**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, opening up a six-game set at Bowie.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Matt Fraizer swatted a two-run homer, but Altoona managed just one baserunner over the final 3.0 innings in a 5-4 loss to Erie.

**THE STARTER IS THE CLOSER:** Twice during their the series with Erie, Altoona got a complete game win from a starting pitcher. On Friday, August 11, Aaron Shortridge tossed his second career complete game, the first 9-inning complete game for Altoona since Domingo Robles on August 26, 2019 turned the trick against Akron. Shortridge allowed six hits, including an unearned run in the ninth inning, did not walk a batter and struck out seven on a season-high 103 pitches. Earlier in the week, right-hander Sean Sullivan tossed the first 7.0 inning complete game for Altoona since June 8, 2019 (Domingo Robles 7.0 inning shutout of the Akron RubberDucks in the first of a doubleheader) on Wednesday, August 9 against Erie. Working in the first game of a doubleheader with the SeaWolves, Sullivan scattered seven hits and two runs in 4-2 Curve victory.

**SMASHYCRAFT:** Limited to shorter outings in his return from Tommy John surgery, RHP Braxton Ashcraft has been dominant in eight starts with Altoona, he has a 1.35 ERA (3 ER / 20.0 IP) with the Curve and features a 2.39 ERA (14 ER / 52.2 IP) this season with Bradenton, Greensboro and Altoona.

**OUR OWN HOWLER:** Left-hander Jackson Wolf, acquired from the San Diego Padres in the Rich Hill and Ji Man Choi deal, has continued to be one of Double-A's best strikeout artists this season. He's struck out 11 in two starts with Altoona in 8.0 innings giving him 116 this season between San Antonio and Altoona, the 11th-most strikeouts by a pitcher at the level.

**IT'S OFFICIALLY GEN Z:** Infielder Tsung-Che Cheng owns the Eastern League's longest hit streak this season at 17 games, a streak that ended on August 11 against Erie. Cheng's tied Kevin Newman for the seventh-longest in franchise history, falling a few games short of Austin Meadows' 24-game hit streak in 2016 that stands as the franchise record. Cheng batted .393/.415/.574/.989 with 5 2B, 2 HR, 9 RBI, 3 BB, 9 K and 3-3 SB during his streak. Cheng's 10 triples this season are the most in minor league baseball. Chattanooga's Alex McGarry holds the longest hit streak in Double-A this season at 18 games.

**PLAY THE SONG!** With Connor Scott's walk-off walk on August 1 against Richmond, he earned his third career walk-off RBI for Altoona in two seasons with the Curve. Brock Holt holds the franchise record for most walk-off RBI's with four across 2011 and 2012. Scott is the first Curve player with two walk-off RBI's in the same season since Elvis Escobar in 2017.

**THE BIG LEFTY:** Lefty Anthony Solometo is the youngest pitcher to reach the Eastern League this season, doing so at 20 years, 6 months and 15 days when he made his debut on June 17 at Somerset. Solometo is the 13th player in franchise history to suit up for the Curve under the age of 21 and slots in as the 5th-youngest player in the team's history between C Ryan Doumit, who was 20 years, 4 months, 0 days old when he debuted on August 3, 2001, and LHP Sean Burnett, who was 20 years, 6 months, 18 days old when he debuted on April 4, 2003.

Solometo leads all qualified Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.99 ERA and ranks 3rd with 105 strikeouts this season. He is one of 8 players to play in the EL at age 20 or younger, Harrisburg has two of them: Brady House and James Wood. Jackson Holliday (BOW), Jasson Dominguez (SOM), Yanquel Fernandez (HFD), Blaze Jordan (POR) and Marcelo Mayer (POR) are the other players in the league that are not permitted to drink alcohol.

**STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE:** Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Sunday, August 13, Altoona has struck out 842 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 4th-fewest in minor league baseball. Altoona's franchise record for fewest strikeouts in a season is 811 achieved in 2003 when the Curve struck out an average of 5.75 times per game. The 2023 Curve are striking out an average of 8.13 times per game.

**THE SOX BY THE BAY:** Managed by Kyle Moore, the Baysox feature a bevy of top Orioles prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No. 1 INF Jackson Holliday, No. 9 OF Dylan Beavers, No. 14 OF Jud Fabian, No. 15 INF Max Wagner, No. 21 OF John Rhodes, No. 28 OF Billy Cook, and No. 30 RHP Alex Pham.

**THE FIRST TO SOCK:** RHP John Means takes the ball in his rehab from Tommy John surgery. Means was an AL All-Star with Baltimore in 2019 when he finished second in the AL Rookie of the Year voting with a 3.60 ERA in 27 starts. He holds a career 3.81 ERA in 70 MLB games, 26 starts. Means was Baltimore's 11th round pick in 2014 out of West Virginia University and pitched for the Baysox as a minor leaguer from 2016-18 totaling a 4.32 ERA in 49 starts. He's pitched on rehab twice for Bowie since, in 2021 and last week when he tossed 2.0 scoreless innings.

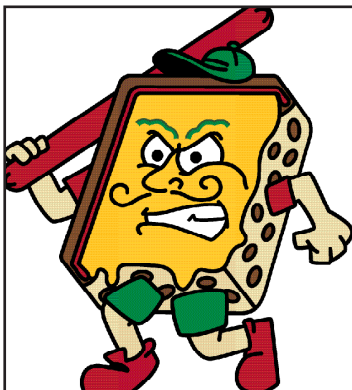

## PIZZA MIA!



The Curve will re-brand as the Altoona Pizzas during the week of August 8-13. The Altoona-Style Pizza connects its origins to the Altoona Hotel, a small-town establishment that first opened its doors as a 30-room hotel in the 1900s. In its later years, the Hotel operated only as a small restaurant. The Altoona Pizza is crafted on a Sicilian-style pizza dough and topped with tomato sauce, green bell peppers, salami, and a single slice of yellow American cheese. The square-style cut is believed to have been first served sometime in the 1960s or 70s. For decades, it was exclusively offered by the Altoona Hotel, until in 2013, when the building was destroyed by a fire and never rebuilt. Other establishments around the community have since added the recipe to their menus to carry on the tradition. The jerseys will be auctioned off via the Live-Source App, with proceeds benefitting the Blair County Suicide Prevention Task Force, American Foundation for Suicide Prevention, and Blair County System of Care.
