TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, wrapping up a 6-game set at Somerset.

LAST TIME OUT: Anthony Solometo struck out seven in his Double-A debut, but Altoona managed just three hits in an 8-1 loss at Somerset. Matt Fraizer had two hits and drew two walks in the loss.

THE BIG LEFTY: Altoona welcomed lefty Anthony Solometo to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out Harrisburg seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. The 20-year-old left-hander was Pittsburgh's second round pick (37th overall) in 2021 out of Bishop Eustace Prep (NJ). At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in Bowie the Eastern League behind Somerset's Jasson Dominguez (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17.

MOVING SEASON: Altoona saw a pair of key members of their pitching staff earn promotions to Triple-A on June 16. RHP Travis MacGregor, who was 2nd among Eastern League relievers with 43 strikeouts in 32.1 IP, and RHP Kyle Nicolas, who ranked 10th in the league in strikeouts with 63, each moved to Indy. In their place, Altoona welcomed back RHP Sean Sullivan from the injured list and received the No. 9 prospect in the system according to MLB Pipeline: LHP Anthony Solometo.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez reached base safely in 6-of-7 games played including 3 2B, 2 HR and 6 RBI, including a gametying 2-run homer on Sunday, June 11 to aid Altoona to a 5-4 comeback win in 10 innings. Gutierrez was acquired from the Philadelphia Phillies in exchange for LHP Braeden Ogle in July of 2021 and the two worked as the battery on Friday, June 9. Reading

PEGGY'S POP: Infielder Liover Peguero enters play on June 18 as one of the league's top hitters this month, he is 16th in the Eastern League batting average with a .323 mark and reached base safely in 14 straight games (5/31 - 6/16).

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Sunday, June 18, Altoona has struck out 492 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5th-fewest in minor league baseball. In their series at Richmond beginning on June 4, the Curve struck out 62 times (including 4 games with 10 or more) one shy of a season-high in a six-game series.

WE'LL TAKE TWO: Altoona is 2nd among all Double-A teams with 58 double plays turned.

A BID FOR THE AGES: Altoona right-hander Jared Jones carried a no-hit bid into the 7th inning on Thursday, June 8 at Richmond. Jones allowed just one walk and hit one batter in his first six innings before Brandon Martorano swatted a solo homer to left field to leadoff the 7th inning. <u>Jones is now ranked as the No. 89 prospect in all of minor league baseball ac</u> cording to Baseball America.

PROSPECT PARTY: The Curve roster features several top Pirates prospects according to MLB Pipeline led by No. 6 INF Liover Peguero, No. 9 LHP Anthony Solometo, No. 11 RHP Jared Jones, No. 17 OF Matt Gorski, and No. 23 OF Matt Fraizer.

THE PATRIOTS ARE THE YANKEES?: Fresh off an Eastern League championship in just their second season of play as the Yankees Eastern League affiliate, Somerset enters the series in the thick of the First Half Championship race. Their roster Pereira, No. 5 INF Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Richard Fitts, No. 9 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 13 RHP Clayton Beeter.

A PATRIOT ON THE 'SET: Chase Hampton makes his Double-A debut this afternoon for Somerset. New York's 6th round selection out of Texas Tech in 2022, Hampton recorded a 2.68 ERA in 9 starts at High-A to begin the season with 77 strikeouts in 47.0 IP. Hampton hails from Kilgore, TX and was a draft-eligible sophomore by virtue of reaching the 21-year-old age requirement.
