### FROM THE CROWS NEST

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Bradenton Marauders were swept in a doubleheader on Saturday afternoon by the Tampa Tarpons by a score of 7-3 and 5-1 in eight innings. In game two, **Clevari Tejada** tossed five scoreless innings with **Peyton Stumbo** recorded two scoreless frames as well. **Justin Miknis** extended his on-base streak to 14 games in game one while **Keiner Delgado's** streak came to an end at 17 games.

**HAPPY BARBANEGRAS DAY:** For the third and final time this year at LECOM Park, the Bradenton Marauders are taking on their alternate identity of the Bradenton Barbanegras in celebration of Hispanic Heritage. The other celebration dates were April 21 and June 8 in which Bradenton won on a miraculous comeback in April before edging out the Clearwater Threshers 2-1 in June, a game that Sunday's starter Khristian Curtis earned the win in.

**LAST ONE, BEST ONE:** Sunday's series-finale against Tampa also marks the final home contest for the Marauders in 2024. Bradenton is currently 33-32 at home this year with just an 11-18 record in the second half. It's the last Pirates related baseball game at LECOM Park until Spring Training and February 23rd when the Pirates host the Minnesota Twins.

**SEARCHING FOR THE BIG HIT:** Over the last four games, the Marauders' offense is just 4-for-42 (.095) hitting with runners in scoring position which is the third-lowest mark in Single-A during this span. On Saturday, the Marauders went 0-for-15 combined in both games and are 0-for-their last-21 in this scenario with their last hit, a Justin Miknis three-RBI double in the sixth inning on Friday night.

**A HISTORIC NIGHT:** On Tuesday against Tampa, **Jhonnny Severino** went 4-for-4 at the plate and collected a single, a double, a triple, and a home run to become the first Marauders batter in franchise history to hit for the cycle. Severino has also been the only Marauder to record four or more hits in a game, last accomplishing that feat in early August in St. Lucie.

**HEY NOW, YOU'RE AN ALL-STAR:** On Thursday afternoon, Minor League Baseball announced four current Marauders had been named to the Florida Complex League All-Star team. The list included **INF Jhonnny Severino**, **INF Carlos Caro**, **INF Yordany De Los Santos**, and **RHP Zander Mueth**. Mueth was also named the Pitcher of the Year in the FCL. RHP David Matoma was the other Pirates representative on the list with the Pirates owning the most players recognized.

**STAYING HOT: INF Keiner Delgado's** on-base streak came to an end at 17 games on Saturday night in game two of a doubleheader against Tampa. The 17-game stretch was tied for the longest active streak in the Florida State League with Archer Brookman (LAK). **Esmerlyn Valdez** holds the longest on-base streak by a Marauder this year at 19 games, doing so from April 24 - May 19. Delgado also held a nine-game hitting streak earlier this season, the longest by a Marauder batter. **Shalin Polanco's** (12 games) also came to an end in game two while **Justin Miknis** (14 games) extended his in game one.

**TARPON FISHING:** The Tampa Tarpons make their lone visit to LECOM Park this year beginning on Tuesday night. Bradenton split a pair of series and lost the other in their three meetings last year. In their only trip to Bradenton last August, Tampa won four out of the six games. In fact, the Tarpons have won their last three series meetings in Bradenton and haven't lost one since May of 2019.

**SECOND INNINGS IS OURS:** This season, the Bradenton Marauders have scored 76 runs in the second inning. The 76 runs are the sixth-most in Single-A this season and 11th-most among High-A and Double-A teams as well.

**AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS:** The Marauders hold three of the top nine home run leaders in the Florida State League, with **Esmerlyn Valdez** leading the way in second with 19 longballs. **Axiel Plaz** is currently in fourth with 15 and **Javier Rivas** is in ninth with 12. Valdez is just one HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 19 HR hit by Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

**CLOSE QUARTERS:** Both wins last Saturday against Lakeland marked the Marauders' 40th and 41st one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 21-20 record in those games. After dropping their previous five one-run games, Bradenton has won three-straight.

**Last Time Out:** In his second start off the injured list, Curtis allowed just an unearned run in the second inning against Dunedin last Thursday night and left with a 4-1 lead. The Blue Jays rattled off five runs in the last three innings to win 6-5.
