**Today:** The Lansing Lugnuts, High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the 11th game in a 12-game, 14-day road trip, the fifth affair in a six-game series at the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Nuts are 5-2 against Great Lakes this year, all at Dow Diamond, sweeping a three-game series to open the year and winning the last two games of the current series after dropping the first two contests.

**Last Night: Lugnuts 8, Loons 3.** Starter **Jacob Watters** fired five scoreless innings with five strikeouts, batterymate **CJ Rodriguez** smashed his first home run of the year and drove in three, and the Nuts piled up 14 hits en route to the easy victory in front of 4,335 in Midland. Lansing had six players collect multi-hit games and swiped four bases in the winning cause, finished up by two dominant scoreless innings from **Stevie Emanuels**. The Loons' only runs came in a three-run seventh.

**On the Air:** Today's game can be viewed on Bally Live and MiLB TV with **Brad Tunney** and **John Vicari**, and an audio-only broadcast via StreamGuys with **Jesse Goldberg-Strassler** and **Adam Jaksa**.

**On Deck:** The Lugnuts wrap things up in Great Lakes tomorrow, returning home on the 4th of July against the Lake County Captains, starting a six-game series at Jackson Field.

### LUG•NOTES

**One Base at a Time:** After collecting one extra-base hit in their first 17 hits in the series, the Lugnuts notched four extra-base hits among their 14 hits last night, with the tone set by a leadoff double from **Max Muncy**. It was the 17th double-digit hit game for Lansing this season and the most base hits allowed in any game by Loons pitchers this year.

**Start Your Engines:** This series features the two clubs with the most stolen bases in the Midwest League, with 113 steals for Great Lakes and 109 steals for the Lugnuts. Last night, the Lugnuts went 4-for-4, giving them eight steals in eight attempts in the series, while the Loons were successful in their only attempt, giving them eight steals in 11 attempts through four games.

**Two for the Price of One:** Though they have not turned a double play in the last three games, Lugnuts' defense continues to lead the league with 68 double plays this year, nine more than second-place South Bend and 34 more than 12th-place Lake County. The Nuts' 53 errors ranks second lowest in the circuit, with only two errors in the last seven games and 35 errorless games this season. In their seven-game season series, Great Lakes has committed 10 errors to the Nuts' four.

**The Future is Now:** 2022 Lugnuts stars **Tyler Soderstrom** and **Lawrence Butler** will play in the Sirius XM All-Star Futures Game, Soderstrom's second time appearing in the Futures Game (2021). 2022 Lugnuts outfielder **Denzel Clarke**, currently in Double-A Midland with Butler, played in last year's Futures Game, joining **Ángel Perdomo** (2016), **Bo Bichette** and **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** (2017) as active Nuts to play in the event.

**Roster Movement:** Outfielder **Jonny Butler** was promoted yesterday to Double-A Midland, becoming the ninth Lugnut to join the RockHounds this season. In a corresponding move, infielder **Alexander Campos** was returned to the Nuts' roster from Triple-A Las Vegas.

**The Cycle:** On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

**They Know Their Trade:** Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2009:** The Nuts split a doubleheader at Great Lakes, falling 4-2 in Game 1 before winning 3-1 in Game 2 behind a complete game from Chad Beck (7 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K). Chris Emanuele belted a two-run homer in a three-run 7th to supply the offense and snatch victory from the jaws of defeat.

**2011:** Consider these numbers: The Lugnuts collected 16 hits (two singles and two doubles apiece in four-hit games from Jake Marisnick and Marcus Knecht), including seven doubles, one triple and one Michael Crouse homer, and went 5-for-16 with runners in scoring position – but lost 7-6 at Great Lakes, which collected only eight hits and went 2-for-13 with RISP.

**2015:** The Toronto Blue Jays traded Lugnuts 2B Tim Lincecum (.310 in 70 games, leading the MWL with 30 SB and 21 HBPs) and former Lugnuts pitcher Chase De Jong to the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for three international signing slots, allowing the Jays to sign 16-year-old Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. The Jays also promoted Sean Reid-Foley, Conner Greene and Richard Ureña to A-Adv. Dunedin, sending 20-year-old Dawel Lugo back to Lansing from Dunedin.

**The King:** First name is pronounced “yo-el-vis,” with the emphasis on the middle syllable... nicknamed Elvis... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... has been clocked as hot as 98 mph this year; says that he has hit 100 mph once in his life, the first time his mother came in from the DR to watch him pitch in a professional game, in 2022 in the Florida State League... currently rated the No. 29 prospect in the Athletics’ organization by MLB Pipeline; Fastball 55, Slider 50, Changeup 50, Control 50, Overall 40.

**Path Through the Pros:** After signing at age 16 for \$33,000, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

**Joining the Athletics:** Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A’s had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

**A Taste of the Cactus League:** Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A’s, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.

**Lugnuts Lineage:** Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings as the Opening Day starter, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Heston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yennsy Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).
