**PLAYOFF BASEBALL IS COMING BACK TO THE BURG:** After winning the first three games of the series and locking up the second half playoff berth in the North last night, the FredNats return to action today on Firework Friday with Travis Sykora going on the mound for FXBG. Sykora was just named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month in August, and his dominance is noted below. He faces Lynchburg righty Jogley Garcia as the Hillcats try to avoid a fourth straight loss at Virginia Credit Union Stadium.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** Fredericksburg got going early once again when Caleb Lomavita knocked in two runs with a broken bat single in the first inning, and FredNat pitching set down the final 20 Hillcat hitters in a row to cruise to a 4-1 victory. Salem's extra innings loss to Kannapolis later on last night clinched the playoff spot for the Freddies. Seaver King picked up a late RBI single to pad the lead, and the FreddNat bullpen did not allow a base runner all night.

**PLAYOFF SCHEDULE:** With three games remaining in the regular season, the first round playoff matchups are set in both divisions of the Carolina League. As the second half champion, Fredericksburg will host Carolina in game one of the best-of-three series on Tuesday, and then travel to Five County Stadium for game two on Thursday and game three if necessary on Friday. If FXBG advances, they would play a road game on Sunday, September 15 at the winner of the Kannapolis/Charleston series, and then would host game two and three if necessary of the championship series.

**HE'S SOMETHING ELSE:** Travis Sykora has proven to be one of the most dominant pitchers in the Carolina League since arriving in Fredericksburg on May 1. In August alone, Sykora made six starts, going 4-0 with an 0.88 ERA. In 30.2 innings pitched, he struck out 49 hitters (11 more than the second-best pitcher) and walked just three the entire month. He was named Washington's FredNat Pitcher of the Month for August (duh), and today was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for August by MiLB. Not only did he dominate in August, but among MiLB pitchers with at least 80 innings pitched this year at any level, Sykora leads all of MiLB in strikeout percentage (39.9%), WHIP (0.83) and is second in strikeout-to-walk percentage (32.3%), and FIP (1.78).

**HARDWARE FOR THE KING:** Seaver King was named the Carolina League's Player of the Week for his efforts in Kannapolis, going 9-for-22 with two triples, three RBIs and three walks for an OPS of 1.071. King becomes the fourth FredNat to win a Player of the Week award.

**HE'S BACKKKK:** After winning Carolina League Player of the Month for April, Brandon Pimentel got back to early-season form in August. He continues to lead the Carolina League in RBI with 84, and in August, Pimentel slashed .316/.386/.494 for an OPS of .880. He drove in 19 runs in August as well, his most in a month since he knocked in a whopping 33 runs in April.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg. Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 213-174 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

**THE STAFF:** The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals. He was the Pitching Coach for the High-A Wilmington Blue Rocks in 2021 and the Double-A Harrisburg Senators in 2022 before coming to FXBG in 2023 and spending the last two seasons here.

Habas, 33, is in his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prairie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past three seasons. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with ZSP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh is also in his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

**A LASTING LEGACY:** The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Travis Sykora is making his 20th professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Lynchburg Hillcats. He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

**QUICK CLIMBER:** Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely. Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

**A BIG MENTOR:** Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

**WINNER WINNER:** Sykora was named the Carolina League Pitcher of the Month for August - he posted a 0.88 ERA in 30.2 IP, with a 48:4 K:BB ratio. He also leads ALL of MiLB in K% (39.9%), WHIP (0.83) and is second in FIP (1.78).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Sykora was up to his usual tricks with five shutout frames against Kannapolis, with nine strikeouts.
