FRES-NOTES

LIVING ON THE EDGE: Fresno has opened the series with back-to-back one-run victories, improving to 35-30 overall. The Grizzlies walked off Inland Empire 4-3 in Game 1 before rallying from two deficits of two runs at 3-1 and 5-3 for a 6-5 win in Game 2. Fresno has now won five of its last seven games, four in a row, with four of those victories decided by two runs or fewer.

CLUTCH OFFENSE SHOWING UP LATE: The Grizzlies have scored six of their 10 runs in the seventh inning or later through the first two games. Fresno erased a ninth-inning deficit Tuesday and scored four unanswered runs over the final four innings Wednesday. The club has continued a season-long trend of grinding out at-bats late in games, ranking among the California League leaders in walks and on-base percentage.

JUNE ADJUSTMENTS: After a difficult April, Fresno's pitching staff has steadily lowered its ERA each month. The Grizzlies posted a 5.89 ERA in April, improved to 5.26 in May, and have cut it all the way down to 4.46 through the first half of June. Fresno has allowed 138 earned runs in 211 innings during April, 140 earned runs in 239.2 innings during May, and just 62 earned runs in 125 innings this month. The improvement has coincided with stronger performances from the starting rotation, including Angel Jimenez (1.98 June ERA) and Easton Marks (2.92 June ERA), while the bullpen has been anchored by scoreless stretches from Bryson Van Sickle and Seth Clausen.
