RIDERS FALL IN SERIES OPENER TO TULSA:

The Frisco RoughRiders jumped ahead early on **Jax Biggers**' leadoff home run in the first inning but Tulsa outpaced Frisco for a 7-2 win at Riders Field on Tuesday. On the second pitch of Frisco's day offensively, Biggers homered to right field. It was his eighth homer of the year and first since rejoining the club from Triple-A. Down 3-1 in the sixth inning, Frisco drew three walks and scored **Evan Carter** on **Aaron Zavala**'s fielder's choice. Carter reached twice with his walk and a single, while Zavala added a double to his RBI grounder. Biggers also reached twice, walking on nine pitches in his first plate appearance after his homer. Liam Hicks singled and reached on a hit by pitch. Hicks has now reached base in 22 of his last 24 games, and in all 26 of his games played at Riders Field this year. Nick Krauth (4-9) went 5.1 innings in his start for Frisco, allowing three runs and picking up the loss. He struck out the last batter he faced to tie his season high with six strikeouts. John Matthews pitched the eighth inning for Frisco, logging his sixth consecutive appearance without an earned run. He has covered eight innings in those appearances with just three hits allowed. Nick Frasso (3-4) collected the win for Tulsa, going five innings with one run allowed. After he gave up a home run to the first batter he faced, he did not allow a hit to the next 12 batters he faced.

NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 13 games in August, (7-6 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.03 ERA while allowing a league-low nine home runs and .205 BAA. The bullpen has allowed just 17 earned runs over 63.1 innings, a 2.42 ERA with 89 strikeouts to 19 walks. Ryan Garcia was brilliant on Tuesday, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. Nick Krauth then followed up with a second quality start on Wednesday, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when Owen White and Jack Leiter completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is last in the Texas League with a .705 OPS and runs per game with 4.5 per contest.

THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-28 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:

Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 42 games since, he is batting .295/.416/.494/.910 with 11 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 33 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 37 points and his OPS 97 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 66 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.1 percent walk rate this year is fourth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 16 times in his last 15 games. His .407 OBP on the season is ninth in all of Double-A and among all 13 players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 24 games, Hicks is batting .329 (28-for-85)/.424/.447/.871 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 13 walks and 12 runs scored. In his last 1 games, he is batting .359 (14-for-39) with a .919 OPS.

K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever Antoine Kelly has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 outings. During that stretch, he has 25 strikeouts to three walks over 21.2 innings while recording four saves. He has converted on all eight save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

-Grew up in Berkeley, California and played under father, Matt, at Berkeley High School. Mother, Shelly Neufeld played basketball at University of California. Older brother, Tyler, played baseball at Baylor and was drafted in the 27th round by the Cubs in 2012 (Finished his minor league career with Double-A Jacksonville in 2017 after 164 career outings).

-Went to University of Washington for college. Earned Louisville Slugger Freshman All-American honors in 2015, going 6-3 with a 2.41 ERA. In 2016 and 2017, garnered All-Pac-12 honors with a 2.98 ERA and 3.15 ERA, respectively.

-Broke into the UW career and single-season record books including: career starts (T6th, 40), innings pitched (3rd, 284), career strikeouts (6th, 205) and single-season strikeouts (7th, 103) over his three seasons.

2023 SEASON

-Returned from Tommy John Surgery on June 5th and pitched four games with AZL Rangers. Surgery was performed on March 30th, 2022.
