OKLAHOMA CITY BASEBALL CLUB (28-23) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (16-35)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque and Oklahoma City meet for the third series of four on the year and the final set in the Duke City in 2024 ... The Isotopes are coming off thier seventh series loss of the year (0-7-2) after dropping four of six at Salt Lake ... Juan Hillman is slated to start for Albuquerque while Hyun-il Choi is expected to toe the rubber for Oklahoma City.

NOW THAT'S WHAT I CALL QUALITY: Karl Kauffmann's quality start Sunday was the third of the season for Albuquerque (also: Noah Davis, April 14 vs. Sugar Land; Josh Rogers, May 4 vs. Round Rock). It marked the second time an Isotopes hurler completed seven frames, joining Rogers' May 4 outing.

WALK-OFF LOSS: The walk-off loss Sunday (bases-loaded walk to Charles Leblanc, 5-4) was the Isotopes second of the year and series (other: May 23, Elliot Soto three-run double, 9-8) ... It was the eighth time in club history they've lost via game-ending free pass and first since Aug. 12, 2021 at Sugar Land (Jose Siri).

COMBINED KNOCKS: Sunday's game featured just 12 combined hits, the second-fewest in an Isotopes contest this year (lowest: 11, April 5 at Oklahoma City) ... Additionally, Albuquerque was held to six or fewer knocks for the sixth time in 2024, and second time in the last three games.

DINGERS ALLOWED: The Bees connected on just two home runs this week, tied for the fewest allowed by Albuquerque in a six-game series (also: Sept. 12-17, 2023 at El Paso).

ONE-RUN GAMES: The Isotopes dropped to 4-10 in one-run games, including three losses to the Bees during last week's set. Overall, the Isotopes have lost four-straight one-run contests.

EXTRA-INNINGS: Sunday's game was the Isotopes first extrainning contest of the year and first since Sept. 17, 2023, at El Paso (11-8 loss, 10 innings).

THREE-BAGGERS: Drew Romo collected a triple Sunday, tallying the Isotopes MiLB-leading 26th three-bagger of the year. Albuquerque has tallied a triple in 18 of 51 games.

200 RBI: Coco Montes became the sixth Isotope to tally 200 RBI with the club Saturday night, six days after Sam Hilliard completed the feat. Isotope RBI leaders: Jason Wood, 328 (2003, 6, 2008); Jordan Patterson, 229 (2016-18); Mike Tauchman, 211 (2016-18); Sam Hilliard, 201 (2019-present) and Montes, 200 (2022-present).

ERROR 404: The Isotopes have committed multiple errors in three-straight for the second time this year (also: April 3-5).

FAN FAVORITE: Coco Montes has a hit in 12 of his last 13 contests (23x54), slashing .426/.484/.667 with five doubles, a triple, two homers and 13 RBI. ... Has reached base twice in 17 of 21 games played in May.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard was held hitless Sunday to end a sixgame hitting streak ... It was just the fifth time in his last 30 starts without a hit, dating back to April 19.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver went 2-for-3 Sunday with a double and solo homer, his fourth clout of the season. It was his second contest with multiple extra-base hits in 2024, as he doubled twice on March 31 vs. El Paso.

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia's eight-game hitting streak ended Sunday, slashed .290/.405/.516 with a double, two homers and four RBI during stretch ... Has 100 RBI in 119 Triple-A games.

HIS NAME IS DREW: Drew Romo went 1-for-3 Sunday with a two-run triple, the third time in the series he delivered a runscoring extra-base hit off a left-handed pitcher in the seventh inning or later. However, Romo was just 5-for-26 against the Bees, one knock in five of six games.

ON A HEATER: Since April 21, Romo is slashing .387/.402/.670 with eight doubles, two triples, six homers and 24 RBI.

BOONIE: Trevor Boone has seven triples in just 48 contests at the Triple-A level ... Has a hit in five of fsix games this year.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 3rd in average (.351), and T-8th in hits (54) ... Aaron Schunk is T-3rd in doubles (15) ... Coco Montes is 1st in OBP (.447) and hits (62), 2nd in average (.358), 4th in OPS (1.008), T-6th in walks (30), 7th in total bases (97) and 8th in slugging (.561) ... **Sam Hilliard** is 2nd in runs (41), 3rd in total bases (107) and OPS (1.018), 4th in slugging (.598), T-4th in XBH (24), walks (31), homers (11) and hits (58), 5th in OBP (.420), T-7th in triples (3) and 8th in average (.324).

TEAM STATS: Offensively in MiLB, the club is 1st in slugging (.493), OPS (.863), average (.289), total bases (881) and hits (516), 2nd in runs (315), 3rd in doubles (111) and 4th in homers

GRANNY: Grant Lavigne's miscue in the eighth Sunday was his 13th of the season, worst among all Triple-A players.

KAUFFEY: Karl Kauffmann completed 7.0+ innings for just the second time in his pro career Sunday. He spun 8.0 shutout frames for Double-A Hartford on May 6, 2022 vs. Binghamton.

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
