- The Blue Jays fell short of erasing a 6-0 second inning deficit and lost 7-5 to Lakeland on Sunday at Joker Marchant Stadium.
- Gage Stanifer surrendered 6 ER in 1.2 innings to start the game for the Jays including a solo homer from Max Clark and a three-run shot from Kevin McGonigle.
- Dunedin scored their first two runs of the game in the fourth on an RBI triple from Luis De Los Santos and an RBI single from Yhoangel Aponte.
- De Los Santos blasted a solo homer his first of his rehab assignment from AAA in the sixth to cut the lead to 6-3.
- Arjun Nimmala made it a one-run contest with his seventh home run of the season; a two-run shot in the eighth.
- With the defeat, the Blue Jays settle for a series split in a rain-shortened, two-game series in Lakeland. Saturday's postponed contest will be made up as part of a doubleheader when the Flying Tigers visit Dunedin August 27-September 1.

BIG STRETCH

After splitting two games with Lakeland, Dunedin continues its critical eight game stretch out of the All-Star Break by hosting firstplace Fort Myers for a six game set. The Blue Jays trail the Mighty Mussels by three games entering today's opener. This week's series will mark the final head-to-head matchups of the season between the clubs.

LONG TIME, NO SEE

This week's series between the Blue Jays and Mighty Mussels marks the first meetings between the teams since Dunedin visited Fort Myers May 7-12. The Mighty Mussels won four of six games that week, walking off Dunedin three times.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Luis De Los Santos joining the fray on Sunday, Dunedin has hosted 17 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Other notable rehabs include top prospect Ricky Tiedemann, Joey Votto, Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

SECOND HALF SLUGGING

Blue Jays outfielder Victor Arias is off to a hot start in the second half of the season, hitting to a .986 OPS in 20 games - good for sixth in the FSL in the half. Arias' full-season wRC+ of 140 ranks third in the league, behind Kevin McGonigle (150) and Ryan Ignoffo (141). wRC+ quantifies a player's total offensive value measured by runs, on a scale where 100 is league average.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

The Blue Jays have played 32 one-run games this season - tied for the most in the FSL. The Jays are 16-16 in those contests. 60 of the Blue Jays 88 games this season (68%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 32-28 record in those games.

NIC'S BIG NIGHT

Nic Deschamps' 3-4 performance Friday night marked the first three-hit game of his pro career and first multi-hit game in over a month (6/5 at Palm Beach). The Quebec native is hitting .247 through 31 games, compared to his .170 average in 57 games last season. Deschamps was signed by the Blue Jays as an undrafted free agent following his final season of High School in 2021.

JAMMIN' IN JULY

The Blue Jays' team OPS in July stands at .803 through 14 games - the best mark in the FSL this month. Dunedin is second in runs scored this month, posing 74 (5.2 per game).

SERIES SUCCESS

With last weekend's split with Lakeland, the Blue Jays have achieved a split or better in nine of their last 10 sets. Dunedin has especially been strong at home, having gone without a series loss at TD Ballpark since Clearwater took four of six from the Jays April 16-21 (six series). The lone series loss came at Lakeland, June 25-30, when the Flying Tigers took four of six games.

GIVING IT THE COLLEGE TRY

Of Toronto's 21 draft picks in last week's first year player draft, 16 were drafted out of college, including 10 of the team's first 11 selections. The selections could lead to an influx of college talent to Dunedin's roster. Of the team's 28 current players, just eight played college ball.
