THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue a six game home series tonight. Wichita has 17 games remaining and 11 at home, team is 8 games back of first place. Since the All-Star Break, Wichita is 22-12, tied for the best record in the Texas League. Since the break the team has won four series, lost one and split a series. Wichita will need to win 8 more games this year to avoid having its fewest wins in a season. 2024 team finished 58-80.

THE HIT PARADE - Wichita has recorded double-digit hits in 16 of its last 34 games and 30 times this season. The team leads the league with 200 runs and third in league with 48 home runs. The Surge hitters are not the only ones that flipped the page after the break, Wichita pitching has third best 4.02 ERA in league over 34 games.

SWIPE EM- The Wind Surge set a new stolen base record on Sunday, The Surge stole their 213th base surpassing the previous record of 211 in 2013. The team added two more bags Tuesday.

THE LONG BALL - The Wind Surge are second in the league with 168 Home Runs. The Surge have six players with double digit homers. Wichita led the league last season with a franchise record 171 home runs for the season. The Surge have had 13 players have multi home run games this season. The grand slam Friday night was the seventh of the season, one shy of the club record. (8, 2025). The league has hit 1,428 home runs this season, as of this date last year it was 980, an increase of 448.

PUNCH OUTS - The Wind Surge have 53 games with double-digit strikeouts this season. 7th highest total with 1103 strikeouts in TL. The club record is 1311 in 2022.

VS. TRAVS- The 2026 season series 8-8, the teams split the series in North Little Rock in April. Travs took five of six in Wichita. The Surge swept a three game set in Arkansas in July. In 2025 Wichita won 12 of 18. The All-Time Series is Wichita 67-45.

ON THE BUMP: Adrian Bohorquez makes his Class AA debut today. Its his 4th season of professional baseball. 12 games, 11 starts with Cedar Rapids, 1-0, 4.19 ERA, 38.2IP, 47K. Also made 3 starts with FCL Twins after forearm injury. Named Twins Co-Pitcher of the Week on 8/23 ..made the start on Thursday 8/20 at Beloit, allowing one run on one hit in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strike outs...the La Victoria, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins in January of 2023 and is the club's 18th-best prospect, per MLB.com.

THE COMEBACK- The five run ninth inning deficit, matched the largest comeback of the season, the teams largest comeback ever was a seven run deficit on July 6, 2025 vs Tulsa. The walk-off win is the 8th against the Arkansas Travelers in six seasons. The Wind Surge win their 3rd game when trailing after 8 innings and second time in a week.

SURGE WALK OFF TRAVS- The Wichita Wind Surge (26-26) walked off the Arkansas Travelers (20-32), 7-6, in game two of a six-game series Wednesday night at Equity Bank Park, scoring six runs in the bottom of the ninth to erase a five-run deficit. Kyle DeBarge was the hero, delivering the walk-off single up the middle to cap the six-run rally and record his 22nd multi-hit performance of the season. Jaime Ferrer and Caden Kendle each logged multi-hit, multi-RBI performances, with Kendle driving in a run for the third consecutive game. Jake Rucker extended his on-base streak to 24 games, while Graham Brown reached safely for the sixth straight game.

THE RYTHEM OF THE NIGHT - Kyle DeBarge recorded his 22nd multi-hit performance of the season and delivered the walk-off single in the ninth.

ICT NOTES -Wichita has won 9 of its last 13 home games..... 46 of the 51 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge are 14-16 in one run games. Wichita is 9th in the league in batting average, 2nd in walks, 1st HBP (6th in all of MiLB), and 9th in ERA, and have allowed the most SB's in all of AA. The team has 101 errors, 8th most in the league.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 598.2 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 45 of the 51 team wins, the bullpen has a 5.59 ERA 9th in TL, starters are at 4.60. Surge starters are 6-36, fewest wins in the league, next closest team has 18.

LIGHT UP THE KENDLE- Caden Kendle notched his 14th multi-hit and 10th multi-RBI performances of the season. Kendle has driven in a run in four consecutive games. He has the best batting average in the league since July 1, .376 and his 8 home runs in August are tied for the league lead and his 35 RBI since July 1st is 5th best.

RUCK EM UP - Jake Rucker extended his on-base streak to 25 games. He is 3 RBI shy of 200 career RBI with Wichita. Since his return from the IL, he is batting .347 with 5 HR, 19RBI and has 13 walks in 22 games.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFT OFF - Marek Houston, since July 1, he has the 8th most hits in the league and leads with stolen bases. His 31 game on base streak from June 28-Aug 8 is the longest in Surge history and the third longest in the Texas League this season.
