Bourbon and Baseball... The Bowling Green Bootleggers return to the diamond on Thursday night against the Hub City Spartanburgers. This 10-year alternate identity honors the rich bourbon heritage in Kentucky. There are over 35 distilleries present throughout the Bluegrass State.

Salami For Summerhill... Outfielder Brendan Summerhill belted a grand slam on Wednesday night for his first High-A home run. It marked the seventh grand slam hit by Bowling Green during the 2026 season, all from different players. Summerhill grades as the Tampa Bay Rays' No. 20 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

Run, Tony, Run!... Infielder Tony Santa Maria logged a game-high two stolen bases on Wednesday. His 44 stolen bases paces the 2026 South Atlantic League, surpassing Rome Emperors infielder John Gil's 43. The 24-year-old is now 44-for-50 on steal attempts this season.

Top-Five Tony... Santa Maria also moved into sole possession of fifth-most single-season stolen bases in Bowling Green franchise history. Santa Maria overtook 2018 Hot Rods infielder Vidal Brujan last night. Fourth place is held by infielder Adrian Santana, who stole 47 bases during the 2025 SAL campaign.

Lucky No. 7... Infielder Nicandro Aybar extended his hitting streak to seven games with a single on Wednesday night. The 21-year-old starred in his first series with the Hot Rods, going 11-for-19 (.579 AVG) with five RBI and six runs scored against the Greensboro Grasshoppers.

Flew For Three... Catcher Nathan Flewelling caught three Spartanburgers trying to steal in Wednesday night's defeat. Flewelling has gunned down 27 steal attempts this season, sixth-most in the 2026 SAL season.

Harry's Hill... Bowling Green turns to right-hander Trevor Harrison to start Thursday night's contest. The Rays' No. 18 prospect owns a 10.13 K/9 over 17 starts this season. Bowling Green is 11-6 in games that Harrison starts.
