**TODAY'S GAMES:** Leading the series 2-1, Sugar Land continues their only home series with the Salt Lake Bees in 2023. In their one series of 2022 against Salt Lake, the Space Cowboys went 4-2 at Constellation Field from 9/13-9/18.

**ABOUT THURSDAY NIGHT:** Dixon Machado hit a game-tying two-run homer in the bottom of the fifth inning to tie the game at 2-2. LHP Nick Allgeyer tossed 6.0 innings of relief, allowing just one run, and LHP Matt Gage added another scoreless inning of relief... In the top of the 10th, a Jake Lamb single scored the Salt Lake bonus runner... Luke Berryhill reached on an error by Jordyn Adams in right, and after a Machado single tied it, David Hensley delivered a walk-off sac fly.

**ROSTER MOVES:** 5/23 - LHP Matt Gage optioned to Sugar Land... LHP Parker Mushinski completed his ML rehab and was recalled by Houston... INF David Hensley optioned to Sugar Land (5/19)... OF Alex McKenna placed on the Dev. List... RHP Devin Conn released.

**HOME GROWN TALENT:** Sugar Land's roster has 10 players drafted by the Astros, 6 international signings and 1 player signed as non-drafted free agents in the five-round 2020 MLB Draft.

**PROSPECTING:** The Space Cowboys active roster boasts six of the Astros Top 30 Prospects according to MLB Pipeline. They include C Korey Lee (#5), OF Pedro León (#6), OF Justin Dirden (#7), RHP Misael Tamrez (#11), INF Joe Perez (#14) & RHP Forrest Whitley (#19)

**RECORD SETTING DAY IN ABQ:** On 5/7 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys topped several franchise records in a 24-8 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes. They included:

- Most Hits in a Game: 30
- Most Extra-Base Hits: 14
- Total Bases: 60
- Most Individual Hits in a game: Korey Lee - 6

Sugar Land also tied the franchise record for runs scored in a game (24) and individual at bats, with three different players recording 7 trips to the plate... This came just three days after Sugar Land had set new single-game records for doubles in a game (9), extra-base hits (13) & at bats (50) in a game on Thursday, 5/4.

**BEGINNING WITH A BANG:** Bligh Madris hit a lead-off home run on the very first pitch on 5/19, his fifth overall homer of the season... It was the third lead-off home run this year by Madris, who has hit in the lead-off spot 17 total times for the Space Cowboys. His lead-off home runs have twice come on the first pitch with the other coming on the second pitch of the game. When hitting in the lead-off spot this year, Madris is slashing .342/.449/.658/1.107 with 4 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs, 11 RBI and 15 walks.

**ON THE RECORD:** RHP Joe Record has made seven straight outings without allowing an earned run and picked up the win on Thursday night, allowing one unearned run in the 10th inning... In the month of May, Record has made 11 appearances, giving up just 2 earned runs in 11.2 innings, converting 4 of 5 saves in that span.

**WHAT A WEEK:** The Space Cowboys had the most prolific week for any team in MiLB this season during their trip to Albuquerque from 5/2-5/7, hitting .395 with 100 hits and 76 runs scored. Here is how their offensive output ranked compared to every other single-week high in MiLB.

**GOING IN FRONT IN GRAND FASHION:** On 5/13, for the second time in 8 games, the Space Cowboys hit a go-ahead grand slam in the seventh inning, with Rylan Bannon launching a grand slam. The grand slam capped a six-run frame and helped finish a comeback from 4-1 down to win 7-5... Justin Dirden delivered the other go-ahead grand slam on Friday, 5/5 @ ABQ, part of a 7-run frame that pushed the Space Cowboys over the top after trailing 8-2 going to the seventh.

**GOT 'EM:** Korey Lee has registered 12 caught stealing in 41 total attempts this year. His 12 caught stealing are the most in the Pacific Coast League. In 2022 with Sugar Land, Lee was tied for fifth in the Pacific Coast League in caught stealing, throwing out 17 of 62 attempted base stealers (27.4%)

**GRAE ALL DAY:** Grae Kessinger continues to get on base at a great clip for the Space Cowboys, reaching in 36 of his first 45 games with Sugar Land while recording hits in 29 of 45 contests, including 21 of the last 27... Kessinger recorded an 11-game hitting streak from 5/2 to 5/14, tied with Korey Lee for the longest hitting streak by a Space Cowboys player this year... On the league leader board, Kessinger is currently 9th in walks (31) and T-10th in runs scored (34).

**DOING IT WITH DEFENSE:** The Space Cowboys have committed just 31 errors this year, tied for the fewest in the PCL... Their .982 fielding percentage is tied for the third best in Triple-A... Meanwhile, Salt Lake has committed 48 errors this season, the most in Triple-A

**EXTRA GOOD IN EXTRA INNINGS:** With a 4-3 win in extra innings on Thursday night, the Space Cowboys improved to 4-1 in extra-inning games this year... It was the second straight game they've won 4-3 in extras and their second extra innings game in five games. Sugar Land's come-from-behind victory on Thursday night was their 14th comeback win of the season.

**MOON WALKING:** After issuing nine walks on Wednesday night, Sugar Land pitching has now walked 305 batters, the most in baseball (MiLB & MLB).

**GRAND DAY FOR DIRDEN:** Outfielder Justin Dirden had a career day on 5/4 against ABQ, going 4-for-5 with 3 doubles, a grand slam, 6 RBI and 2 runs scored... The six RBI are a new career high for Dirden... The former SEMO Redhawk also tied two single-game Space Cowboys franchise records with three doubles and four extra-base hits. Dirden then hit a go-ahead grand slam on Friday night in a 9-8 Space Cowboys win.

**SEVENTH HEAVEN:** In the seventh inning on 5/5 @ ABQ, the Space Cowboys rallied for seven runs, charging back from an 8-2 deficit for a 9-8 win. Justin Dirden delivered the go-ahead hit with a grand slam, his second consecutive day with a grand slam. It's the first time the Space Cowboys have hit grand slams on back-to-back days. The closest grand slams were the first and second slams hit in Sugar Land's affiliated history on 5/13 & 5/17 (G2) @ RR in 2021, both hit by Jose Siri.

**MATIJEVIC'S CAREER NIGHT:** On Tuesday, 5/2 @ Albuquerque, INF JJ Matijevic re-wrote the Sugar Land Space Cowboys record books, going 5-for-6 with a double, 2 triples, 8 RBI and 2 runs scored. Since the Sugar Land franchise joined the affiliated ranks, Matijevic is the first player to record five hits in a game, surpassing the 17 times a player had registered four hits in a game, most recently done by... Matijevic on 4/5/23 vs. RR. His 8 RBI also establish a new single-game franchise record for Sugar Land, overtaking the 7 RBI recorded by Lewis Brinson on 8/3/22 @ LV. Matijevic also recorded two triples, the first player to record two three-baggers in single game. In the series finale on 5/7, Korey Lee surpassed Matijevic with six hits in a game.

For Matijevic, it was his first five-hit game of his career, passing his previous high of 4 hits on 6/21/21 @ ELP and the most RBI in a game for Matijevic in his career, surpassing his 5 RBI on 7/2/19 with Corpus Christi @ Frisco.

**UNA NUEVA Y DULCE IDENTIDAD:** As part of MiLB's 'Copa de la Diversión,' the Space Cowboys will rebrand on multiple occasions in 2023 as 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land.' The name is to honor the Latino community's contribution to the foundation and growth of the City of Sugar Land, which are as real as the sugar that gives our hometown its name. The primary logo of 'Los Dulces de Sugar Land,' is vibrant and features a watermelon candy capped in a flame of chamoy and chili powder.

**WHERE TO FIND US:** Once again in 2023, all 150 Space Cowboys games can be heard on ESPN 92.5 FM (Gow Media). An audio streaming link is also available at sspacecowboys.com. All Space Cowboys games can be seen on MiLB.TV. Garrett Greene begins his first year as the 'Voice of the Space Cowboys' and will be on the call for all game, home and away. He'll be joined by longtime Houston area broadcaster Gerald Sanchez for home games.

**NOW HERE'S A STOREY:** Mickey Storey returns for his fourth season as the manager of the Astros' Triple-A affiliate and his third with Sugar Land. Storey joined the Astros organization as a coach in 2016 and has managed with Single-A Quad Cities (2018) and Triple-A Round Rock (2019), along with two seasons in Sugar Land. Storey appeared in nine seasons at the professional level as a right-handed pitcher, including stints at the Major League level with the Astros (2012) and Blue Jay (2013). He appeared in four collegiate seasons at Florida Atlantic and was selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 31st round of the 2008 MLB Draft.

**TO INFINITY AND BEYOND:** Key elements of the Space Cowboys brand include the Mission Patch, Horizon Gradient and Primary Space Cowboys Logo.

- **Primary Logo:** The primary logo features the Space Cowboy donning a traditional cowboy hat, a bandanna and a blast shield over his face that is peppered with space dust and has a starburst at the eye.
- **Horizon Gradient:** Inspired by a shot of the horizon of the earth from space, the color palette and gradient feature light blue, navy, orange, gray and black notes that are prominent in the franchise's logo and uniforms. The colors represent the ever-expanding Sugar Land community and an exciting new chapter on the horizon
- **Mission Patch:** This patch will be featured on all three uniforms and serves as an alternate logo. It intertwines elements from the Texas state flag, with a rocket superimposed over the front ready to launch.

**READY TO RIDE:** The Space Cowboys brand pays respect to elements that are key to the identity of Greater Houston. The NASA Johnson Space Center is located in Houston and the Cowboys element is a nod to the rugged, Western roots that are embedded in Houston as Texas' largest city.

**A LITTLE ABOUT US:** Through its first nine seasons, Sugar Land played in the independent Atlantic League of Professional Baseball. They won the Atlantic League Championship in '16 and '18 and appeared in the postseason in five of nine seasons. Sugar Land still holds Atlantic League single-season records for wins (95) and winning percentage (.679) from its '13 season. Sugar Land was managed by former Major Leaguers Gary Gaetti (2012-17) and Pete Incaviglia (2018-20). As an independent team, Sugar Land went 601-502. Notable people to appear for Sugar Land include: LHP Scott Kazmir, RHP Roger Clemens, IF Rafael Palmeiro, Tracy McGrady, IF James Loney, C Derek Norris, OF Willy Taveras and RHP Felipe Paulino.

**REST OF THE CREW:** Joining manager Mickey Storey on the Space Cowboys coaching staff are pitching coach Erick Abreu, hitting coach Aaron Westlake and development coach Wladimir Sutil. Abreu returns for his third season in Sugar Land as the pitching coach for the Astros' Triple-A affiliate. He's previously worked as the pitching coach for Astros affiliates at the Single A, Short-Season, Appalachian League, Gulf Coast League and Dominican Summer League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014. Westlake spent 2022 as the hitting coach in Double-A Corpus Christi and worked as a development coach for the Florida Gulf Coast League Astros in 2021. Sutil enters his second season on the Space Cowboys staff after serving as the manager for the Astros' Florida Complex League team in 2021. He's worked as a manager for Astros affiliates at the Short-Season and Gulf Coast League levels, joining the organization as a coach in 2014.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Pitched in long relief on Saturday night in Oklahoma City... Threw 5.0 scoreless innings, giving up just two hits and two walks while striking out seven... Did not receive a decision in a 4-3 Space Cowboys win in 11 innings.

**FIRST START SINNNNCCCE:** When Blanco started on May 9, it was his first start since July 26, 2019 while he was with Tri-Cities.... Even then, Blanco only threw two innings.. He last worked as a full time starter in 2017, making 11 starts in 22 total appearances with Quad Cities, hurling 84.2 innings... Friday is set to be his 23rd career start in 191 total Minor League appearances.

**DOWN HERE FOR YOGA:** Blanco was optioned to Sugar Land on May 6 to increase his innings and stretch out as a starter... He had previously been in the bullpen for the Astros, making 9 relief appearances in 2023... Tossed 12.0 innings and allowed nine runs, six earned, with seven walks and 16 strikeouts.

**DEBUT SZN:** Made the Opening Day Roster with the Astros in 2022 and made his Major League debut on April 8... In seven appearances with Houston in 2022, went 0-0, 7.00 ERA, pitching 6.1 innings.

**HOLD ME CLOSER:** Has totaled 27 saves in 38 total save chances between 2021 and 2022 with Sugar Land.

**WELCOME TO THE 'STROS:** Signed as an international free agent when he was 22 on April 27, 2016... Began his career as a corner infielder and outfielder with a strong arm... Converted to pitching at the age of 18.
