HISTORIC RALLY LEADS TO 9-8 WIN IN 11 INNINGS

Down to his final strike, **Jordan Groshans** smashed a three-run home run in the ninth inning to tie Saturday's game, helping the Jumbo Shrimp rally from six runs down as Jacksonville wound up beating the Memphis Redbirds 9-8 in 11 innings to secure the largest come-from-behind victory in the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present). Memphis had two different leads of six runs and Jacksonville whittled it down to 8-5 in the ninth before eventually tying the game.

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 16 of their last 21 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 48 runs, 41 earned, on 98 hits (8.7 H/9) in 101.0 innings for a 3.65 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 70 punchouts (6.2 K/9). However, they have only issued 29 walks during this run, a rate of 2.6 per nine innings.

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 120 free passes over the last 22 games since April 11, a figure that ranks second in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.6 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since the season's second week. Over his last 22 games dating back to April 7, the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 27-for-80 at the plate, slashing .325/.471/.550/1.021 with nine doubles, three homers, 16 RBIs and 22 walks. Encarnacion places amongst the league leaders in several categories this year, including doubles (T-6th, 9), walks (T-10th, 22) and RBIs (T-16th, 23).

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER

The Jumbo Shrimp's 9-8 victory on Saturday in Memphis saw Jacksonville rally from a six-run deficit, marking largest comeback win of the Jumbo Shrimp era (2017-present) and the franchise's biggest since also rallying from six runs down on August 10, 2013 at Pensacola in an 8-6 win in 16 innings. Meanwhile, Jacksonville recorded consecutive 11-inning wins for the second time this season (April 1-2 at Gwinnett). Prior to 2023, the club hadn't won back-to-back extra-inning games since beating Durham 3-2 in 10 innings on June 27, 2021 and taking a 6-4 contest in 10 frames two days later at Memphis. Before that, the feat hadn't been done since 2014. The last time Jacksonville won consecutive games of at least 11 innings in length was July 3-4, 2011 (4-3 in 17 innings over Birmingham, 9-5 in 11 innings at Carolina).

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, **Charles Leblanc** went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last eight games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 11-for-26 (.423) with a double, home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 13 walks for a .577 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (25) more than he has struck out (23). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (23.6 percent) and tied for second in total walks (25). His swinging-strike rate of 7.9 percent is the 22nd-lowest out of the circuit's 139 qualified hitters.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the nine games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 14 runs, nine earned, on 35 hits (7.4 K/9) in 42.2 innings for a 1.90 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 40 strikeouts (8.4 K/9) against 28 walks (5.4 BB/9) during this recent run.
