### NORFOLK HALTS JUMBO SHRIMP WINNING STREAK

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell to the Norfolk Tides, 10-2, from 121 Financial Ballpark on Tuesday evening. The Tides (25-8) got off to a hot start, plating seven runs in the opening frame. Jacksonville cut into the deficit with two runs in the bottom of the second. Norfolk added three runs in the third and their eight-run cushion was too insurmountable to overcome. Charles Leblanc continued his hot-streak, going 3-for-3 at the plate with a walk.

### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 17 of their last 23 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 58 runs, 50 earned, on 104 hits (8.8 H/9) in 106.0 innings for a 4.24 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 75 punchouts (6.4 K/9). However, they have only issued 37 walks during this run, a rate of 3.1 per nine innings.

### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late: Jacksonville has registered 130 free passes over the last 24 games since April 11, a figure that ranks second in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 13.5 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games, Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

### JERARASSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion has been on a tear since the season's second week. Over his last 24 games dating back to April 7. the native of Bayaguana in the Dominican Republic is 27for-94 at the plate, slashing .287/.422/.479/.901 with nine doubles, three homers, 16 RBIs and 22 walks. Encarnacion places amongst the league leaders in several categories this year, including doubles (T-9th, 9), walks (T-13th, 22) and RBIs (T-19th, 23).

### WAVE RUNNERS

Last year Jacksonville struggled against their International League East foes, going 39-45. However, against Norfolk, Jacksonville went 11-10, winning the Navy Town Showdown. Although the Jumbo Shrimp slashed .250/.327/.403/.730 with 21 home runs and 93 RBIs, the pitching staff struggled. The Jumbo Shrimp hurlers compiled a 5.03 ERA was the third-worst ERA among 2022 opponents. Norfolk hit .233 against Jacksonville pitchers, plating 102 ER in 182.1 innings. The Tides' 21 home runs against Jumbo Shrimp pitchers was the third-most hit against the pitching staff out of the 10 teams Jacksonville faced in 2022. The 2021 Navy Town Showdown series also featured Jacksonville's record-setting game where the offense put up 20 runs on June 4, 2022, the most in a game since 2005.

### KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last nine games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 14-for-33 (.424) with two doubles, home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 15 walks for a .604 on-base percentage. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (27) more than he has struck out (25). Leblanc ranks second in the International League in walk percentage (23.5 percent) and tied for third in total walks (27). His swingingstrike rate of 7.8 percent is tied for th 22nd-lowest out of the circuit's 135 qualified hitters.

### 'PFN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the 11 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 18 runs, 12 earned, on 23 hits (3.7 H/9) in 55.2 innings for a 1.94 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 57 strikeouts (9.2 K/9) against 35 walks (5.7 BB/9) during this recent run.

### **ABOUT SEAN**

-Native of Seaford N.Y., Nolin has pitched in 18 Major League games, including 12 starts with the Toronto Blue Jays, Washington Nationals and Oakland Athletics. He owns a career record of 1-5 with a 5.74 ERA in 58.0 Major League innings.

-Nolin was drafted three times. The Milwaukee Brewers picked him in the 50th round of the 2008 draft out of Seaford High School in New York. He opted to attend San Jacinto College, and following his first season there, he was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 48th round of the 2009 draft. He decided to return to San Jacinto again and was picked by the Toronto Blue Jays in the sixth round of the 2010 draft. He then signed with the Blue Jays, beginning his professional career.

-Nolin made his Major League debut on May 24, 2013 for the Blue Jays in a game against the Baltimore Orioles at the Rogers Centre. He pitched 1.1 innings in a 10-6 loss.

-When Nolan piched in South Korea, he collobarted with the oringzation Free Korean Dogs to help spread awareness about the dog and cat meat trade.

-Growing up on Long Island, Nolin was a fan of the New York Yankees and his favorite pitcher was Andy Pettitte, who he modled his game after.

### 2023 SEASON

-Nolin was trasnfered to Jacksonville from the FCL Marlins on April 18th. He made his Jacksonville debut the next day against Nashville at 121 Financial Ballpark.

### 2022 SEASON

-Nolin made 21 starts for the Kia Tigers, posting an 8-8 record and 2.47 ERA with 108 strikeouts in 124.0 innings pitched.

### 2021 SEASON

-On August 11, 2021, the Nationals selected Nolin's contract, marking his first appearance in MLB in six years.

-Nolin made  $10\ \mbox{appearances}$  for the Nationals, going 0-2 with a  $4.39\ \mbox{ERA}$  and 20 strikeouts.
