PATRIOTS PLAYOFF PEDIGREE: On Thursday night, the Somerset Patriots clinched the Eastern League Northeast Division's Second Half playoff berth, as they lead the Hartford Yard Goats by 4.5 games with three games remaining in the regular season. Somerset has qualified for the playoffs for a fourth consecutive season, joining the Erie SeaWolves as the only other Double-A team to do so.

TOP OF THE HEAP: In five seasons since becoming the Yankees' Double-A affiliate beginning with the 2021 season, the Somerset Patriots have a record of 386-278. Their 386 wins lead all Double-A teams (ERI, 2nd, 377) and rank 6th in all of Minor League Baseball. Over that span, Somerset's 3.66 ERA as a pitching staff ranks 4th in MiLB, and is the lowest of any team in Double-A or Triple-A. Their 6,558 strikeouts also lead all Double-A teams (CHS, 2nd, 6,417). Offensively, in their tenure as the Yankees' Double-A affiliate, the Patriots lead all Double-A teams with 851 HR.

SOMERSETEMBER: Since the start of September, the Somerset Patriots are 8-1, tied for the best record in Minor League Baseball (Iowa and Louisville). The Patriots' 2.05 ERA and 0.99 WHIP during September are the lowest marks in all of Double-A, ranking 5th and 3rd in MiLB, respectively.

FEASTING ON THE NORTHEAST: During the second half, the Somerset Patriots have combined to go 18-3 vs. the New Hampshire Fisher Cats and Reading Fightin' Phils, making up for 48.6% of their second half victories. Over the full season, Somerset has combined to go 13-23 against the three other Eastern League Playoff teams (Binghamton, Erie and Altoona).

KINGS OF K: Entering the final weekend of the regular season, Yankees pitching prospects Carlos Lagrange and Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz sit second and third on Minor League Baseball's strikeout leaderboard with 168 and 166, respectively (Jonah Tong, 1st, 179). Neither pitcher has allowed a run during September over two starts each. They have combined to go 3-0 with 0 R allowed over 22.0 IP with 31 K and 5 BB.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONES: Brendan Jones enters today on a 15-game on-base streak dating back to 8/26 @BNG. During the streak, Jones is 17-for-54 (.315/.448/.407) with 16 R, 3 2B, 1 3B, 4 RBI, 13 BB, 12 SB, 0 CS and an .855 OPS. After a 3 SB game on Thursday night, Jones extended his Yankees minor league lead in steals to 48. The last Yankee to steal 50 bases in a season was Anthony Volpe in 2022 (50).

JERE COMES JASSO: Dylan Jasso enters today tied for the Eastern League lead with 75 RBIs (Ryan Clifford, BNG). Somerset's single-season RBI record is 78, accomplished twice: in 2021 by Oswaldo Cabrera and in 2024 by Spencer Jones. Jasso also enters the day with 122 H, three shy of 125, which is both the league lead (HBG, Phillip Glasser) and the Patriots' single-season record (Spencer Jones, 2024).

HARDMAN'S HAMMER: In 34 games since 8/1 vs. RIC, Tyler Hardman is 30-for-118 (.254/.358/.449) with 18 R, 13 XBH (7 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR), 17 RBI, 18 BB, 3 SB and an .807 OPS. Hardman is Somerset's all-time Double-A leader in RBI (153) and HR (53), while ranking second in XBH (99) and TB (418), and third in H (206), R (146), and 2B (39).

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafter. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.
