YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels swept a doubleheader against the Patriots. In Game 1, Jack Choate, Will Bednar and Tyler Myrick combined for a four-hit shutout. Choate picked up his third win of the year, throwing five scoreless innings with seven strikeouts. Will Bednar struck out the side in a scoreless sixth. Tyler Myrick closed his eighth save in the year. The only run of the game scored in the first inning. Bo Davidson singled to lead off the game, advanced to third on a pick-off attempt error and scored on a double by Victor Bericoto. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels jumped out to a big lead and held off a late charge by the Patriots for an 8-6 win. Somerset scored a run in the first but Onil Perez hit a two-run single to move the Flying Squirrels ahead and later scored on a sacrifice fly by Aeverson Arteaga for a 3-1 lead. In the third, Carter Howell hit a three-run homer in the top of the third to open a 6-1 lead. Victor Bericoto hit a two-run homer in the fourth to extend the lead to 8-1. The Patriots scored two runs on a pair of bases-loaded walks in the fifth to close the score to 8-3. Brendan Jones closed the score to 8-6 in the seventh with a three-run homer. After a walk to bring the potential tying run to the batters box, Evan Gates entered and recorded the final out. Shane Rademacher made his Double-A debut and allowed one run over 3.2 innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the fifth of a six-game series against the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. When these two teams met at The Diamond from April 29-May 4, the Patriots won the first two before the Flying Squirrels won the next three. Somerset won the series finale for a series split.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,556 fans per home game, which ranks seventh among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are in second place in the Southwest Division second-half standings, 1.5 games behind Altoona. Last week, they had a three-series win streak snapped, dropping four-of-five to the Sea Dogs at The Diamond. After going 10-2 from July 4-20, they are 3-6 in their last nine games since July 22, but won both games of Friday's doubleheader. Of Richmond's 60 losses this season, 34 of them have been by two runs or less (22 by one, 12 by two). Their 22 one-run losses are the most in the EL, two more than Reading. Richmond's +19 run differential in the second half is third-best in the league. In their last nine games, the Flying Squirrels have hit 185 (17-for-92) with runners in scoring position and left 70 on base.

THE PATRIOTS are in second place in the Northeast Division second-half standings, 3.5 games behind first-half champion Binghamton. They are two games ahead of third-place Hartford. Somerset is 5-7 in its last 12 games and split last week's six-game series at Erie. For the year, the Patriots lead the Eastern League in homers (110) and rank second in runs (457). Somerset's roster features four of Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects, including SS George Lombard (No. 1), RHP Carlos Lagrange (No. 5), RHP Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz (No. 6) and LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 11). MLB.com's top-30 prospects list features seven Somerset players, including Lombard (No. 1), Lagrange (No. 2), Rodriguez-Cruz (No. 6), Selvidge (No. 10), OF Brandon Jones (No. 20), OF Dylan Jasso (No. 24) and OF Jace Avina (No. 26).

STRONG ARMS: Since June 18, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 3.03 ERA (103 ER/285.0 IP) in 35 games, which is fourth in the Eastern League. The Richmond bullpen has posted a 2.73 ERA (44 ER/145.0 IP) in that stretch. In their last 16 road games since June 17, the Flying Squirrels have posted a 2.57 ERA (40 ER/140.0 IP).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 19th start of the season and the fifth of his career against the Patriots. Tonight marks the 57th start of his Richmond career, moving him ahead of Kyle Crick (2014-16) and Jack Snodgrass (2013-15) for third-most in franchise history. He started last Tuesday against the Sea Dogs and threw five scoreless innings with six strikeouts. It was his second consecutive scoreless start. He threw seven innings and allowed two hits on July 10 at Akron in his last start before the All-Star Break. He also started last Sunday's game against the Patriots and threw one inning before the game was delayed and eventually canceled. In July, Bertrand went 2-0 with a 0.51 ERA (1 ER/17.2 IP) in three starts. For the season, he ranks second in the Eastern League in innings pitched (95.2), fourth in ERA (3.10) and ninth in WHIP (1.30). After going 0-4 with a 5.91 ERA (14 ER/21.1 IP) in five April starts, Bertrand has gone 4-3 with a 2.30 ERA (19 ER/74.1 IP) in his last 13 starts since May 4. Since the start of the 2024 season, Bertrand leads all MiLB pitchers in innings (251.2) and double play groundouts (34). Last year, he was named the Flying Squirrels' Pitcher of the Year after going 7-9 with a 4.32 ERA in 28 outings (27 starts). Bertrand also won the team's Community Service Award. He made two starts with Triple-A Sacramento to close the season. For the year, Bertrand led all Eastern League pitchers with 10 scoreless starts, all at least five innings. He also led all MiLB pitchers in double plays induced (23), five ahead of the next closest pitcher. Bertrand was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice last year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. Entering 2025, he is rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system for the second straight year. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two

FOR SOMERSET: Right-hander Trent Sellers makes his 18th start of the season and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Saturday at Erie and allowed career highs in hits (11) and earned runs (6) in a no-decision. He pitched at The Diamond on May 3 and allowed two runs over 4.1 innings with seven strikeouts in a loss. For the season, Sellers ranks eighth in the Eastern League in strikeouts (87). Sellers began his collegiate career at Washington State before pitching two years at NAIA Lewis-Clark State. He transferred to Oregon State in 2023 and signed with the Yankees that July. He spent last season with High-A Hudson Valley and went 6-3 with a 2.09 ERA in 31 outings (nine starts) en route to being named a South Atlantic

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey, Zach Morgan and Onil Perez have combined to catch 53 stolen base attempts this season, which first among the 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey leads all Double-A catchers with 38 runners caught stealing. Sugastey has set a franchise record for the most caught stealing in a season in Flying Squirrels history, passing Jackson Williams' mark of 35 set in 2015 with his 36th on July 26 against Portland. For his career with Richmond, Sugastey's 51 runners caught stealing for his career is third-most in franchise history, trailing Eliezer Zambrano (53, 2010-2017).

BERI BOMBS: Victor Bericoto hit his ninth homer of the season in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, which leads active Richmond players for the year. It was the 31st homer of his Flying Squirrels career, moving him into third place on the franchises's all-time home run list, passing Jarrett Parker (2013-14). He is now two homers behind Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22) for second place on the list and six behind Ricky Oropesa's (2013-16) franchise record of 37. He also drove the 118th RBI of his Richmond career in the first game of Friday's doubleheader, moving him ahead of Hunter Cole (2015-17) for second place on the franchise's all-time RBI list. Bericoto now has 120 career RBIs with Richmond, trailing only Oropesa's record of 165.

UNTUCK: Tyler Myrick recorded his eighth save of the season in the first game of Friday's doubleheader. It was the 20th save of his Richmond career, which tied him with **Cody Hall** (2013-14, '17) for sixth-most in team history. He is two behind a tie for fifth on the list with **Josh Osich** (2013-16). Myrick has converted all four of his five save attempts since July 1 over nine appearances. He picked up his first win of the season on July 25 against the Sea Dogs, working the final four outs. Since June 28, Myrick has posted a 1.50 ERA (2 ER/12.0 IP) in 10 appearances.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Diego Velasquez is ranked sixth in walks (50), sixth in hits (89) and ninth in OBP (.362), Turner Hill is tied for fourth in triples (5). Seth Lonsway is tied for fifth in innings pitched (92.0), seventh in ERA (3.52) and 10th in strikeouts (84). John Michael Bertrand is second in innings pitched (95.2), fourth in ERA (3.10) and ninth in WHIP (1.30). Jack Choate is third in strikeouts (102) and, fifth in ERA (3.59) and tied for seventh in BAA (.227). Joe Whitman is seventh in strikeouts (88). Tyler Myrick is tied for third in saves (8).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 241 wins in his career, which is a new franchise record all-time wins record for a manager. He passed the record with Richmond's 6-1 win at Binghamton on May 23. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster features four players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bo Davidson (No. 4), Diego Velasquez (No. 8), Joe Whitman (No. 9) and Jack Choate (No. 28). John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control in the Giants system. Adrian Sugastey is ranked as the top defensive catcher. Aeverson Arteaga is rated as the best defensive infielder and best infield arm. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features three Richmond players, including Davidson (No. 5), Whitman (No. 14) and Velasquez (No. 21).

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

1963: The Richmond Virginians beat the Arkansas Travelers, 2-0, at Parker Field. Jack Cullen scatted nine hits over seven scoreless innings. Mel Stottlemyer recorded the final six outs. The game's two runs scored on solo home runs on consecutive pitches in the sixth inning by Don Buddin and Elvio Jimenez. 1973: The Richmond Braves were swept in a doubleheader by the Pawtucket Red Sox at Parker Field. In the second game, Pawtucket's Bill Kouns threw a no-hitter, allowing two walks and striking out one over seven innings in a 1-0 win. 1981: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 7-6, at Parker Field. After Toledo scored four runs in the seventh to take a 6-4 lead, Down a run with two outs in the ninth, Randy Johnson beat an infield single with a head-first dive to first to tie the score. Ken Smith followed with a ball hit to second baseman Johnny Walker, scoring Butler on the error to win the game. 1997: The Richmond Braves beat the Toledo Mud Hens, 6-5, at The Diamond. Down 5-2 in the bottom of the ninth, Richmond had one runner on base with two outs. Mike Mordecai hit an RBI double and scored on a single by Ed Giovanola, who later scored on a single by Ed Giovanola, who later scored on a single by T.R. Lewis to tie the game. Damon Hollins won the game with a walk-off single. 2012: The Flying Squirrels beat the Reading Phillies, 2-0, at The Diamond. Mike Kickham pitched 8.1 scoreless innings and allowed three hits. He struck out 12 batters, which tied the then-franchise single-game record, set twice the previous year by Eric Surkamp. Brett Bochy finished the shutout, recording the final two outs to pick up his 14th save of the season. Daniel Mayora hit a solo homer and Ehire Adrianza drove in a run with a groundout, beating out an attempted double play, in the seventh for the game's only two runs. 2018: The Flying Squirrels beat the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 20-8, in Manchester. The Fisher Cats took a 5-0 lead in the first inning, which tied the second-largest defi
