

TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: The Curve wrap up their first road trip of the season, a six-game series at Akron with the Cleveland Guardians affiliate. Akron is loaded with returners like RHP Aaron Davenport and Tommy Mace in the rotation along with INF CJ Kayfus and OF Joe Lampe. INF Travis Bazzana, the No. 1 overall pick in 2024 out of Oregon State, highlights their prospect group. Bazzana was born in Austrailia and made history with Chase Burns (Italy, selected No.2 overall by Cincinnati) as the first pair to be born overseas and selected at the top of the draft.

On the mound, Rorik Maltrud makes his second start of the series. Altoona knocked him out in the first inning on Tuesday night tagging him for 2 runs in 0.2 IP. A 25-year-old from Austin, TX, Maltrud joined the Guardians in January of 2024 after his well-traveled collegiate career at Oklahoma (Fall only, 2018), Grayson CC (19-20), New Mexico State (21-22) and Missouri (2023). He turned in a fine pro debut at Lake County and Lynchburg, recording a 3.44 ERA in 24 games, 19 starts.

A YOUNG MAN'S GAME: Infielder Termarr Johnson became the third-youngest player to suit up for the Curve, behind Jose Tabata and Andrew McCutchen who were both 19 years old when they debuted for the Curve, when he arrived on August 27, 2024 in Curve, PA. This season, <u>Johnson opens as the youngest in the Eastern League at 20 years old, just two days younger</u> than Reading's Aidan Miller. Among Double-A players, he is the 7th-youngest player at the level; the youngest is San Antonio's Ethan Salas (SD, 18.8 years old).

Johnson's 85 walks last season were 9th-most by a minor league player and <u>he's reached base safely in 15-of-20 games with</u> the Curve. Johnson has a hit in all 6 games he's played this year, he recorded his first multi-hit game of the season on Satur-day, going 2-for-5 with an RBI at Akron.

OUT FOR A WALK: Altoona hitters are 2nd among all Double-A clubs with 44 walks in their first 8 games of the season. It is the 10th-most among non-Triple-A clubs who have each played 6 more games.

ACROSS THE BOW: Outfielder Jase Bowen has gotten off to a strong start at the plate, batting .273 (6-for-22) with 1 2B, 1 HR, 3 RBI and 2-2 SB in his first 7 games. Perhaps most encouraging, he has showed a renewed sense of discipline at the plate, earning 5 walks; tied for the 2nd-most on the club and giving him a .414 on-base percentage through play on April 12.

CLOSING TIME: In his first season in the Pirates organization, righty Cam Sanders has earned both of the Curve's early season save opportunities - converting both with 5 strikeouts in 3.0 total innings. Sanders, who touched 99 with his fastball on a brutally cold night on Thursday, April 10, has earned 13 career saves after converting to the bullpen in 2022 in the Chicago Cubs system.

RAISIN BRAN: Infielder Jack Brannigan has reached base safely in 6-of-8 games played for the Curve this season and has a hit in 3-of-5 games played this week.

IT'S ABOUT HOW YOU START: Curve starters tossed 15 scoreless innings to begin the season (Barco, Dotel, Solometo, Chen). Overall, Curve starters have a 0.87 WHIP, 1st among Double-A staffs and 2.23 ERA, 2nd among Double-A clubs.

2024 IN REVIEW: The Curve totaled a 62-76 mark during the 2024 season, marking the 11th time in franchise history that Altoona finished with a record under .500. Since the cancelled 2020 season, Altoona has had a winning record just one time (2022) in four seasons. Returners **Kervin Pichardo** (Team MVP) and **Sammy Siani** (Unsung Hero) return to the Curve lineup.

PROSPECT PARTY: Seven Curve players are ranked among the Pirates Top 30 according to MLB Pipeline and Baseball America. Termarr Johnson (No. 4 MLB/No. 5 BA) headlines the group, which also features LHP **Hunter Barco** (No. 7/No. 10), INF **Jack Brannigan** (No. 11/No. 14), INF/OF **Mitch Jebb** (No. 13/No. 14), LHP **Anthony Solometo** (No. 14/No. 15), RHP **Ales**sandro Ercolani (No. 21 BA), RHP Wilber Dotel (No. 27 BA).

THE TRACKS TO PITTSBURGH RIDE THROUGH ALTOONA: Three Curve alums, RHP Thomas Harrington (4/1, PIT), LHP Omar Cruz (4/1, SD), and INF Tsung-Che Cheng (4/9, PIT) have all made their major league debut this season, totaling 220 alumni who have gone onto the major leagues.

WE'LL SEE THEM ALL: For the first time since the 2019 season and the creation of the six-game series, the Curve will face every team in the Eastern League this season. Altoona will face New Hampshire and Binghamton on the road only, while Hartford and Reading will only play the Curve at PNG Field.

2025: Assigned to Altoona to begin the season...

2024: Made every turn in the Altoona rotation, finishing the season 7th in Eastern League in ERA (4.03), and Innings Pitched (134.0)... Tied for the lead among PIT MiLB with 25 starts (Wilber Dotel, GBO), also ranked 1st in IP (134.0), 7th in Strikeouts (96)... Named to Altoona's Opening Day roster for his Double-A debut... Changed number from #35 to #45 on 4/25... Completed 5.0 IP for the first time on 5/3 at HBG... Faced fellow Taiwanese prospect Hao-Yu Lee on 5/21 @ Erie (Lee lined into DP in 1st and homered in 3rd), did so again on 5/26 (struck him out looking and walked)... Pitched opposite fellow Taiwanese pitching prospect CJ Liu on 6/1 vs. Portland... Earned his first Double-A win with a career-long 8.0 innings, struck out a season-high 9 batters, on 6/7 @ Richmond... Finished 7.0 innings for the 7th time in his career on 6/29 vs. Akron... Fired 7.0 innings in 3 straight starts 6/29 - 7/11... May 25 - August 1: 4-3, 2.43 ERA (23 ER / 74.0 IP), in 12G/11 starts, 1.08 WHIP, 60 strikeouts, dropped season ERA from 5.72 to 3.62...

**2023:** Spent the entire season with High-A Greensboro... Finished the season fourth among Pirates minor leaguers in IP (119.2), also ranked fifth in strikeouts (124)... Led the South Atlantic League in games started (24) which was also fifth among Pirates minor leaguers... Also ranked third in the South Atlantic League in ERA (4.44) and innings pitched, tied for fifth in WHIP (1.28)...

**CURVE CUTS:** Po-Yu Chen... Was a member of the 2019 U-18 world-champion Taiwanese national team, where he started two games against Panama and Korea during the tournament; also earned a save in the gold medal game against the United States... Was rated as the 22nd-best international prospect for the 2019-20 signing period according to Fangraphs... Signed for \$1,250,000, one of the largest amounts in the 2019-20 International signing class for the Pirates... Pittsburgh was able to secure his services after trading for International Bonus Pool money in deals that sent Domingo Robles to St. Louis and Jarrod Dyson to the Chicago White Sox... Would be just the 12th pitcher from Taiwan to reach the major leagues... His father Ping-Nan Chen played professionally in the Chinese Professional Baseball League... Attended the National Taiwan Sport University, same preparatory school that former Curve C Jin-De Jhang, former Richmond Flying Squirrel RHP Kai-Wei Teng and Orioles/Marlins LHP Wei-Yin Chen attended... Grew up approximately 10 minutes away from INF Hao-Yu Lee (DET/PHI) and played with and against him many times growing up, the two first faced each other in 2023 in the South Atlantic League when Lee was playing for Jersey Shore (Phillies, A+)... 

Andy Fox Manager (1st Season) Career Record: 45-94

Andy Fox is the 16th manager in Curve history. Fox's coaching ca-reer has seen him serve in several roles, including time with the Rang-ers, Mariners, Marlins, and Red Sox. He spent the last 14 years in Boston's system, serving as the team's infield coordinator and first base coach. Prior to his time in Boston, Fox served as a first base coach for the Marlins and managed the Rangers Single-A Clinton team in 2006. Fox was drafted in the 2nd round of the 1989 Draft by the Yankees and won two World Series in his nineyear Major League career with New York (1996) and the Florida Marlins (2003) as an infielder.

#### Matt Ford **Pitching Coach** 1st season/12th overall

Ford joins the Curve in 2025 after serving as the Pitching Coach for Low-A Bradenton in 2024. This is his 12th season serving as an in-structor in the Pirates system, pre-viously serving in the FCL (2022), Greensboro (2021), as the team's Rehab Pitching Coordinator (2019-20), Bradenton (2017-18), both West Virginia clubs (2015-2016) as well as with Bristol (2014). Ford was Toronto's third round pick in 1999 and made his Major League debut with the Brewers in 2003. He pitched in 25 games and made four starts in his lone Major League season. He began his coaching career at the University of Akron in 2012.
