WE BRING THE BROOMS: The Sounds walked off the I-Cubs for the second time in the series last week en route to the series sweep with a 4-3 win in Sunday's series finale. Sundays win marked Nashville's first six-game sweep since 2023 when the Sounds swept the Gwinnett Stripers from June 13-18 at First Horizon Park. The walk-off also marked the Sounds third walk-off win this season and the 137th overall walk-off win since 2005 with a single-season high of 13 coming in the 2023 season. Eddys Leonard earned his seventh career walk-off winner with his RBI single in the bottom of the ninth to cap a three-run inning.

IN THE JETT STREAM: Brewers no. 3-rated prospect Jett Williams went deep for the second consecutive game and his fifth overall on the season with a solo shot in the bottom of the sixth inning on Sunday. Williams became the fifth different Nashville player to leave the yard in consecutive games, joining Luke Adams (4/3-5 vs. CLT), Eddys Leonard (4/24-25 @ CLT), Luis Lara (4/25-26 @ CLT), and Cooper Pratt (5/16-17 vs. IOW). He has 36 regular season home runs in his minor league career. Sunday was the first time he had homered in back-to-back games since he had a HR in three straight games August 19-22, 2023.

DEBUT MATERIAL: Right-hander Tyson Hardin made his Triple-A debut in Sunday's finale against the I-Cubs, collecting his first career Triple-A quality start along the way (7.0 IP, 4 H, 2 R, ER, 6 K, 3 BB) and the eighth overall quality start in his three-year campaign. This marked the second time that Hardin has recorded a quality start in his first appearance at a new minor league level, and the second against a Chicago Cubs Affiliate as well. The first occurred in his Double-A debut and allowed two runs on four hits and punched out five batters against Knoxville and earned his first career Double-A win. In his debut with High-A Wisconsin last year, Hardin tossed five scoreless innings, allowed no hits and struck out four batters to collect his first career High-A win as well.

CLEARED FOR TAKE OFF: Jett Williams tallied two of Nashville's five hits in Sunday's finale against the I-Cubs. It marked the 12th multi-hit game of his season and sixth in 14 games played in the month of May. After beginning the season hitting .186 (15-for-83, 2B, 3B, HR, 7 RBI, 15 BB, 12 R) through his first 21 games, Williams is hitting .338 (25-for-74, 5 2B, 2 3B, 4 HR, 17 RBI, 14 BB, 23 R) over his last 21 games. Since April 24, Williams owns a 1.079 OPS and ranks tied for second in the International League in runs scored, T-7th in XBH (11), 9th in total bases (46), and 10th in the IL in OBP (.457).

BACK TO PRATT: Brewers no. 4-rated prospect Cooper Pratt homered in back-to-back games for the first time in his professional career after his three-run homer off Tyler Ferguson in the third inning Saturday night. Over his last 20 games, Pratt is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with four home runs, four doubles, two triples, and 18 RBI with 15 walks and 15 runs scored.

SLAMI SAMMICH: Eddys Leonard is one of nine players in the minor leagues with multiple grand slams this season after hitting his second of the season on Saturday night. Leonard gave Nashville a 5-0 lead in the bottom of the first inning after clearing the bases off I-Cubs starter Vince Velasquez. Since the Sounds moved to First Horizon Park ahead of the 2015 season, he's the sixth Nashville player with multiple grand slams in the same season. Leonard had just one career grand slam entering the year. He ranks among International League leaders in doubles (T-4th, 11), OPS (7th, 1.002), SLG (7th, .585) and AVG (T-9th, .333). His seven home runs this season are tied with Luis Lara for the team lead in 2026.

BALL TILL YOU STALL: Garrett Stallings turned in his second straight scoreless outing and quality start on Saturday night. The right-hander worked a season-high 6.2 IP with six strikeouts and four hits allowed. The 6.2 IP is the most for Stallings in a start since working 7.0 IP on September 13, 2023, with Norfolk. Saturday night was his 20th career quality start and 12th of his Triple-A career. The right-hander has not allowed an earned run over his last 14.0 IP dating back to his start on May 2nd. Saturday night was the fifth time with consecutive quality starts in his career. He worked three straight QS from June 23-July 4, 2021 to set his career-high.
