**TODAY** marks game #37 of the 2023 season, the fourth game of a six-game roadtrip, and the fourth game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 17 times during the 2022 regular season, with the Whitecaps winning the series 9-8, and will play 24 times in 2023. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 29th season in pro baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 16th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series.

**UP NEXT:** The 'Caps come back to West Michigan for a six-game series against the Lake County Captains (Cleveland Guardians affiliate from May 23-28 at LMCU Ballpark before heading to Day Air Ballpark in Dayton, Ohio for a six-game series against the Dragons (Cincinnati Reds affiliate) from May 30-June 4.

### STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The West Michigan Whitecaps ran into big trouble multiple times as two five-run innings led to a 10-0 loss to the Great Lakes Loons at Dow Diamond on Thursday night. The Whitecaps loss drops them to two games out of first place behind Great Lakes in the Midwest League Eastern Division. Meanwhile, the five-run third and seventh innings become the fifth time in the last five games that a Whitecaps opponent has scored at least four runs in a single frame. Thursday's contest remained scoreless until the fourth when Luis Diaz opened the frame with a leadoff double. After a strikeout of Austin Gauthier, the following five hitters reached base safely as RBI doubles from Yeiner Fernandez and Damon Keith allowed the Loons to take a commanding lead in Midland while sending all nine of their batters to the plate. All five runs were surrendered by 'Caps starting pitcher Carlos Pena, whose evening ended after the lefty finished the five-run frame. The 'Caps record falls to 21-15, while the Loons improve to 23-13. Great Lakes reliever Aldry Acosta (2-1) collects his second win of the season, while Pena (0-2) suffers his second loss in three starts. The middle of the Loons batting order reached base 14 times in 20 plate appearances, going 8-for-13 in the process from their Nos. 3-through-7 hitters. 'Caps infielder Danny Serretti reached base three times with a single and a pair of walks in a losing cause. The game saw an ejection in the eighth inning as home plate umpire Daniel Bytheway ejected Loons shortstop Alex Freeland for arguing balls and strikes.

**JUSTICE BEING SERVED:** After going 13-for-20 in a series in Mid-May against the Lansing Lugnuts, Whitecaps OF Justice Bigbie collected his first-ever Midwest league Player of the Week award. Bigbie tallied four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI as the 'Caps took 4 out of 6 games with the 'Nuts from May 9-14 at LMCU Ballpark.

**ENTERING ELITE COMPANY:** With a 11-10 victory over the Great Lakes Loons on May 16, Whitecaps Manager Brayan Peña collected his 151st victory to pass former West Michigan and one-time Baltimore Orioles manager Phil Regan for 5th place on the all-time 'Caps wins list by a manager.

**LEADING THE PACK:** The Whitecaps enter today's game leading the Midwest League in numerous offensive categories, including team batting average (.259), slugging (.429), OPS (.774), doubles (73), RBI (166), and homers (36). They also have the fewest team strikeouts at 266.

**DIFFERENT STRENGTHS:** The Whitecaps have stolen just 8 bases this season, the fewest in MiLB. The next closest team is Triple-A Reno with 21.

**BRINGING THE PENA:** On May 4, Whitecaps pitcher Carlos Pena was named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Month for April. The 24-year-old pitched to a 0.47 ERA in five starts, covering 19.1 innings in the first month of the season, as he allowed one earned run and held opponents to a .200 average. Pena struck out 26 batters and was unscored upon in his first nine innings and his last nine innings of the month. Pena, 24, was signed by Detroit as an international free agent out of Santiago, DR, on March 6, 2019.

**CROUCHING TIGER, HIDDEN WHITECAP:** The Whitecaps recieved a boost when they recieved their 2022 captain from the Double-A Erie Seawolves, as catcher Josh Crouch rejoined the club on May 2. Crouch returns to West Michigan after being named a Postseason All-Star as a member of the Whitecaps in 2022. The 24-year-old was named the Best Defensive Catcher in the Midwest League in a vote among league managers for Baseball America. The Floridian hit .290-10-61 RBI in just 90 2022 games with the 'Caps.

**PROSPECTS APLENTY:** The Whitecaps hold seven of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects. Players include those mentioned near the top right corner of this page.

**HEALTH REPORT:** The 'Caps IL holds four players in pitchers Jackson Jobe, Tanner Kohlhepp, and Matt Walker, and catcher Eduardo Valencia.

A Top-30 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, the 22-year-old makes his high-A debut after posting an eye-popping 103 strikeouts through just 78.2 innings in low-A Lakeland with a 3.43 ERA. Burhenn played three seasons with the Ohio State Buckeyes, compiling a career 15-8 record with 189 punchouts through 192.2 innings, earning All-Big Ten Third Team honors his Junior season with Ohio State.

**LAST GAME:** Burhenn endured a rough third inning, giving up six runs and cutting his otherwise effective start short, as he allowed seven hits and four earned runs with two walks and a strikeouts as the Whitecaps lost to the Lansing Lugnuts by a score of 6-0 on May 13 at LMCU Ballpark.

**2021 (Junior):** Earned All-Big Ten honors after a standout season, finishing 7-2 with a 3.81 ERA and 103 strikeouts to just 19 walks. Burhenn also enjoyed a complete game shutout in his home city of Indianapolis, allowing just one run while striking out a career-high 10 batters in a 3-1 victory over the Indiana Hoosiers on May 23, 2021.

**2020 (Sophomore):** Burhenn struggled with hard contact early, posting a 2-2 record with an 8.02 ERA in the COVID-shortened season. However, he maintained a walk-to-strikeout ratio of 25-to-1 (ranked third in the BIG 10) while also compiling 29 strikeouts in just four games pitched.

**2019 (Freshman):** Earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team after going 6-4 with a 3.96 ERA in 15 starts. Burhenn struck out 69 batters while walking only 31 through 91 innings of work before missing the Big Ten Tournament due to injury.

**MORE:** Son of Heather and Dave Burhenn. Has one brother, Nick. Loves hockey and enjoyed going to see games at Ohio State Ice Rink. Graduate of Lawrence North High School in Indianapolis, Indiana where he hearned First Team All-State honors his senior season. Went to school for accounting and financing.

**THROWS:** Fastball (4 and 2-seam), SL (2 types, a sweep and short), changeup.
