LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints were handed their first loss of the season as the staff issued a franchise record 20 walks, including a record 10 runs allowed in the sixth inning, as they fell 19-3 to the Worcester Red Sox in Tuesday's home opener. Worcester batted around twice, including sending 12 men to the plate and scoring eight runs on seven hits, including three homers, in the first. Christian MacLeod gave up a three-run blast to Allan Castro before striking out Tsung-Che Cheng, walking Jason Delay, and exiting after 38 pitches. Raul Brito followed by allowing a two-run shot off the batter's eye to Vinny Capra and Nick Sogard made it back-to-back shots and 8-0 before the Saints swung the bat. Orlando Arcia touched off for his first home run as a St. Paul Saint in the 2nd, but Worcester erased the marker in the third and scored 10 runs in the sixth, the most ever allowed in a single inning by the Saints. The 16-run deficit was St. Paul's largest-ever margin of defeat in franchise history.

GRIP IT AND RIP IT: The Saints offense still rank 3rd in the International League in batting average (.263, 35-133) and 7th in team OPS despite yesterday's lopsided scoreline, aided by Orlando Arica's home run and their nine walks drawn as a team. Kalen Culppepper and Ryan Kreidler each extended their hitting streaks to four straight games to open the season. While Emmanuel Rodriguez has been relatively quiet on the surface (4-17, 4 singles), the Twins' No. 2 prospect has already produced two of the top-30 hardest hit balls in the league this year, a 113.8 mph fly out on Friday in Indy & a 110.5 mph single blistered on Tuesday against Worcester. St. Paul rank 10th among 20 teams in the league in average exit velocity (87.8 mph).

"BALL FIVE, BALL SIX, BALL SEVEN...": Tuesday's contest featured 29 walks between both staffs, the most combined free passes in a Triple-A game since at least 2005 and the second-most base on balls featured in a game at the full-season level in that same span (The Jupiter Hammerheads & Dunedin Blue Jays combined for 32 walks in a game on April 8, 2025 last season). Of the 12 pitchers featured in the game, all but one issued at least one walk (Seth Martinez). There was at least one free pass issued in 15 of the 18 half-innings played, including multiple base on balls in eight of them.

VARIETY IS THE SPICE OF LIFE: In his first four games as Saints manager, Brian Dinkelman has turned in four unique lineup cards. Only Gabby Gonzalez has hit in the same spot in the lineup for three of the first four games, doing so in the 2-spot in each of the first three games in Indy before hitting third in the home opener on Tuesday.

IT'S GOOD TO BE HOME: The Saints are now 3-3 all-time in home openers as a Triple-A franchise, having won the season lid-lifter at CHS Field each of the previous two seasons, including an 11-0 rout of Indianapolis last year on March 28. Despite just a 62-85 record overall last season, the Saints were a respectable 36-38 on home turf. Since becoming a Triple-A franchise, the Saints' .551 winning% at home (199-162) is 7th among 30 Triple-A clubs. Only Nashville (MIL), Tacoma (SEA), Durham (TBR), Indianapolis (PIT), Scranton/Wilkes-Barre (NYY), & Toledo (DET) have won more home games than the Saints in that run.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints open the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culppepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they also tout four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. Jenkins, the Twins' consensus top prospect, became the youngest player in Saints franchise history when he debuted at 20 years, 6 months, and 7 days of age last year. After a 1-for-20 start, the North Carolina prep product hit .296 (21-71) with eight extra-base hits, including his first two Triple-A homers, in his last 17 games. Shortstop Kalen Culppepper, Minnesota's No. 2 prospect (MLB.com) and last year's Twins Minor League Player of the Year, will make his Triple-A debut on Opening Day. Prielipp, the Twins No. 4 (BA) prospect, returns in a Saints uniform after finishing last season in St. Paul. The remaining ranked prospects include Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). Left-hander Kendry Rojas (10/8) will also open the year on the Saints' injured list, but is expected to join the rotation with the first few weeks.

YOU'RE A SAINT: The Saints Opening Day roster features 16 players that saw action in a St. Paul uniform previously and 12 new faces in their first year in St. Paul. Among the 16 returners, 14 played for the Saints last season with catcher David Banuelos and Matt Bowman also returning to St. Paul after stints with other organizations. Among the 12 new players, only Kaelen Culppepper does not have previous Triple-A experience. With an average age of 26.7 on the active roster, the Saints are slightly younger than the average age for a Triple-A team last year (26.9). St. Paul's roster have 14 different U.S. states represented by hometown with 23 of the 28 on the active roster being American-born players. Internationally, the Saints tout three of their ranks from Venezuela (Gabby Gonzalez, Orlando Arcia, & Eduardo Salazar) and two from the Dominican Republic (E. Rodriguez & R. Brito).

BULLPEN MARCO: In just his 13th professional appearance in relief and his first in a save situation, Marco Raya held down the lead in the ninth for the Saints on Saturday. After appearing in just two games in relief over his first three professional seasons, Raya transitioned to a reliever role with the Saints last season, making nine straight appearances out of the St. Paul bullpen and ten total on the season. On Saturday, Raya punched out three of four batters faced in his season debut while generating six swings-and-misses. His average 4-seam fastball (96.5) and cutter (91.8) velocities were both up a tick from last season.

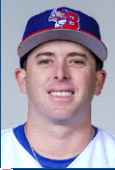

- Enters his first season as Twins farmhand...originally a 30th-round pick by the Angels in 2019...was released in May 2020 and signed with Toronto over a year later...has spent the last 5 years in Jays system

- Has produced a sub-3.00 ERA in three straight seasons & owns a 2.66 ERA from 2023-25, which ranks 7th in MLB among pitchers with at least 200 IP

2025

- **Named the Warren Spahn Award Winner** as the Triple-A Buffalo Most Valuable Pitcher for second year in a row

- Spent the entire season with Triple-A Buffalo, going 6-2, 2.57 ERA (24 ER, 84.0 IP) with 72 strikeouts (20 K%) and 36 walks (10 BB%) in 40 app. (5 GS)

- Ranked 7th in the International League in ERA (min. 50 IP)...threw a scoreless outing in 20-of-40 appearances, mostly in relief

- Of his 40 appearances, five were starts...one of which came vs the Saints on May 9 at CHS Field (3.1 IP, 1 Run, 5 hits, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HRA, season-high 64 pitches)

LAST APPEARANCE: Threw 2.1 scoreless innings in relief in his Twins organizational debut on Saturday at Indianapolis...threw 27 sweepers (68%), 6 sinkers (15%), 5 four-seamers (13%), and 2 changeups (5%). The 68% sweeper usage was the highest in a single-outing for Bash in the pitch-tracking era (circa 2023, Triple-A only).

Generated four swings-and-misses, 3 on the sweeper.

TROY PERCIVAL, YOU'RE MY HERO: A Southern California native, Bash's family were Angels season ticket-holders while Bash was growing up. He attended Game 7 of the 2002 World Series, where the Angels beat the Giants for the Commissioner's Trophy. Bash would go on to eventually be drafted by the Angels in the 30th round of the 2019 Draft. He would spend just one year with the Halos organization before being released in May of 2020, signing with the Missoula Paddleheads in Indy Ball for the start of 2021, and eventually latching on with the Blue Jays.

IT AIN'T MUCH, BUT IT'S HONEST WORK: Following the cancellation of the 2020 minor league season, Bash was working as a groundskeeper at his old college, California Baptist. In 2021, he got the call from the Missoula Paddleheads (Independent, Pioneer League) in 2021 and signed with them.

THE INVINCIBLE ONE: Spending most of the last two seasons with Triple-A Buffalo in the Toronto system, Andrew Bash is the back-to-back Warren Spahn Award winner, granted to the Bisons' Most Valuable Pitcher each season. Bash ranked 7th in the International League in ERA last season (min 50 IP) with a 2.57 mark, his second straight year throwing up a sub-3.00 ERA. The award is of course named for the Hall-of-Famer, who although he didn't ever play for the Bisons, is a South Buffalo native. Nicknamed "the Invincible One," Spahn won 363 games and threw 382 complete games in his illustrious 21-year career.

2025 Season: Playing in his 10th season in The Show, hit just .202 (41-203), 3 HR, 13 RBI and a .529 OPS in 76 games split between the Atlanta Braves & Colorado Rockies

- >Marked the Venezuela native's worst MLB season by OPS while also notching the fewest HR and RBI of his career...spent the whole year in the majors
- Broke camp with the Braves and went 6-for-30 (.200) at the plate in 10 games before landing on the 10-day IL with a left wrist fracture
- >Returned to action on May 6 with Atlanta but appeared in just four games and only received 1 AB before being released on May 25
- Signed as a free agent with Colorado on May 28 and closed the year hitting .203, 3 HR 12 RBI and a .544 OPS in 62 games with the Rox
- >Was mired in a 1-for-29 (.034) slide from July 5-July 26
- Graded as an above average defender at shortstop in the big leagues, posting a +2 Outs Above Average, in the 78th percentile of big leaguers at the position

- Was an All-Star for the Atlanta Braves in 2023 after winning the starting shortstop job out of camp and hitting .264, 17 HR, 65 RBI and a .741 OPS in 139 games
- >Ranked 7th in batting average, eighth in OBP and slugging% & 9th in OPS among qualified MLB shortstops that season
- A 2021 World Series champion with Atlanta...saw just 4 AB in the postseason and drew a walk in one of his 5 PA
- >A .247 career postseason hitter (19-77) with 5 HR in 29 games...drilled 3 HR in the first 6 games of Milwaukee's 2018 run to the NLCS after 3 in 119 gm in reg. season
- Started his career with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, where he ascended to the big leagues for the first time in 2016 & spent six seasons with the club
- >Was traded to the Braves on April 6, 2021 in exchange for RHP Chad Sobotka and RHP Patrick Weigel
- In 2024, opened the Braves' season with back-to-back 3-hit games @PHI, 1-of-5 players in the Braves' modern era to do so

- >Raised his batting average 70 points & his OPS by 230+ points from his first season in Double-A in 2024
