Jersey Shore BlueClaws (12-13) vs Bowling Green Hot Rods (13-12)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, NJ (opened 2001) LHP Braeden Fausnaught (2-0, 1.74) vs RHP Trevor Martin (2-1, 3.76) Series: Game 5 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 3-1 of 6)

Last Time Out...Cade Fergus broke a 3-3 tie with a sixth inning home run as the BlueClaws topped Bowling Green 8-5 on Friday night at ShoreTown Balloark...Fergus' home run, his second of the year, put the BlueClaws up 4-3 and they scored four more times in the seventh inning, including a two-run single by Leandro Pineda...Daniel Harper came on in the ninth and earned his second save... Trey Dillard threw 1.2 innings of scoreless relief for the win in his BlueClaws debut.

State of the Claws...The BlueClaws have won three in a row for the first time this year and are now within 3.0 games of first place behind Wimington, who will be in town next week...Jersey Shore had dropped eight of nine, including the first game of this series on Tuesday, before earning wins in each of the last three games...The BlueClaws are looking for their first four-game winning streak of the season but can get there with a win tonight...They won four in a row on four separate occasions last year, including August 6th through 10th against Brooklyn and Hudson Valley...Their longest win streak last year was seven games from July 26th through August 1st against Aberdeen and

Hot Rods Roll Into Town...Bowling Green (BlueClaws lead 3-1) comes to ShoreTown for the second-ever meeting between the two teams and first in High-A...They split four games here in 2009 (July 13-16), Bowling Green's first year in the South Atlantic League before they moved to the Midwest League from 2010 - 2019...Bowling Green went 3-3 last week at Hudson Valley...The Hot Rods won the SAL Title in 2021 and 2022 while the Rays Low-A affiliate, Charleston (SC), won the Carolina League title in 2021, 2022, and 2023.

Positively Fergalicious...Cade Fergus went deep on Friday to break a 3-3 tie and give the BlueClaws the lead...It was his second home run of the season and the 18th of his career...Fergus is 5 for his last 14 with three stolen bases in his last five appearances...He already has seven steals this year after he stole 14 last year between Clearwater (10) and Jersey Shore (4)...He was a 13th round pick in 2022 from George Washington University and played at St. Thomas Aquinas HS in Fort Lauderdale.

Keep on Gettin' On ... William Bergolla has reached base in seven of his 12 plate appearances this week, going 3-7 with four walks so far in this series ... The 19 year old is one of just six players to play for the BlueClaws in High-A (2021-present) before his 20th birthday (Andrew Painter, Bryan Rincon, Hao-Yu Lee, Justin Crawford, Kervin Pichardo) and only Painter (19 years, 2 months, 2 days) was younger than Bergolla was (19 years, 5 months, 12 days) on his BlueClaws debut.

in' Claws...The BlueClaws are third in the league with 45 stolen bases this year (Aberdeen leads with 71 and Bowling Green has 60)...Justin Crawford stole two bases on Thursday and leads the team with 10...Cade Fergus is second on the team with seven and Emaarion Boyd (who stole 56 last year to lead the Florida State League with Clearwater) has six and William Bergolla (who stole just two bases last year with Clearwater) has five... Jersey Shore stole a season-high seven bases on Sunday – including two each by Cade Fergus, William Bergolla, and Erick Brito... The seven Sunday steals is two off the club record (4/8/23 at Brooklyn and 4/8/22 vs Aberdeen)...Jersey Shore is 45-53 on the season stealing bases.

EB1...Erick Brito had two hits on Thursday, his fourth two-hit game of the season, the second most on the team behind Justin Crawford (seven)...Brito had nine with the BlueClaws last year (June 13th through the end of the season) and four from July 3rd through the end fo the season...He also has four stolen bases so far this year

Going Deep...BlueClaws starting pitchers have thrown 118 innings over their 25 games, the third most of any team in High-A (Bowling Green – Rays, leads at 121.2)...BlueClaws starters have a 2.97 ERA, fourth best in High-A, best in the South Atlantic League...The BlueClaws starter has thrown at least five innings in 15 of their 25 games...Jean Cabrera has a seven inning start and a six inning start while Sam Aldegheri has a six inning and a 6.2 inning start...Braeden Fausnaught also has a six inning start

Left on Left... Against a Bowling Green lineup that has had seven left-handed hitters in each of the first three games and six in the fourth, the BlueClaws turned to LHP Andrew Walling on Thursday who threw 1.2 scoreless innings... Walling last year held left-handed hitters to 5-60 with 28 strikeouts between Clearwater and Jersey Shore (though LHHs are 5-13 against him this season)...Walling has allowed two runs in 10 innings with 13 strikeouts and seven walks...He pitched for Williamsport in the MLB Draft League and signed with the Phillies in 2022 out of Mississippi State.

Slingin' Sam...Sam Aldegheri (22 IP, 7 H, 2 R/1 ER, 6 BBs, 28 Ks on the season) gave up one run over a career-long 6.2 innings on Wednesday night, striking out seven to earn his second win in four starts this year...He is one of seven MiLB pitchers to allow 0 or 1 ER in 20+ innings so far this year (including Clearwater's George Klassen who has not allowed an earned run in 21 innings)...The left-hander from Verona. Italy fanned 10 over five scoreless innings last week in Aberdeen, joining Jean Cabrera (4/12 at Hickory) as the second BlueClaw to do that this season... They are the third and fourth BlueClaws since the team moved to High-A in 2021 to struck out at least 10 in five or fewer innings: Mitch Neunborn (5 IP. 0 H. 0 R. 1 BB. 10 K on 8/31/23 vs ABD) and Ben Brown (5 IP. 1 H. 0 R. 1 BB. 11 K on 5/28/22 vs GVL).

Jumpin' Jean...Jean Cabrera threw seven innings on Tuesday night, allowing three runs and striking out eight Bowling Green hitters...His seven inning start was just the fifth 7+ inning start in High-A so far this year and the first time a BlueClaws pitcher has thrown seven innings in an April game since 2017 when Adonis Medina (April 20th) and Ranger Suarez (April 21st) did so in back to back games...It was the first 7-inning April start for a Phillies High-A pitcher since Bailey Falter on April 29th (and 23rd) with Clearwater in 2018

Dillard Earns Debut W...RHP Trey Dillard threw 1.2 scoreless innings on Friday to earn the win in his BlueClaws debut...He joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater, where he gave up three earned runs in eight innings with 11 strikeouts and five walks...Dillard signed with the Phillies as a non-drafted free agent last year from Texas A&M...He previously pitched at Missouri

Walk This Way...Bryan Rincon has already drawn 13 walks in just 76 plate appearances so far this year after he drew 68 walks (59 in 348 PAs with Clearwater and 9 in 77 PAs with Jersey Shore) last year...Felix Reyes (10 in 77 PAs) and Justin Crawford (9 in 85 PAs) are tied for the second most on the team...William Bergolla, who drew two walks on Thursday, has six on the year and drew 30 walks in 227 PAs last year with Clearwater.

Welcome Back Otto...Otto Kemp played first base for the first time as a professional on Thursday...He is back with the BlueClaws having been transferred to Jersey Shore (where he had been rehabbing since April 16th) from Reading...He had the game winning RBI single in the game on April 25th at Aberdeen in a 1-0 win and is 11-37 so far after going 7-14 with a home run, triple, and two doubles with Clearwater over five games...Kemp spent the end of last year with the BlueClaws, hitting .223 with 10 RBIs and several key defensive plays in the post-season run...He hit 7 HRs and stole 17 bases with Clearwater last year and was a 2022 NDFA signee out of Point Loma Nazarene (CA).

Going Going Gone... The BlueClaws have not homered since April 20th in Lakewood (a span of 10 games) against Brooklyn (eight of their 12 HRs on the season came in Hickory from April 9th – 14th)...Leandro Pineda hit his second home run of the year and 16th of his career on April 20th, his second home run of the Brooklyn series... Troy Schreffler hit his second home run of the season on April 19th, his 9th career long ball... Pineda, Schreffler, Justin Crawford and Jordan Dissin each have two so far for Jersey Shore, both homering twice in Hickory...Schreffler, Pineda (2), and Andrick Nava have the four BlueClaws long balls in ShoreTown so far this year.

Pottstown Bomber...C Jordan Dissin leads the BlueClaws with 12 RBIs so far this year including a two run single on Thursday...He has two home runs, both in Hickory...Dissin hit four home runs with Clearwater last year...The 21 year old grew up in Pottstown, Pennsylvania and went to Malvern Prep High School, growing up a huge Phillies fan...He made his BlueClaws debut this year and had an RBI double in the game on April 14th...Dissin began his career at Richmond and finished at Saddleback JC in California before the Phillies drafted him in the 12th round of the 2022 draft.

Youth Is Served...Per Baseball America, the BlueClaws have five of the 25 youngest players in the South Atlantic League (based on Opening Day rosters of 360 players): William Bergolla (3rd youngest), Bryan Rincon (9th), Justin Crawford (11th), Hendry Mendez (17th), and Emmaarion Boyd (21st).

Lock It Down...The BlueClaws have five saves on the year, two by Charles King and Daniel Harper and one fro Wesley Moore (May 1st)...Harper got his second save on Friday after a six out save last Thursday at Aberdeen...Moore got his save on Wednesday with a 1-2-3 inning against Bowling Green, the sixth of his career...King earned his second save with a scoreless ninth inning on April 16th...The right-hander signed with the Phillies in February and was working as a pitching analyst with the Padres the previous two years after graduating from TCU with a biology degree.

In the First Round...Justin Crawford is the 15th former first round pick to play for the BlueClaws and the fourth to play for the BlueClaws as a High-A team (Andrew Painter and Mick Abel in 2022 and Bryson Stott in 2021)... Since 2000, the only two Phillies first round picks not to play for the BlueClaws are Joe Savery (2007) and Aaron Nola (2014) plus 2023 first-round pick Aidan Miller, who is currently with Clearwater.

Go Phils...The BlueClaws have several players that grew up Phillies fans: C Jordan Dissin (went to Malvern Prep in Philadelphia, 27 miles from Citizens Bank Park), OF Troy Schreffler (from Harrisburg), and LHP Braeden Fausnaught (from Danville and went to West Chester University).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had an Opening Night walk-off win when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

From The Shore to the Show...123 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including one this year (Ben Brown, Cubs)...Three debuted in 2023 – James McArthur with the Royals, Johan Rojas with the Phillies, and Orion Kerkering with the Phillies...Kerkering, who was with the BlueClaws from May 9th through July 6th, is the only player to play for the BlueClaws and Phillies in the same year.

On the Staff...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2024 after leading the BlueClaws to the playoffs and a league-best 73-58 mark in 2023...Pitching coach Brad Bergesen is in Lakewood for a third time (2018 and 2022) and is joined as a pitching coach by first-year Phillies coach Matt Ellmyer...Hitting coach Adam Lind hit 200 big league home runs and is in his first year as a coach...Position coach Orlando Munoz is in his first year with the BlueClaws after managing the DSL Phillies since 2017...Development coach Beth Greenwood is the first BlueClaws female position coach and a member of Team USA Women's National Baseball Team.

Career Notes: Spent 2023 with Clearwater, where he played 55 games hitting .255 with 20 RBIs and two stolen bases...Struck out just 17 times and walked 30 in 218 plate appearances...Since

2005, Bergolla and Wander Franco are the only two 18/19 year olds with a 10% or greater walk rate and 10% or fewer strikeout rate (minimum 200 PAs)...Following the season, rated as having the best strike-zone discipline in the Phillies minor league system by Baseball America...Made pro debut with the DSL Phillies in 2022, hitting .380 in 24 games.
