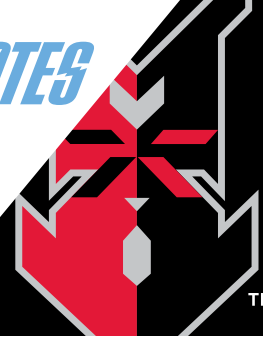

NOTES AND NUGGETS

NEW (AND OLD) KIDS ON THE BLOCK

Omaha added 2 hitters to the team's offense ahead of this week's series with Indy.

Outfielder **Dairon Blanco** joined Omaha Tuesday, on a Major League rehab assignment ... he landed on Kansas City's 10-Day Injured list on March 31 with *right Achilles tendinopathy* ... Blanco previously played 194 games with the Storm Chasers previously, between 2021 and 2023.

Additionally, infielder **Peyton Wilson** was promoted to Omaha from Double-A Northwest Arkansas ... the 66th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft out of Alabama, Wilson has been in Double-A since the start of the 2023 season and racked up 267 games with the Nationals, where he's slashed .268/.365/.418 with NWA ... Wilson currently ranks Top-10 among qualified Minor League hitters in on-base percentage, slugging percentage and OPS.

WHAT A RELIEF!

Omaha's bullpen combined for 7.1 scoreless innings yesterday, one of the group's most impressive performances in recent memory.

Yesterday's game marked the 6th time this season the Storm Chasers relievers combined to not allow a run ... Omaha is 5-1 when its bullpen works a shutout.

Since 2021, Omaha's bullpen has combined for 7.0 scoreless innings or more 7 times ... yesterday's 7.1 scoreless innings were the most since they worked 7.1 scoreless innings on July 28, 2024 @ St. Paul.

DON'T LEAD ME ON

Omaha has had a lead in just 2 of the team's last 9 games, with a long stretch recently where the team did not lead at all.

In the last 9 games (since April 24), Omaha has led for 13 of 77 innings (17%), while the Chasers have played from behind for 53 of 77 innings (69%).

This Wednesday, Omaha snapped a streak of 50 innings without having a lead in a game, a stretch that dated back to last Wednesday, April 23 in Toledo ... after taking a 1-0 lead in the 1st inning in Toledo on April 23, Omaha played from behind or tied with its opponents from the 2nd inning of the game until taking a lead in the 2nd inning Wednesday.

The Storm Chasers only led for 6 innings in last week's series with the Mud Hens ... over the final 4 games of the series, Omaha led for 0 of the 32 innings played, with Toledo leading for 25 of the 32 innings (78%) ... in the series as a whole, the Mud Hens led for 34 of 54 innings (63%).

U CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff ranks near the top of the International League in strikeouts, with 303 strikeouts this season, just 3 behind first place.

Omaha pitchers are averaging 10.40 K/9, which ranks 3rd at the Triple-A level.

With 303 strikeouts through 30 games, an average of 10.1 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,504 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.

MASHIN' MERV

While his first week in Triple-A was slow, outfielder **MJ Melendez** has picked up the pace offensively this week against Indianapolis.

Melendez has gone 5-for-19 (.263) against the Indians this week, with a pair of doubles, 3 RBI and 1 walk ... he drove in a run in the first 3 games of this series.

Last week, Melendez was just 2-for-24 (.083 average) with 1 double, 2 walks and 10 strikeouts.

In 11 games with Omaha, MJ has an average exit velocity of 91.4MPH ... that's the 2nd-best average exit velo on batted balls, among 20 Omaha hitters this year ... his RBI double in the 4th inning Thursday rocked off his bat at 112.0MPH, the hardest hit ball of the season by an Omaha player and his 3rd-hardest batted ball recorded by Statcast (since MLB debut in May 2022).

LET'S RAVE

Outfielder **John Rave** has been a consistent presence at the top of the Omaha all season long, contributing in all facets of the game.

Rave is tied for the league lead in triples (3), tied 4th in steals (12) and tied 9th in runs scored (20) ... he leads Omaha in all 3 categories.

Rave has served as Omaha's leadoff hitter in 24 of 30 games this year ... he's reached base to begin 9 of 24 games (.375 OBP leading off the 1st inning) ... that includes 6 hits (1 single, 3 doubles, 2 homers), 2 walks and 1 hit-by-pitch ... his 2 leadoff homers this year are tied for the Minor League lead.

Rave has played at least 50.0 innings at all 3 outfield positions, one of 5 Triple-A players who has done so.

Rave's average sprint speed this season has been 29.3 ft/sec ... that ranks 2nd on the team behind Tyler Tolbert (29.6 ft/sec).

LUINDER AVILA SCOUTING REPORT

MLB Pipeline

Scouting grades: Fastball: 50 | Slider: 50 | Curveball: 50 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45 | Overall: 40

The Royals signed a 16-year-old Avila out of Venezuela during the 2018 international signing period. Ever since, it's been steady progress for the now-23-year-old who spent most of the 2024 season at Double-A before making one Triple-A start. Avila posted a 1.37 WHIP over 19 starts for Northwest Arkansas. It was the first time since 2022 that he didn't throw over 100 innings, as he missed about six weeks with a minor oblique injury. In five games (three starts) in the Arizona Fall League, Avila posted a 3.07 ERA with 17 strikeouts and eight walks in 14 2/3 innings. The Royals added him to their 40-man roster to protect him from the Rule 5 Draft in November.

Last year marked the first time Avila missed significant time; he's been a durable young pitcher for the Royals, and those innings don't go unnoticed. Avila's comfort zone with his fastball is 94-95 mph with flashes of the upper 90s, and the pitch has natural cut and ride. To help him command the arm'side of the plate, Avila introduced a two-seamer that is about the same velo as his four-seamer. He throws both the slider and curveball, and both can miss bats. They can sometimes morph into each other, so the separation is a work in progress. A fringe-average changeup rounds out Avila's arsenal, a pitch he's still developing with a focus on backing off the 89-91 mph velocity. Avila has near-average command but hides the ball well in his delivery, and as he's grown, his presence on the mound has gotten stronger.

Now that he's on the 40-man, Avila could make his big league debut at some point in 2025. He needs more development time in Omaha, particularly with his secondary pitches and command, but will be part of the Triple-A depth to begin the season. Avila will continue to start but might be someone whom the Royals can rely on in different roles depending on need for a long reliever or a swingman.

Baseball America

Scouting Grades: Fastball: 55 | Curveball: 60 | Changeup: 45 | Control: 45

Track Record: It's been a slow trek through the Royals system for Avila since first signing in 2018, but he's proven enough value to get a spot on the 40-man roster. The Venezuelan righthander was on the way to a strong season until a rib cage injury in early July put him on the sidelines for seven weeks. He returned in time to get three more starts at Double-A Northwest Arkansas and one with Triple-A Omaha. His 3.81 ERA and .229 opponent batting average in Double-A were among the best numbers of his career. Avila finished his year in the Arizona Fall League, where he pitched in the annual Fall Stars Game as well as throwing two scoreless innings in the championship game.

Scouting Report: Avila's four-seam fastball has glove-side cutting action and sits 93-95 mph, touching 98, with ride. A development goal will be to improve the location and consistency of the pitch. His best pitch is a high-spin two-plane curveball at 79-83 mph and he uses it to get swings and misses with its downward movement that's tough to barrel. His 87-91 mph hard changeup is still in development, a pitch with natural sink that gets whiffs, and could be an average offering with more consistency. He repeats his delivery and has been called a sneaky competitor.

The Future: The Royals added Avila to the 40-man roster in November. He projects as a valuable innings-eater at the back of the rotation but could thrive in a bullpen role.
