GETTING BACK IN THE WIN COLUMN: The Storm Chasers won their second game on this seasonlong 12-game road trip yesterday. The game was the first time on the road trip that Omaha trailed after the first inning, previously outscoring opponents 13-1 in the first inning. The Storm Chasers shut the Bats out for the final nine innings of the game with **LHP Drew Parrish** going 6.0 innings, his second consecutive quality start on this road trip. One day after **LHP Sam Freeman** allowed the walk-off win, he bounced back and earned his first save with the Storm Chasers yesterday, throwing a perfect 10th inning. Omaha also came back to win for just the fourth time on the road this season, and the first road win of the season when trailing after the seventh inning. The 10-inning win was the first road win in extra innings, bringing their season record in extra-inning games to 3-3.

GETTING HOT: C Freddy Fermin has had a quietly impressive start to the month, now riding a 13game on-base streak, the eighth longest active streak in the league. During the streak that started on August 3, Fermin is hitting .340 with a .426 on-base percentage. He has hit two home runs and four doubles with five RBIs and a 1-to-1 walk-to strikeout ratio, seven walks and seven strikeouts during the streak. Fermin is looking to hit above .300 in a single month for the first time this season, hitting .296 in April as his best month to date.

RUNNING WILD: The Storm Chasers stole four bases yesterday, now with 137 stolen bases this season. The 137 steals are now just four behind Buffalo's 141 for most in the International League. Omaha holds the best stolen base percentage in the league, stealing successfully on 85.6 percent of their attempts. **OF Dairon Blanco** swiped his 29th base last night, now tied for the second most in the International League. **OF Brewer Hicklen** stole his 25th base of the season, the seventh most in the league.

MAKING A SPLASH: OF Drew Waters hit his seventh home run for the Storm Chasers last night, a two-run shot in the top of the 10th to give Omaha the lead. The blast was Waters' second homer of the series, starting the series on Tuesday with a first-inning leadoff homer. In his first 29 games with the Storm Chasers, Waters has stolen 12 bases (12-for-12) and has had more multi-hit games (nine) than no-hit games (eight). He is hitting .298 with Omaha after getting traded from the Braves' organization on July 11.

GETTING ON BASE: OF Brewer Hicklen extended his on-base streak to 21 games last night, the second longest active on-base streak in the International League. Louisville's Spencer Steer holds the longest active streak at 28 games. Hicklen's streak started on July 26, and he has an on-base percentage of .333 with five home runs, 12 walks, and 10 RBIs. He needs to reach base in his next two games to tie **INF Michael Massey's** 23-game on-base streak for the longest by a Storm Chaser this season.

FOR OMAHA: LHP Austin Cox takes the ball to make his team-leading 20th start and 23rd overall appearance of the season for the Storm Chasers. In his last start, Cox went 5.0 innings and allowed four earned runs on eight hits and three walks with three strikeouts. Cox, with today's start, will become the ninth pitcher to start 20 or more games in the International League. The 6-foot 4-inch left-hander has four quality starts this season, but his most recent came on June 23 against Columbus. Cox has made four appearances against Louisville this season with three starts and one relief outing, holding a 3.63 ERA and 0-1 record against the Bats this season.

FOR LOUISVILLE: RHP Deck McGuire gets the nod to make his 11th start and 14th overall appearance for the Bats. In his last start, McGuire went 4.0 innings and allowed two earned runs on four hits and two walks with three strikeouts. His longest outing of the season came back in June, a 5.2-inning start when he allowed one earned run and struck out a season-high six batters against Charlotte. McGuire holds a 8.55 ERA at home, allowing opponents to hit .289 with a 1.70 WHIP inside of Louisville Slugger Field. McGuire started the season in independent ball, not having played affiliated baseball since the 2018 season. In the gap, he spent time playing in South Korea and China.
