JUMBO SHRIMP SWEPT WITH 5-2 LOSS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp were swept by the Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre RailRiders with Sunday's 5-2 loss. The RailRiders methodically built up a 4-0 lead and held the Jumbo Shrimp without until the eighth inning. Jacksonville was able to nab a pair of runs in that frame, but Scranton/ Wilkes-Barre plated a run in the ninth to get the tally to 5-2. Jacksonville was swept for the first time since Mississippi broomed the club from May 1-5 of the 2019 season. The Jumbo Shrimp had not been swept at home since Montgomery did so in a seven-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018.

TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 24 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 30-for-95, slashing .316/.377/.526/.903 with five doubles, five home runs, 20 RBIs, 10 walks and 19 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 16.0 percent this season with Jacksonville.

TROY MEETS WORLD

Troy Johnston, the Miami Marlins Minor League Player of the Year in 2023, got off to a slow start this season. Through his first 16 games, the Puyallup, Wash., batted just.203/.292/.234/.526 with two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and three runs scored. In his last 17 games, however, Johnston is 22-for-68 at the plate, hitting .324/.361/.485/.846 with eight doubles, one home run, seven RBIs, three walks and 11 runs scored.

SIXPENCE NONE THE RICHER

Jacksonville's 5-2 loss to Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on Sunday marked the sixth straight defeat for the Jumbo Shrimp - the club's longest losing streak since dropping six straight games from May 29-June 3, 2023. During this six-game stretch, Jacksonville has been outscored nearly 2-to-1 by a margin of 36-19, dropping from 1.5 games back in the standings of the first-place RailRiders to 7.5 games back. Jacksonville has not suffered seven straight losses since an eight-game skid from April 29-May 7, 2023.

IT IS HOW YOU START

Out of the club's 293.1 innings pitched thus far in 2024, Jacksonville starting pitchers have accounted for just 146.1 frames, a ratio of only 49.9 percent. That said, those 146.1 innings are the seventh-most in Triple-A for any starting rotation. Jumbo Shrimp starters have also provided quality in their innings. The club's starting rotation has posted a 4.41 ERA, which ranks seventh Triple-A. The club's .251 batting average against from its starters ranks ninth. Jacksonville starters have yielded three runs or fewer in 15 of their last 18 games.

SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through 33 games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only 144 runs (4.4 per game), a figure that ranks 28th in Triple-A in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. Thus far during the 2024 campaign, the Jumbo Shrimp are batting a woeful .239/.336/.382/.718 (ranking 27th, 26th, 25th and 25th, respectively, in those respective slash categories in Triple-A), with runners in scoring position. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th at the Triple-A level.

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 20 of Jacksonville's 33 games (60.6 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer. The Jumbo Shrimp have mostly excelled in these contests, going 12-8 (.667) in those closely-decided affairs thus far. However, Jacksonville has lost five of their last six games decided by three runs or fewer, including four straight. Last season, 85 of the club's 149 games (57.0 percent) were determined by no more than three runs, with the club going 39-46 (.459) in those contests. Prior to that, Jacksonville had been over .500 in games decided by three runs or fewer in every season from 2019-22.

SHRIMP BITES

Will Banfield has reached base in seven of his last eight games, batting 11-for-29 (.379/.471/.621/1.092) with two doubles, one triple, one homer and seven RBIs during that span... Jacksonville's 12 road games played are tied for the fewest in the International League thus far. The Jumbo Shrimp have won both their road sets (at DUR, at MEM).
