GET THE LO DOWN: Brewers' no. 12-rated prospect Logan Henderson puts his seven-game winning streak with the Sounds on the line on Thursday night. The right-hander has won 10 straight overall this season including his first three starts this year with the Brewers. His seven wins are tied for the most in Triple-A and he's one of 19 pitchers in the minors with 7+ wins.

ZERO, NADA, ZILCH: Nashville pitched their way to their 11th shutout win of the year on Tuesday night for back-to-back nine-inning shutouts for the second time this year. The Sounds are tied for the lead in the minors in shutouts this season and the 11 shutouts are already tied for the fourth-most in a single-season for the Sounds dating back to 2005. The team had 12 shutouts in 2006, 2012, and most recently in 2021.

THREE BONES: Bobby Dalbec continued his hot stretch at the plate, turning in another three-hit game for the Sounds. It was his third-straight multi-hit game. It's the second time this season that he has had multi-hit games in three consecutive games with his last coming April 16-20 when he was playing against the Sounds with Triple-A Charlotte. Wednesday night was his third 3+ hit performance in his last six games. Through 14 games in June, Dalbec is slashing .333/.407/.706 with a 1.113 OPS and has 14 RBI in his 14 games.

SAY IT AINT SO: Tyler Jay saw his 15 game, 17.0 IP streak without an earned run come to an end on Wednesday night. The 15 games and 17.0 IP were both tops on the team this year and his 15 games were the second-longest active streak going in the International League behind Iowa's Riley Martin who has yet to throw in this series. Jay's streak was also tied for the fourth-longest by a pitcher in the minors this year. It was the first loss of the season for Jay and his first loss since July 9, 2024, while he was with Triple-A Syracuse. Through 21.0 IP and 21 appearances, Jay owns a 0.86 ERA and has allowed just three runs (2 ER) on 13 hits. He is second on the team in appearances this year behind Jesus Liranzo (22 G).

RISP IT TO GET THE BISCUIT: Nashville ended the night 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position and 11 left on base. Through 67 games, Nashville is hitting .255 with RISP (T-13th in the IL). After leaving the bases-loaded in the bottom of the sixth the Sounds are hitting .250 (16-for-64) with 20 strikeouts. The 494 batters left on base this season ranks 11th in the IL.

WELCOME HOME: Andrew Vaughn suited up for the Sounds for the first time since being traded to the Brewers from the Chicago White Sox last Friday as part of the Aaron Civale trade. The former no. 3-overall pick in the 2019 MLB Draft made his first hit with the Sounds a memorable one with his seventh-inning grand slam. It's just the second grand slam hit by a Nashville player this year and the first since Daz Cameron hit one on April 19th on the road in Charlotte. He followed up a career-high 21 home runs for the White Sox in 2023 with another 19 during the 2024 season. Tuesday night was his second career professional grand slam and his first since September 18, 2022, against the Detroit Tigers.

QUALITY CONTROL: RHP Tobias Myers earned his first Triple-A win this year on Tuesday and his first win since May 5th against the Houston Astros. It was his second quality start in his last three outings after also spinning one on June 5th against Gwinnett when he worked 6.0 IP with three runs allowed. The six scoreless he gave the Sounds on Tuesday night were the most he has gone in a start without a run since working 7.1 IP scoreless on August 10, 2024, against the Reds and it was the 12th scoreless quality start of his career.

ALL GOOD THINGS: Anthony Seigler's 35-game on-base streak came to an end on Tuesday night after going 0-for-4 with a strikeout. It ended tied for the fourth-longest on-base streak in the minor leagues so far this season and the fifth-longest by a Nashville player since 2013. During his streak which began on April 25th, Seigler ranked second in the International League with his .376 AVG and also led the league in SLG (.658), OPS (1.161), and OBP (.503). He was T-4th in stolen bases (14), and triples (3), T-5th in runs (32), T-6th in the league in walks (28), and 9th in total bases (77).

- Currently ranked as the no. 12-ranked prospect in the Brewers top 30...no. 2-ranked RHP behind Jacob Misiorowski.
- Made his Major League debut in 2025 and tossed a quality start in his first career start (6.0 IP, 3 H, ER, HR, 9 K, BB) against the Athletics...Through first four MLB starts is 3-0 with a 1.71 ERA (14 H, 4 ER, 29 K, 6 BB)...One of two MLB pitchers since 1901 to have struck out at least 29 and allowed four or fewer runs through first four MLB starts...Joined fellow Brewer Freddy Peralta (per Brewers' beat writer Curt Hogg).
- Got a late start to his 2024 season after injuring his oblique during the 2024 Spring Breakout Game...Made his season debut on May 9th in the Arizona Complex League.
- Earned Southern League Pitcher of the Month as well as Brewers Minor League Pitcher of the Month in June 2024 after going 4-0 with a 1.66 ERA in four starts...Held opposing hitter to a .192 AVG and matched his single-game career-high with 10 strikeouts in two of his outings (6/15 vs. TEN and 6/28 vs. PNS).
- From the time of his first start with High-A Wisconsin on May 24th until he was promoted to Nashville (8/8) he led the Brewers farm system with his 78 strikeouts.
- Made his Triple-A debut on August 9th and allowed one run on three hits over 4.0 IP but took the loss...Tossed a quality start in his second game vs. DUR (6.0 IP, 0 R, 8 K, 3 H).
- Finished the 2024 season 8th in the Milwaukee farm system in strikeouts (104) and was T-8th in wins (7)...Added to the Brewers 40-man roster on November 19th. 35.2% strikeout rate was fourth best among 661 minor leaguers with at least 70.0 IP in 2023.
- Missed the majority of 2022 after undergoing non-Tommy John elbow surgery in the spring.
- Pitched one season at McLennan CC in Texas and was named NJCAA Division I Pitcher of the Year after going 10-2 with a 1.66 ERA in 17 games (14 GS)...Led NJCAA DI in strikeouts (169) and IP (97.2)...Struck out 17 over 8.0 IP with one run allowed to guide the Highlanders to their first championship since 1983.
