STRIPERS EASE BY JUMBO SHRIMP, 10-5

Both Griffin Conine and Jonathan Davis finished a triple shy of the cycle on Wednesday, but Gwinnett rolled by Jacksonville 10-5. Conine's second-inning solo shot opened the scoring, but the Stripers gained a lead they would not relinquish in the third on Drake Baldwin's two-run home run. Gwinnett then rattled off five runs in the fourth inning, with the big blow coming on a three-run Nacho Alvarez Jr. home run. After the Stripers added another run in the fifth to go up 8-1, Jacksonville scored three times in the sixth. Davis' solo shot in the ninth set the score at 10-5.

AND SHE THINKS WE'RE JUST FISHIN'

Over the last 22 meetings between Jacksonville and Gwinnett dating back to 2023, the Stripers hold a narrow 12-10 advantage over the Jumbo Shrimp. Over these 12 contests, Gwinnett has outscored Jacksonville by a thin 92-84 margin. Sixteen of these 22 affairs have been determined by three runs or fewer; again, the Stripers own a 9-7 advantage in these closely-decided contests. With much else being equal over these 22 games, Gwinnett owns edges in stolen bases (24-13) and strikeouts (176-165). The Jumbo Shrimp own a very small advantage in home runs (18-17).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 48 of his last 55 games, notching 21 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 71-for-217 (.327/.397/.475/.871) with 17 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 35 RBIs, 26 walks and 27 runs scored.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine has been stellar since early May. Over his last 53 games, the Duke product is 58-for-187, slashing .310/.379/.615/.994 with 13 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 37 RBIs, 21 walks and 35 runs scored. Among the 116 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks eighth in HR/FB (27.0 percent). On the season, he ranks tied for sixth in the IL in extra-base hits (36), tied for ninth in home runs (17), 10th in SLG (.534), 16th in OPS (.893) and tied for 18th in hits (77).

GET PITCH OR DIE TRYIN'

Jacksonville has gone 16-12 in their last 28 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 19 of those 28 affairs (67.9 percent). Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in both fewest runs allowed (108) and ERA (3.53) while ranking third in WHIP (1.36), tied for fifth in fewest hits allowed (233) and sixth in both batting average against (.248) and OPS against (.746).

QUIT PLAYING GAMES WITH MY START

Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three earned runs or fewer in 23 of the last 27 games, with 19 of those starts resulting in two earned runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and nine being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 52 runs, 47 earned, on 112 hits (8.7 H/9) in 115.2 innings for a 3.66 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 107 strikeouts (8.3 K/9) against 48 walks (3.7 BB/9) during this stretch. Rather remarkably, the Jumbo Shrimp have started 14 different pitchers over these 27 contests.

SOULJA TROY

Heading into play on May 25, Troy Johnston, the reigning Marlins Minor League Player of the Year, was hitting just .240/.294/.316/.610 with only 12 doubles, one home run, 21 RBIs, nine walks and 16 runs scored in 48 games. However, over the last 39 contests, the Puyallup, Wash., native is a sizzling 50-for-147, slashing .340/.404/.531/.935 with nine doubles, two triples, five homers, 22 RBIs, 14 walks and 28 runs scored. Johnston has 11 multi-hit games in his last 20 contests and is the season's IL leader in hits (97) while also ranking tied for fourth in doubles (21).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's starting rotation ERA of 4.42 is tied with Memphis for the best all of Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp's lid-lifters have tossed 394.2 innings, which ranks eighth at the level... Jacksonville relievers have combined for a 4.34 ERA (seventh in Triple-A) in 384.0 innings, which represent the 16th-most at the level... The Jumbo Shrimp are 13-7 (.650) in their last 20 road games... Prior to making his MLB debut, Valente Bellozo was 1-1 with a 2.57 ERA in his last three Triple-A outings (14.0 IP, 13 H, BB, 13 K, .232 BAA).

ABOUT VALENTE

-Bellozo was originally signed by the Houston Astros as a non-drafted free agent on July 3, 2017.

-After reaching as high as Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was traded from Houston to the Miami Marlins on April 6, 2024 in exchange for infielder Jacob Amaya, who had recently been designated for assignment.

-Bellozo made his major league debut for the Marlins on June 18, 2024 against the Royals from Kauffman Stadium in Kansas City. He tossed 5.0 shutout innings, scattering two hits and a walk with two strikeouts.

-Bellozo has pitched for his hometown Aguilas de Mexicali of the Mexican Pacific League in each of the past two offseasons.

2024 SEASON

-Bellozo was promoted to Jacksonville from Double-A Pensacola on May 22. In his final start with the Blue Wahoos, the right-hander yielded just one run on two hits in a career-high 7.0 innings on May 16 at Montgomery. He struck out eight Biscuits without walking a batter.

-At the time of his promotion, among the 110 Southern League pitchers with at least 10.0 innings pitched, Bellozo ranked 24th in walk percentage (5.3 percent). He also ranked 14th in strikeouts (39) among qualified hurlers in the Southern League.

2023 SEASON

-In 11 games (seven starts) of the first half of the season with High-A Asheville, Bellozo went 2-2 with a 7.35 ERA (49.0 IP, 62 H, 14 BB, 51 K, .308 BAA). However, over 11 appearances (six starts) in the campaign's second half with the Tourists prior to his August 29 promotion to Double-A Corpus Christi, Bellozo was 1-1 with a 4.93 ERA (45.2 IP, 44 H, 12 BB, 43 K, .247 BAA).
