#### LAST TIME OUT

Worcester, MA (April 29, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell in eleven innings 7-6 to the Worcester WooSox. SWB took an early lead in the contest, grabbed it back in the ninth, and again in the tenth but could not hold on to seal the deal

The RailRiders got on the board first with a three-run second. The inning began when Elijah Dunham was hit by a pitch. Michael Hermosillo and Mickey Gasper walked to load the bases. Wilmer Difo singled sharply to plate two. Difo then tried to take second, but was caught in a rundown. Gasper took the opportunity to race home before the tag was placed on Difo. SWB led 3-0. Rodolfo Duran launched a solo home run to left field to give the RailRiders a 4-0 advantage in the sixth. In the bottom half, the WooSox cut the lead in half. Jorge Alfaro led off with a triple. Back-to-back walks issued to Ronaldo Hernandez and Greg Allen walked to load the bases. Two more walks from Nick Sogard and Niko Goodrum pushed two runs home. The WooSox got one closer in the seventh. Wilyer Abreu led off with a single and a fielder's choice sent him home. SWB led 4-3. An RBI single off the bat of Abreu plated David Hamilton to tie the game at four apiece. In the top of the ninth, Gasper singled up the middle with two outs. Difo pushed him into scoring position with a walk. Then, Estevan Florial ripped a base hit up the right field line to plate Gasper for a 5-4 advantage. Immediately after the WooSox pop two consecutive extra base hits to plate the tying run again, this time at five apiece. The contest went into extras and the RailRiders took a quick lead. With Florial as the inherited runner, Dunham connected for an RBI double for a 6-5 lead. Once again Worcester tied it up in the bottom of the tenth. Niko Goodrum was the pace-of-play runner and trotted home on Alfaro's sacrifice fly to make it 6-6. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre could not get a run on the board in the eleventh and Worcester was able to walk it off. Marcus Wilson stole third as the placed runner and scored the winning run-on Allen's sacrifice fly. Randy Vasquez tossed five shutout innings with only three hits allowed. On 90 offerings, he walked three and struck out five. Deivi Garcia recorded just two outs giving up two runs on four walks. Matt Bowman notched the final out of the sixth but let up a run in the seventh. Both Greg Weissert and James Norwood tossed a one-run frames. DJ Snelten (L, 0-1) allowed a run each in the tenth and eleventh, bot unearned. Southpaw Brandon Walter allowed four runs on six hits in 5.1 innings. Taylor Broadway pitched the final outs of the sixth and a 1-2-3 seventh. By Ryan Sheriff gave up a run on two hits in one and two thirds frames. AJ Politi recorded the final out of the ninth. Jake Faria (W, 2-0) recorded the final two innings, allowing one unearned run.

#### **NEWS & NOTES**

**ON THE MOVE**- The RailRiders are wrapping up a two-week road trip between St. Paul and Worcester. On Tuesday they return home for two weeks at PNC Field against Rochester and Omaha.

**AGAINST SOUTHPAWS**- Prior to this week, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has not had many opportunities to hit against lefties. After playing the first contest of this series against MLB Rehabber LHP James Paxton, the RailRiders were batting .129 as a team against lefties. Going into last night's game, the combined batting average moved up to .142. Heading into yesterday after facing three straight left-handed starters and plenty in the bullpen, the collective RailRiders were hitting .166 against southpaws. Before facing Paxton for the second time the team has raised the cumulative average to .184.

FIELDING FREE- The RailRiders have played two consecutive error-free contests. The RailRiders recorded their ninth total errorless game last night. They are now third in Minor League Baseball with 34 miscues, two behind Stockton and Visalia. Andres Chaparro has eight total. Earlier this summer they did have a five-error game. Worcester has 23 errors during the summer, while the Frisco RoughRiders have only had night precisions.

HARRISON IS HERE - Harrison Bader joined Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on the road after playing two games on a rehab assignment with Double-A Somerset. Last night he went 0-3 with a walk. He also reached on an error, stole a bag, and scored a run. Bader was sidelined with a left oblique strain back on March 27th, missing a lot of the spring. After beginning playing games again on April 21, he is hopeful to return to the Yankees in early May. Bader was acquired from the Cardinals at the deadline last season for lefty Jordan Montgomery. He was on the Injured List with plantar fasciitis but was able to be back in time for the post-season. In the playoffs, he hit .333 with eight

0-FOR-THREE - SWB called three challenges last night one from each a hitter, catcher, and pitcher. Neither of them resulted in overturned calls and the RailRiders didn't get any back.

ABS & CHALLENGE ERA-This weekend begins the Automated Ball-Strike system in Triple-A. Teams will have three challenges per contest. Hitters, catchers and pitchers (and only them) then have the ability to challenge a call, which triggers a decisive visual of the pitch on the video board. Each team gets three challenges per game, with successful challenges retained for future use in the game. The ABS system challenges will only be available to be utilized Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.

**BAUERS EFFORT** - Jake Bauers officially signed a Major League contract and was activated by the New York Yankees yesterday. He made his first start in left field and ran into the wall making an excellent catch. He was removed from the contest and will be receiving more x-rays today. He played in 20 games with the RailRiders batting .304 with five doubles and a team-high nine home runs. Bauers also led with 20 runs batted in and had five steals.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM – The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#18 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Randy Vasquez (#14) and Sean Boyle (#29) are both set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre
