**MUCH-NEEDED W:** After getting back in the win column at Carolina last night by edging the Mudcats 1-0, the FredNats will try to make it two straight on Friday night at Five County Stadium behind Jarlin Susana, who hasn't allowed a run in his last two starts. Susana's 10-inning scoreless streak is the best stretch of his professional career so far. Despite the win last night, the Fredies have continued to mightily struggle with the bats in the month of June. This month, the FredNats are slashing .181/.272/.255 this month for a team OPS of .527, while the opponents have a .299/.367/.343 slash line this month for an OPS of .800. This month is a stark contrast to the first six weeks of the season when FXBG led the league in runs scored and bullpen ERA. Fredericksburg comes into play today 7.0 games behind Carolina for first in the division with six games to play in the first half, however, the FredNats are not mathematically eliminated yet because Carolina has eight games remaining. The Mudcats will play two doubleheaders next week against the Columbia Fireflies to make up for early-season rainouts.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Travis Sykora, Kevin Rodriguez, Samuel Vasquez and Merrick Baldo combined for the fourth shutout of the season for FredNat pitching, and the offense scratched across the game's only run in the 7th in a 1-0 victory to snap a four-game losing skid for the FredNats. Cristhian Vaquero got the base hit that caused an error for the game's only run in the 7th inning, scoring Marcus Brown.

**UNBEATEN AFTER 7:** Despite the recent struggles, the FredNats remain a perfect 25-0 when leading after seven this year, and also a perfect 26-0 when leading after eight innings. The winning formula all season has been the offense taking a lead in the middle innings, and the bullpen holding onto that lead each time.

**BIG SPLASH:** Nick Peoples homered in his second FredNat at-bat in Wednesday night's game, hitting a rocket 362 feet way over the right field wall to bring FXBG within a run at the time. Peoples, the Nationals' 12th round draft pick in 2022, had a .706 OPS in 18 games in the Complex League before being called to Fredericksburg prior to the start of this series.

**FORMULA FOR SUCCESS:** The FredNats are 23-5 this season when scoring first, including 20 out of the last 21 wins. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses the last two weeks, and has scored first in its last three wins, and two of them on the last road trip against Down East. Tuesday night, FXBG was beaten by Carolina despite scoring first.

**RBI KING:** Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 48. This year, Pimentel is hitting .347 with runners in scoring position, and is 11-for-24 (.458) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 172-148 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Jarlin Susana is set to make his 11th start of 2024, after getting the nod on Opening Night. The big righty features a heater that routinely exceeds triple digits, to go along with a sinker, a tight slider, plus a curveball and a changeup.

**EARLY-SEASON HIGHS:** After an up-and-down April last year, Susana really hit his stride going into May. From his start on 5/3 vs Down East, Jarlin was flat out dominant. Over his next eight starts, Susana worked to a 2.35 ERA across 30.2 IP, with opponents hitting a measly .167 against him.

**LATE-SEASON LULL:** Unfortunately, Susana faltered as the season went on. After the aforementioned eight-start stretch, Jarlin made just four more starts the rest of the season. He struggled with his command, walking 15 batters in 22.2 IP, with an ERA north of 9.00. Susana made his final start of the year on 8/5 against Salem before being placed on the Development List to end his season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** For the second straight start, Susana tossed five shutout innings. Jarlin fanned nine against Kannapolis at home last week, while giving up just a pair of base hits. He did not earn a decision.
