FRES-NOTES

GRIZZLIES LOOK TO LEAPFROG THE PORTS: Fresno sits two games behind Stockton in the second-half standings entering tonight, with the Ports and San Jose tied atop the North at 27-21 (.563) and the Grizzlies at 25-23 (.521) after Saturday's extra-inning loss in San Jose. This six-game set is also the last meeting between the two clubs this season, and Fresno already holds the edge in the season series at 10-8 — meaning a strong week does double duty, padding the head-to-head margin while chipping directly at the two-game gap that stands between the Grizzlies and a second-half playoff spot. With only 18 games left on the schedule, this series represents nearly a third of Fresno's remaining path to October. Every game against Stockton right now carries outsized weight, and tonight is the first chance to start closing the distance.

BEARLY SEPARATED: Whatever the standings say, Fresno's offense has thoroughly outplayed Stockton head-to-head this season, hitting .280 with a .866 OPS and an eye-popping 27 home runs in just 18 games against the Ports. That power surge has produced 114 RBI in those meetings, while Stockton's lineup has managed only a .698 OPS and 13 homers against Fresno pitching over the same stretch. The Grizzlies have out-slugged the Ports by nearly 150 points of OPS in this series, a gap that's rare between two teams separated by two games in the standings. If that trend holds across six more games, Fresno's bats could be the difference-maker in this playoff push.

RENZULLO HAS THE PORTS' NUMBER: Few Grizzlies have more history — or more success — against Stockton than Carlos Renzullo, who is hitting .364 with a .923 OPS against the Ports this season, going 8-for-22 with a homer and 5 RBI. He's been remarkably disciplined doing it too, drawing three walks against just a single strikeout in 26 plate appearances against Stockton pitching. Renzullo is one of only four hitters on Fresno's active roster who has already faced the Ports this year, giving him a rare edge in familiarity as the Grizzlies open this crucial series. With the season series and a playoff spot both on the line, Renzullo's track record makes him a name to watch all week.

FEW FAMILIAR FACES, BIG NUMBERS AGAINST THE PORTS: Roster turnover means only a handful of current Grizzlies have a track record against Stockton, but the ones who do have been outstanding. Manuel Olivares has been perfect against the Ports this year, posting a 0.00 ERA and a .100 opponents' average across 8.2 innings over four appearances, while Yanzel Correa has been nearly as sharp with a 1.13 ERA and .179 average allowed in 8.0 innings. Just four hitters on Fresno's active roster — Andujar, Fossum, Freitez and Renzullo — have logged at-bats against Stockton this season, meaning most of tonight's lineup will be writing its own history against the Ports. With so little precedent to lean on for much of the roster, the players who have already found success against Stockton could be the ones who set the tone for this series.
