NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

2026 has been a roller coaster for Omaha, with the Storm Chasers experiencing significant ups and downs in the last month.

- Of 25 series this year, Omaha has won 8, lost 12 and split 5 ... the Storm Chasers have lost 4 of their last 5 series, with a series split against St. Paul September 1-6.
- After going 4-15 (.210) from August 9 to September 2, the Storm Chasers have gone 5-5 (.500) over their last 10 games, outscoring their opponents 43 to 40.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 36 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 41 losses this year.
- 36 comeback wins are tied 6th-most in the International League, tied 9th-most in Triple-A ... 41 blown leads rank as the 3rd-most in the International League and 5th-most in Triple-A.
- The 36 comeback wins and 41 blown leads mean 77 of Omaha's 141 games this year (55%) have featured a comeback from the eventual winner.

RECORD WATCH

- There are several milestones to keep watch for as Omaha's 2026 season nears a close.
- In Sunday's game, **Carson Roccaforte** stole 2nd base in the 1st inning, his 30th steal of the Minor League season to become just the 28th Minor League player since 1948 and the first in the Royals system to reach that milestone ... with 25 doubles, 35 homers and 30 steals, he needs 5 doubles over the final 5 games to be just the THIRD 30/30/30 player in the Minors since 2005.
- Brett Squires** and **Carson Roccaforte** have already achieved 20/20/20 seasons, as both have 20+ doubles, home runs and steals when combining their Double-A and Triple-A numbers ... with 18 doubles, 17 homers and 25 steals, **Gavin Cross** needs 2 doubles and 3 homers in the final 5 games to join the pair.
- The 2026 Storm Chasers are on pace to break the franchise record for doubles in a season ... in 141 games, the 2026 Chasers have 281 doubles (1.99 doubles/game) and need 7 over the final 5 games to set a new club record.
- Squires sits just outside Omaha's single-season top-10 in home runs ... he needs 3 over the final 5 games to join a 4-way tie for 9th (28, last done by **Brewer Hicklen** in 2022), but is still 18 shy of **Chris Hatcher**'s franchise record (46, 1998).

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest starts to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) ... but in his last 77 games (since May 16), he's hitting .295 (89-for-302), with 37 extra-base hits and 46 RBI, as well as 26 multi-hit games, including 17 of his last 39 games ... since May 16, Cross is 4th in the IL in SLG (.543), 7th in total bases (164), tied 8th in extra-base hits (37), 9th in AVG (.295) and tied 9th in home runs (17).
- July 2 to 28, Cross produced a career-best 19-game hitting streak, Omaha's longest since 2018, and since July 2, his .620 SLG is 3rd in the IL and his .953 OPS is 6th ... he homered in a club record 6 straight games July 22 to 28 and has 12 homers in 27 games since July 22, tied for the 3rd-most homers in the IL in that span.

EXTRA, EXTRA BASES, READ ALL ABOUT IT

- A pair of Storm Chasers hitters that started the year in Double-A currently rank among the top Minor League hitters this year in extra-base hits and total bases.
- Among all Minor League hitters this year, **Brett Squires** is tied 3rd in extra-base hits (68) while **Carson Roccaforte** is tied 6th (65) ... Roccaforte is 3rd in the Minors in total bases (275) while Squires is tied 9th (266) ... Roccaforte also ranks tied 7th in the Minors in home runs (35) while Squires is 15th in RBI (101).
- Despite spending the first 6 weeks of the season in Double-A, Squires is 5th in the International League this season in extra-base hits (51) and tied 5th in home runs (25) ... among IL qualifiers (2.7 PA/G), he is 2nd in SLG (.571) and 3rd in OPS (.911).

GETTING OFFENSIVE

Beyond the hitters scattered across the league leaders, a pair of other Storm Chasers hitters find themselves in especially strong stretches.

- In 35 games since joining Omaha (July 22), **Alejo Lopez** is hitting .311 (33-for-106) with 14 RBI ... Lopez did not strike out in his first 9 games with the Chasers, from July 23 to August 2 and has drawn more walks (11) than he has strikeouts (10), the best walk-to-strikeout ratio (1.10) among 16 Chasers with 30+ PA since July 22.
- Over his last 35 games (since July 24), **Peyton Wilson** is hitting .301 (37-for-123) with 11 doubles, 5 homers and 17 RBI ... his 5 homers in the last 35 games come after he did not homer in his first 50 of the season with Omaha ... Wilson has reached base safely in 14 straight games (since August 23), a stretch where he has a .443 on-base percentage with 9 walks and 16 hits over the 14 games.

TODAY'S START

- ✓ Tony Gonsolin is making his **4th start with the Storm Chasers** this year, his **4th overall appearance in 2026** ... he was assigned to Omaha on August 26 to begin a Major League rehab assignment, as he works back from **right elbow surgery**.
- ✓ Playing his **11th professional season** this year, the Royals are his 2nd MLB organization ... he was drafted by and has played parts of 6 Major League seasons with the Dodgers (2019-23, 2025).
- ✓ Gonsolin will be making his 4th career start against Iowa and his 9th lifetime appearance against the Cubs and their affiliates ... his first rehab start of this season came in Des Moines on August 26, with 2 previous starts in 2019 while with Oklahoma City in the Dodgers organization.

ARSENAL
