"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints opened up the second half of the season with a 6-1 win over the Louisville Bats, backed by three home runs and a strong Triple-A debut from right-hander Pierson Ohl on Tuesday night at CHS Field. Ohl was outstanding at inducing soft contact all evening. His day started with a 37.4 mph infield single by Bryson Brigrman and he went on to retire the next six he faced before allowing his first clean hit, a single from Will Banfield to leadoff the third. Ohl scattered just three hits on the evening over 4.0 scoreless frames, striking out one without a walk. He induced six pop outs and allowed an average exit velocity of just 72.7 mph on the balls put in play against him, the lowest average for a Saints pitcher who has thrown at least three innings in a game in the past three years of the Triple-A pitch-tracking era. The Saints offense backed him with three home runs on the night, including a two-run blast by Noah Cardenas, his third in nine games since a call-up to Triple-A to cap a three-run second. Edouard Julien led off the fifth with a solo shot, his fourth in seven games on the homestand and sixth on the year, before Carson McCusker blasted off for his team-leading 15th for a two-run big fly three batters later. Ivan Johnson got the Bats on the board with a leadoff shot to begin the seventh off Michael Tonkin, who otherwise pitched a pair of scoreless innings and completed three to pick up his first win. Cody Laweryson worked a scoreless eighth and ninth inning to close it out.

TURNING A CORNER: The Saints have won back-to-back games for the first time since May 28-29 in Omaha when they chained together three in-a-row. Tuesday's win also marked the first win for St. Paul in a series opener since May 13 @Iowa (the Saints had lost five straight openers after beginning the season 7-1 in such games). Before Sunday's walk-off win to close the first half, the Saints had gone just 4-16 (.200) over their previous 20 games, tied for the worst record in MiLB over that span and the Saints' worst 20-game stretch this season.

GIVE ME OHL THE POP UPS: Saints starter Pierson Ohl was superb in his Triple-A debut on Tuesday night, producing an average exit velocity of just 72.7 mph against him in his four scoreless innings. It marked the lowest average exit velo allowed by a Saints pitcher who had gone to at least 3.0 IP in a game in the last three years of the Triple-A pitch-tracking era, and one of the top-15 lowest in a game for a Triple-A pitcher this season. He generated six pop outs on that span, which is tied for the second-most in a game of any pitcher in Triple-A this season regardless of innings thrown (Memphis RHP Zach Plesac has the season-high watermark with 7 popouts vs GWI on June 15).

BASH BROTHERS: Since being called up for his Triple-A debut on June 12, first baseman Aaron Sabato has joined forces with Carson McCusker for the league's best hard-hitting tandem. Since joining the Saints on June 12, Sabato ranks 2nd in the International League with a 71.4% hard-hit rate (min 20 PA) and is 4th in average exit velocity (96.6 mph). In less than two weeks in Triple-A, he has produced 20 "hard-hit" balls of 95 mph or greater which leads the league and Carson McCusker is right behind him with 17 such batted balls in that span (see below). McCusker ranks 5th in all of Triple-A in average exit velocity on the season (93.5 mph) and has produced four of the top-50 hardest hit balls in the league this season.

NEW HALF, NEW SAINTS: The Saints wrapped up the first-half of the season on Sunday vs Toledo and the league standings now reset for the second-half. The best record in the league in the second half will face the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (MIA) in a three game series in Florida. Here is how the first and second halves of seasons have shook out for St. Paul the past three years since the International League switched to the first-half/second-half format to determine playoff teams:

POR LA CALLE: Junior Severino broke out of his lengthy home run drought to start the season, smashing a 420 foot bomb to left field on Sunday, the sixth-furthest tracked home run by a Saints batter this year and the longest opposite-field homer from a St. Paul hitter this season. Severino's 97 plate appearances to start a season without a homer marks the longest drought to begin a season in his career and his longest stretch without a homer at any point in the last four years since he went 130 PA and 30 consecutive games without a longball from May 9-June 22, 2021 in the Florida State League. Severino shared the minor league home run crown with the Astros' Shay Whitcomb with 35 round-trippers between Double-A and Triple-A in 2023 and hit 21 with St. Paul last season to tie the Saints' single season franchise record.

MCCRUSHING THE RECORD BOOKS: With five games remaining on the calendar in June, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is currently 4 RBI shy of the Saints franchise record for the most RBI in a season at the end of June (see below). After a monster first month of the season, the 6-8 slugger finished April with 7 homers, three more than any other Saints hitter the last five years by the end of April, and had already reached 23 RBI, also the most in franchise history at that point in the season. Entering play on May 1, his 27 total hits, 1.049 OPS & .651 SLG% were also the highest in franchise history by the end of April (min 40 PA). The Saints record for single-season home runs is 21, shared by three St. Paul hitters (Y. Severino-2024, J. Camargo-2023, C. Williams-2023. DaShawn Keirsej, Jr. holds the single-season RBI record with 81 last year.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (37-42) lost their fifth straight game yesterday in a 6-5 loss to the Mariners at Target Field. Julio Rodriguez broke a 5-5 deadlock that had stood since the fourth with a sac fly in the ninth. The Twins have now dropped 12 of their last 14 games and are 11-22 following a 13-game winning streak in May. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (38-32) shutout Springfield 3-0 at home. Twins No. 4 prospect Kaelen Culepepper homered yesterday, his first at the Double-A level, and has hits in all three games since a call-up to the Wind Surge. High-A Cedar Rapids (41-29) are off to a 1-3 start in the second half of the season after winning the first half title and lost 10-6 hosting South Bend (CHC) Tuesday. Low-A Fort Myers (29-39) lost 6-3 in Tampa (NY) and have dropped 10 of their last 12 overall.

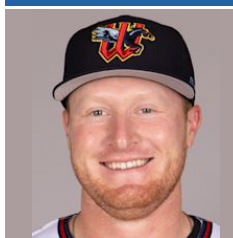

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his second ever Triple-A appearance pitching in relief behind Andrew Morris on Thursday in his CHS Field debut. Notched his first Triple-A win after taking over in a 2-2 game and seeing the Saints offense erupt for six runs in the bottom of the fifth. Allowed five baserunners but left them all stranded, pitching around traffic in each inning. Threw 32 sinkers (47%), 19 sliders (28%), and 17 changeups (25%). Generated 15 swings-and-misses, led by six apiece on the sinker and slider. Three of his five punchouts were recorded on the sinker and two came on the changeup.

KNOWING THE GAME FROM BOTH SIDES: Baker was primarily a catcher until his Georgetown High School coaches recognized his strong arm belonged on the mound. He attracted little attention from college scouts, but his high school coach, Adam Foster, took an assistant coaching job at Angelo State and recruited Baker to join him there. Angelo State head coach Kevin Brooks recalled Baker arriving on campus with a mid-80's fastball and no breaking ball, but he was tall and could throw strikes.

TRIPLE-CROWN WINNER: In his first full professional season in 2022, Baker spent the entire season with the Palm Beach Cardinals and captured the Florida State League's Pitching Triple-Crown (led the league in Wins, ERA, and Strikeouts). While he was the only pitcher in the league that year to throw enough innings to "qualify" for the ERA lead (a pitcher must log at least 0.8 innings pitched per the team's game played that season), Baker logged 24.1 more innings than the next closest pitcher that season and his ERA was the 2nd-lowest among anyone that threw at least 80 innings in the FSL that season. He had one more win and 18 more strikeouts than his next closest pursuer in the other two categories.

EXCUSE ME, WHERE?: Trent Baker made his way to pro ball by the way of Angelo State University, an NCAA Division II program located in San Angelo, Texas, where Baker became the program's career wins (31) and strikeouts (293) leader. The Rams resurrected their baseball program in 2005 after a long hiatus, and have since turned themselves into a perennial power in the Lone Star Conference. They have won six of the past 10 regular season conference championships in the league and as of the end of the 2024 season, are the only current Lone Star Conference team to ever make the College World Series. The Rams have advanced to the College World Series six times in 15 years since bringing the program back, including in 2021 in Baker's RS Junior season and for each of the past four seasons (2021-24). The old iteration of the Angelo State program has produced three Major League players in program history: most notably 5-time All-Star Norm Cash, a first baseman for the Tigers & White Sox for 17 seasons from 1958-1974, as well as Tommy Gramly (RHP, 3g with Cleveland in 1968), and Jim Morris (LHP, TB, 21g, 1999-00), the 35-year-old rookie for the Devil Rays in 1999 who's story was dramatized for the 2002 film "The Rookie" starring Dennis Quaid.
