### Leading Off

Tonight, Reading continues this week's six-game series against the Richmond Flying Squirrels. Richmond leads the season-series 4-0 after last night's win. Mick Abel gets the start opposite Carson Seymour for Richmond.

### Looking Back

Reading fell 6-0 to Richmond last night. Victor Vargas allowed three runs in the first and second inning, but proceeded to go four scoreless after that. Reading pitching held Richmond to just two hits, one walk and no runs from the third inning on last night. The game was played in two hours, and one minute, marking the shortest nine-inning game for Reading this season.

### Streak Snapped

With an 0-4 night, Carlos De La Cruz's 38-game on-base streak came to an end. It dated back to May 12 and passed Cameron Perkins mark of 33-straight games set back in 2014. It was the longest on-base streak for an R-Phil dating back to 2009.

### Bats Kept Quiet

Last night marked the first time Reading has been shutout this season, which took until game 69. Entering last night, the R-Phils were one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and just one-of-eight across Minor League Baseball who have yet to be shutout. Reading has also not scored a run in a season-high 11 innings in a row offensively. It was the first time Reading was shutout since Sept. 11, 2022.

### Hey Now You're an All Star

Tonight's starter Mick Abel was selected to the All Star Future's Game on Monday night. Abel is one-of-two Phillies' prospects to be selected, with the other being Justin Crawford of Clearwater. Abel ranks as the Phillies' second-ranked prospect and will return just three-hours from home for the game in Seattle on Saturday, July 8.

### Trip Trip Triples for Podkul

Nick Podkul hit two triples in Sunday's win at Portland, making him the first R-Phil to hit two three-baggers in a game since Art Charles did it on Apr. 24, 2015. It was both a season-high in triple for Podkul and team-high for triples in a game for Reading.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies earned another series win with a 8-5 win at the Cubs last night. Lehigh Valley opened the second half with a loss to Rochester 7-6 as Nick Nelson went six innings and Darick Hall had three hits. Jersey Shore beat Brooklyn 8-2 as Matt Osterberg was strong over six innings. Finally, Clearwater beat Bradenton 8-5 as Noah Song made his first rehab appearance and Justin Crawford had two hits.

### This Day in Baseballtown History

**June 29, 2016:** At Reading, Dylan Cozens and Rhys Hoskins both homered to stay tied for EL lead with 21 long balls in a 14-1 pasting of Erie. It is the 9th time that season that both homered in same game. Osmel Aguila and Harold Martinez add homers of their own, with Aguila's being his first.

### Richmond Roundup

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Richmond, with the first being a sweep for Richmond at The Diamond. Richmond enters this week after going 33-36 in the first half and finishing fourth in the Southwest Division. Last week, Richmond took five-of-six against Harrisburg, including four-straight to close the series. Next week, Richmond takes on Bowie at home.

### Squirrel on the Bump

Righty Carson Seymour gets the start for Richmond tonight. Seymour is 0-1 with a 3.35 ERA over 14 games and nine starts this season. Accross 53.2 innings, he's allow 43 hits, issued 22 walks and picked up 32 strikeouts. Seymour went four innings and allowed two runs against Harrisburg last Friday. Seymour faced Reading on Apr. 8, going four innings and allowing one run in a no decision. Seymour was traded from the Mets to Giants in last season's Darin Ruf trade. He was a sixth-round pick by the Mets in 2021 out of Kansas State.

Roughed up for nine and six runs respectively on May 12 and 26. In the month of June, Abel has allowed seven-earned runs across 21 innings. Has went six innings three times this season, most recently on June 2 in a loss to New Hampshire. Abel has quality start in each six-inning appearance. Faced Richmond once on Apr. 8, failing to get out of the first inning as he allowed eight walks. Opponents are hitting .198 against Abel which is top-five in the Eastern League. Issuing 5.2 walks per nine and striking out 10.3 per nine.

2023: Entered season as Phillies second-ranked prospect, trailing only Andrew Painter. Earned invite to Phillies spring training. Appeared in two games (one start) and threw three innings. Allowed no runs and one hit. Struck out two and walked two. 2022: Split season between High-A Jersey Shore and Double-A Reading. Went 7-8 over 18 starts with Jersey Shore. With Reading, he started five games and went 1-3 with a 4.01 ERA. 2021: Spent entire season with Single-A Clearwater. He started 14 games and went 1-3 with a 4.43 ERA over 44.2 nnings pitched. 2020: Was first round selection of Phillies out of Jesuit High School in Portland, Oregon. High School: First baseman and pitcher for Jesuit. Injured shoulder as sophomore and required surgery. As a junior Abel posted a 10-0 record with a 1.26 ERA and 111 strikeouts in 72+1/3 innings pitched while also batting .294 with 12 runs scored and 14 RBIs as he helped lead the Crusaders to a state championship and was named the Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year and a Junior All-American by MaxPreps. In 2019, he was selected for U-18 United States national baseball team. Entering his 2020 senior season Abel was named a preseason All-American by MaxPreps and Baseball America and was considered to be a top prospect for the upcoming draft. He was also ranked the fourth best collegiate prospect in the nation and committed to play at Oregon State University after his freshman year of high school. PERSONAL: Abel grew up in Cedar Mill, Oregon, and helped lead the Cedar Mill Little League team win a state title as a youth.
