#### PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

#### NOTES AND NUGGETS

##### IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings re-set for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game with the best overall record in Minor League Baseball, 25 games over .500 with a 52-27 record (.658 winning%).

- 52 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind the 53-win Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Astros Triple-A).
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .658 winning percentage overall this year is also the best, just ahead of Sugar Land (53-28 / .654).
- Omaha has held the best record in Minor League Baseball for 26 days, since June 5 ... the Chasers have been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25.

##### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

51 of Omaha's 79 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less, including 18 of 26 losses in 2024.

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 5 of its last 11 save opportunities.
- Omaha is 17-8 in 1-run games this season, the most wins in 1-run games of any Minor League team ... the Storm Chasers have won 10 of their last 15 games decided by just a run.
- As a team, Omaha's 25 saves are the 4th-most of any Minor League team and second in Triple-A ... **Will Klein's** 9 saves individually rank 3rd in the International League, while six Storm Chasers players have 2 or more saves this year.

##### I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 445 to 359 this season, a +86 run differential.

- A +86 run differential is the 2nd-best in the International League and at the Triple-A level, just behind the Syracuse Mets (+95).
- Omaha ranks 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Modesto Nuts lead the Minors at +146 (489 to 343).

##### COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 29 come-from-behind wins from this season, meaning over half (56%) of this year's wins have been comeback victories.

- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as five runs to win and 10 times, have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win.
- Omaha has trailed for three innings or more in 11 of the 28 comeback wins, with five victories where the club had to overcome multiple deficits ... the team has 8 wins in games where they trailed after the 6th inning.

##### DAZZLING DEFENSE

Omaha's defense has had its ups and downs this season, but the team is on one of its best stretches in the field this season.

- Over Omaha's last 19 games (since June 9), a .988 fielding percentage (8 E in 623 TC) is the 2nd-best in Minor League Baseball over that span.
- Early in the season, the Storm Chasers went 7 straight games without making an error, March 31 to April 7, that included all 6 games of a series at Columbus, April 3 to April 7.

##### RELIEF AID

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the best across the entire Triple-A level in 2024.

- The Storm Chasers relievers lead all Triple-A bullpens with a 1.32 WHIP and an opposing slash line of .207/.320/.348 ... the .207 opponents' average is tied for the 3rd-best in the Minors ... a 3.62 ERA ranks 2nd in the International League.
- Omaha's bullpen has combined to not allow a run in 19 games this year, roughly one in every 4.16 games.
- Since June 14, Omaha's bullpen has a 2.82 ERA (19 ER in 60.2 IP), the 2nd-best in Triple-A in that 16-game stretch.
- Walter Pennington's** 75 strikeouts (in 31 games/2 starts) are tied for the 9th-most in the International League ... his 35.7% strikeout rate is 8th in MiLB (min. 50.0 IP).
- Noah Murdock** made his Triple-A debut just under three weeks ago in Toledo and since arriving to the Storm Chasers, has thrown 8.0 scoreless innings over 7 appearances ... since June 11, he has allowed 2 hits and 3 walks with 9 strikeouts.
