ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians continued their assault on Eugene Emeralds (Giants) pitching Friday night as the C's took down the Ems 9-1 behind 11 hits - including five for extra bases - to even the series at two games apiece.

Leading 1-0 in the fourth after a Tanner Morris RBI single in the previous frame, the Canadians scored the eventual game winning run on one swing. With Spencer Horwitz at second thanks to a walk and a sacrifice bunt, Ronny Brito clubbed his fourth home run of the year to plate a pair and add to a Vancouver lead they wouldn't relinquish.

Luis Quinones (W, 2-2) returned to form with ten strikeouts in five innings pitched and surrendered a single run on two hits to earn the win. He managed to work around five walks - including three in the bottom of the second that were all stranded on base - to keep Eugene off balance throughout the night.

The C's piled on late. Phil Clarke started the seventh with a walk then scored on a DJ Neal double before Neal came home later in the frame courtesy of Cameron Eden's single to centerfield that made it 5-1. Luis De Los Santos belted a three-run homer in the eighth inning after Eric Rivera worked a two-out walk and Neal rolled a seeing-eye single past the shortstop, and Brito brought home his third RBI of the game with a double in the ninth that put the C's up 9-1.

Relievers Alex Nolan and Cobi Johnson each turned in a pair of scoreless innings to secure the win.

Seven of nine starters had a hit, seven scored at least one run and eight reached base. De Los Santos, Morris, Brito and Neal all logged multi-hit efforts.

THE EMERALDS CITY: Vancouver arrives at PK Park this week for their first and only visit to Central Oregon. These two teams last met June 1-6 at Ron Tonkin Field when the Ems took four of six from the C's, when the Giants affiliate outscored the Canadians 38-29.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN CANADIANS HISTORY: June 26, 2014 - The C's scored early and often to beat Tri-City 6-4 at Nat Bailey Stadium. Ryan McBroom hit his second home run as a pro in the bottom of the fifth for what proves to be the winning run and finished the day with two hits and a pair of RBI. Franklin Barreto went 2-for-4 with a double - his sixth of the season - and an RBI while Jonathan Davis tripled for the fourth time that year and scored a run. Zak Wasilewski earned the win with five innings in which he scattered eight hits, gave up three runs, walked two and struck out one.

OMAHA: Two C's - Phil Clarke (Vanderbilt) and Tanner Morris (Virginia) - have alma maters playing in the College World Series this week. Virginia has been eliminated while Vanderbilt beat NC State in an elimination game yesterday before the Wolfpack were sent home due to pandemic protocol. Parker Caracci's former team (Ole Miss) was bounced in the Tucson Super Regional while Sam Ryan (VCU), Sean Wymer (TCU) Cobi Jonson & CJ Van Eyk (Florida State), Brandon Eisert (Oregon State) and Sean Mellen (Northeastern) all saw their former clubs lose in their respective regionals.

HIT PARADE: The Canadians are 10-2 this year when logging ten or more hits in a game.

LATE LOCK: Vancouver is 22-0 when leading after 7 and 23-1 when ahead after 8.

MILESTONES: Last night, the C's collectively recorded their 100th multi-hit game and 50th multi-RBI game of the season.

30, FLIRTY AND DRIVING: Vancouver's two home runs last night give them 29 on the year. Who will hit number 30?

ON THE HILL: RHP Paxton Schultz gets the ball for Vancouver. In his last turn on June 20 against Everett, the right-hander worked a season-low 3.1 innings but allowed just one run on five hits (a solo home run was the only damage). He walked three and struck out three. Schultz, 23, last faced Eugene on June 6 when he baffled the Emeralds for six innings; that day, the Orem, UT native allowed just two hits and a single run while issuing to walks and striking out a season-high nine batters.

Conner Nurse climbs the slope for Eugene. In his last turn on June 20 against Hillsboro, the right-hander went five innings in which he gave up three runs on six hits - including two home runs - with three walks and five strikeouts. Nurse faced Vancouver on June 2, when he went a season-high 5.1 innings and allowed three runs (two earned) on six hits with a walk and a strikeout. The 21-year-old was taken by the Giants in the 34th round (1,026th overall) in 2017 out of Ridge HS in Davenport, FL.
