TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves conclude a six-game road series against the Blue Wahoos on Sunday afternoon. This is the first of five series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 30 times.

The M-Braves are 4-7 on their longest road trip of the season, having split the six-game series in Biloxi, April 25-30, at MGM Park.

LAST NIGHT'S RECAP: Jesse Franklin V homered in his first game back from the IL, and Drew Lugbauer also went deep, but the M-Braves fell to Pensacola, 3-2, on Saturday night...After a 1 hour, 14-minute rain delay, Alan Rangel took the mound, and tossed four shutout innings before yielding two runs in the fifth, on a homer by Griffin Conine, and another in the sixth... Rangel allowed two earned runs on five hits with two walks, and six strikeouts in the loss... Lugbauer was 2-for-4 to pace the offense.

"KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are 2nd in the Southern League, and T-9th in Double-A with 27 homers - 23 coming on the road. 11 different players have at least one homer with Drew Lugbauer leading the way with five, also T-2nd in the Southern League.

VIVA LA VALDES: Javier Valdes notched his first career two-homer game on April 30 in Biloxi. In five games on the road trip, the Miami native is 9-for-19 with three doubles, three home runs, and three RBI.

Multi-homer game: His two-homer game was the first by an M-Braves player this season, and first since Drew Lugbauer hit two on 9/7/22 at Biloxi.

COUNTIN' ON CAL: INF Cal Conley ranks 4th in the Southern League with 10 stolen bases. Conley is 3-for-7 with two doubles, and two runs over the last two games.

SMITH-SHAWVER, NO 4 PROSPECT ARRIVES: The Atlanta Braves promoted No. 4 prospect (MLB Pipeline), RHP AJ Smith Shawver to Mississippi on Tuesday. He debuted on Friday, tossing 2.0 scoreless innings before rain halted play in the top of the third inning. In three Rome starts, the 20-year-old did not allow a run in 14.0 innings, with 23 strikeouts to four walks. Smith-Shawver is set to make his Double-A debut on Friday night.

Smith-Shawver was Atlanta's 7th-round pick in 2021 out of Colleyville High School (TX). At 20 years, 163 days, he is the youngest pitcher for the M-Braves since Ian Anderson was promoted to Mississippi on August 8, 2018 at 20 years, 98 days

GORDON PROMOTED: RHP Tanner Gordon was promoted to Triple-A Gwinnett on Thursday. He didn't allow a run over his last two starts, and 12.2 IP, on seven hits, with 12 strikeouts, and one walk. On the season, Gordon is 2-2 with a 1.63 ERA, over five starts, 27.2 IP, four walks, and 27 strikeouts. Gordon leads the league in innings pitched, 5th in ERA, 7th in opponents' batting average (.183), and 4th in WHIP (0.83).

PROSPECTING: Currently, six of Atlanta's Top 30 prospects, according to MLB Pipeline are on the active roster. Those include: RHP AJ Smith-Shawver (4), RHP Victor Vodnik (11), INF Cal Conley (13), OF Jesse Franklin V (14), RHP Alan Rangel (26), and LHP Luis De Avila (30).

FRANKLIN V IS BACK: OF Jesse Franklin V returns from the 7-day Injured List on Saturday. The 24-year-old was placed on the IL on April 28, last season, with a left elbow injury that required Tommy John surgery. Franklin is Atlanta's No. 14 prospect according to MLB Pipeline, and was their third-round selection (97th overall) in the shortened 2020 draft out of Michigan. In a corresponding move, OF Bryson Worrell was transferred from Mississippi to the FCL roster.

GOOD PITCHING NUMBERS: The M-Braves rank 2nd in the Southern League, and 7th in Double-A with a 3.16 ERA over the last 15 games since April 20. On the season, the club ranks 3rd in the league, and 11th in Double-A with a 3.82 ERA.

M-Braves starters have a 3.59 ERA which ranks 6th in Double-A, while 122 strikeouts in 112.2 innings pitched is T-10th among Double-A teams.

BIG BAD BARGER: The 25-year-old reliever has quietly put together a solid start to the season. He has two saves, and across 12.0 innings, Barger has 14 strikeouts to six walks, in eight appearances, allowing no runs.

ROLLIN' ROBLES: LHP Domingo Robles is starting to find his groove, allowing two earned runs over 18.0 innings in his last two starts. On Friday, the left-hander went 7.0 innings and allowed no runs off three hits and a walk with seven strikeouts. Robles is 3-1 with a 1.71 ERA and 25 strikeouts over 21.0 innings for the M-Braves.

Robles currently ranks 5th in the league in ERA, T1st in wins, and T9th in WHIP (1.10).

SHEWMAKE TO THE BIGS: INF Braden Shewmake was called up to Atlanta on Friday, and will make his MLB debut against Baltimore. Shewmake will be the third M-Braves alum to make his MLB debut this season (LHP Dylan Dodd, LHP Jared Shuster), and 164th since 2005. A member of the 2021 Double-A South Championship squad, the Texas A&M product hit .228 over 83 games with 14 doubles, 12 home runs, and 40 RBI during that season. Shewmake has batted .243 with five homers and 17 RBI in 24 games with Triple-A Gwinnett this season.

THE KING ADDS ANOTHER GEM TO HIS CROWN: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. The towering 426-foot blast landed on top of the parking deck past right field. The ball left Lugbauer's bat at 115 miles per hour.

Lugbauer has a club record 51 home runs over parts of three seasons, blowing past the previous record of 32 (Travis Demeritte/Connor Lien). He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26).

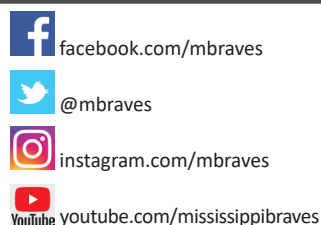
