PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS PITCH, PLEASE!

The last two games are two of Omaha's best-pitched games of the season.

- Back-to-back shutout wins are the first for Omaha since the team had 3 straight shutout wins in August 2018, 8/7 vs. Salt Lake and 8/9 & 8/10 @ Round Rock (32.0 IP).
- A 1-hitter in yesterday's win was Omaha's first since August 26, 2019 vs. Nashville, a 5-0 win that featured 8.0 innings from Arnaldo Hernandez and 1.0 from Gabe Speier.
- 19 consecutive scoreless innings from Omaha's pitchers entering today's game marks the team's longest since a 20-inning stretch in 2022, June 29 (6th inning) to July 1 (8th inning) ... last year's longest scoreless streak was 15.0 innings.

IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 27 games over .500 with a 66-39 record (.629 winning percentage).

- 66 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 68 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .629 winning percentage overall this year is the 4th-best the Minors ... the top team in Minor League Baseball is Sugar Land (.68-38 / .642).
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 93 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

65 of Omaha's 105 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 24 of 39 losses in 2024, with 13 of 39 losses by just one run (33%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 11 of its last 21 save opportunities, since June 5 (52%).
- Omaha is 20-13 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 6th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Hartford has 22 wins by 1 run this year.
- As a team, Omaha's 31 saves are the most in the league, 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 5th in the Minor Leagues ... **Evan Sisk** has recorded the team's last 5 saves, but 7 different Storm Chasers arms have 2 or more saves this year.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT (IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 576 to 479 this season, a +97 run differential.

- A +95 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both the International League and at the Triple-A level, ahead of the Syracuse Mets (+87).
- Omaha is 8th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers lead the Minors at +156 (536 to 380).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 36 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 14 of the 35 comeback wins, with 6 victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 9 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 10 occasions.
- 2 of Omaha's 7 comeback wins in July were games where they trailed for over half of the game ... by 8.5 innings July 21 vs. Indianapolis and 5.5 innings July 23 @ St. Paul.

RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.35 ERA and 216/.325/.353 opposing slash line ... a 3.79 bullpen ERA ranks 2nd in Triple-A.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 27 games this year, roughly one in every 4.89 games ... the bullpen also has 17 games without a walk as a relief corps, including 5 of the team's last 9 games.

TODAY'S START

- Marsh is making his **2nd start with Omaha**, his **21st overall start** this season and his **22nd appearance in 2024** ... he opened the year as the 5th starter in Kansas City's rotation and made a rehab start with Omaha in May ... Marsh was optioned to Triple-A July 31, when Lucas Erceg was activated by Kansas City.
- Royals manager Matt Quatraro told reporters this week Marsh will throw 40-60 pitches per outing in order to reduce his workload ... he is still going to start, but the plan is to back off his innings a bit so he stays fresh for when needed in the Majors.
- Among Kansas City pitchers, ranks 4th in strikeouts (93), tied 4th in starts (19) and 5th in innings pitched (101.1)

LAST OUTING: MONDAY, JULY 29 @ CHICAGO (AL)

Made his 20th Major League appearance of the season, his last outing before being optioned ... three singles scored a run in the 1st inning ... worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... pitched around a two-out double in the 3rd inning ... pitched a 1-2-3 inning in the 4th ... got two outs in the 5th, but two hits batters, a walk and an RBI single ended his day ... exited in a tie game, got a no-decision.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Won the fifth starting pitcher spot in Kansas City's rotation in Spring Training, pitched to a 3.57 ERA (7 ER in 17.2 IP) with 20 strikeouts in 6 Cactus League appearances (2 starts) ... allowed 1 run on 5 hits with 12 strikeouts through his first 4 outings (10.0 IP).
