Today: The Lansing Lugnuts look for a fourth straight win when they play the third game in six-game series against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, the only meetings of the year between the two teams. Thursday starter Kyle Robinson, the A's 11th-rounder last year from Texas Tech, makes his second start of the season, opposed by Wisconsin southpaw Anthony Flores.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, Timber Rattlers 1. Yunior Tur fanned eight batters in 4 2/3 innings, and the Nuts rallied for three runs in the eighth inning against the Wisconsin bullpen to win a second straight game in the series, culminated by a Nate Nankil diving catch on the warning track in the left field corner.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and T-Rats play a doubleheader tomorrow and a matinee Saturday to wrap up the series, then the Nuts head home to play 12 games in 13 days.

#### Lug•Notes

That WWWorks: The Lugnuts' three-game winning streak is the longest such streak in the Midwest League. It is also the Nuts' longest winning streak since July 21-24, 2024. A four-game streak would match July 11-14, 2024... and the last time the Nuts won more than four straight games, it was 2022.

Consistency: Jared Dickey has reached base in 10 straight games while Rodney Green, Jr. has reached base in nine straight games. The longest hitting streak belongs to Nate Nankil, who has at least one base hit in his last eight games.

Best in the League: Lansing's offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.261), fewest strikeouts (76) and on-base percentage (.389), ranking one base hit (98-97) below Cedar Rapids for the league lead.

Plunked: Nuts batters were hit twice in the eighth inning yesterday, with T.J. Schofield-Sam's HBP forcing in the tie-breaking run. Lansing's pitchers have hit the fewest batters in the Midwest League (5), while Lugnuts hitters have been 11 times, 4th highest in the circuit. (In contrast, Quad Cities has been hit by only one pitch all year.)

Leaderboard: Center fielder Rodney Green, Jr. is tied for the league lead in home runs (4), tied for 3rd in runs scored (10), tied for 3rd in total bases (23), and tied for 5th in walks (11). Fellow outfielders Jared Dickey is tied for 5th in walks (11) and Nate Nankil is tied for 5th in RBIs (10) and base hits (13). Among pitchers, Yunior Tur's 8-K game yesterday moved him into a 4thplace tie in strikeouts (14), while Henry Gómez's second save moved him into a 1st-place tie with four other closers.

Alumni Report: Athletics first baseman Tyler Soderstrom, who spent the 2022 season in Lansing, leads the Major Leagues with eight home runs and ranks 3rd in total bases (48), 4th in slugging (.706) and 5th in OPS (1.101), 2017 Lugnut Bo Bichette is tied for 3rd in the Majors in base hits (25) and doubles (8). And 2023 Lugnuts starter Mason Miller continues to dominate as the A's closer, recording his 5th save yesterday by striking out the side in a perfect ninth at the White Sox; Miller has worked six scoreless innings this year, allowing three hits, walking one and striking out 12.

Good Scheduling: Not only are the Athletics currently playing on the south side of Chicago, about three hours away from Appleton, they'll start a three-game series in Milwaukee against the Brewers from Friday-Sunday. It's the closest that the Lugnuts' MLB parent club will be to them all season.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman Tommy White (40th overall), southpaw starter Gage Jump (73rd), shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (75th) and outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old Steven Echavarria, rated No. 12, and outfielder Nate Nankil, who is No. 30.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is Darryl Kennedy, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017

**History vs. Wisconsin** 

The Lugnuts are 87-62 all-time vs. the Timber Rattlers, 44-25 at home and 43-37 in Appleton, Wisconsin.

The two clubs did not meet up in 2021 nor in 2024.

In 2022, the Lugnuts won four of six in Appleton, a series that saw the MWL debut of A's closer Mason Miller. In 2023, the Nuts and T-Rats split a six-game series, made memorable by Jack Winkler's cycle on June 21.

That remains the Lugnuts' most recent cycle.

High School: Played four years on varsity for George C. Marshall High School (Falls Church, Virginia)... named All-Conference First Team as sophomore, junior and senior... named Conference Pitcher of the Year and Conference Player of the Year as a senior: 66 2/3 IP, 1.49 ERA, 60 K... George C. Marshall is best known for the Marshall Plan, which saw the United States give \$13.3 billion to help rebuild Western European economies; it earned Marshall the 1953 Nobel Peace Prize... Marshall's nickname is the Statesmen... other notable Marshall alumni include the first woman to officially run the Boston Marathon, Kathrine Switzer; safety and current Dallas Cowboys special teams coordinator Nick Sorensen; defensive end Michael McCrary; table tennis legend Sean O'Neill; and pitcher Pete Schourek.
