THE OFFENSE DOES IT AGAIN: The Delmarva Shorebirds won game two of their series against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (CWS) on Wednesday as the offense took off late by scoring 9 runs in the last two frames as handily defeated the visitors 12-2. It was a complete effort by Delmarva as the pitching staff combined for a season-high 15 strikeouts, allowing just 1 after the 2nd inning led by Edgar Portes who earned his second win in relief. Jackson Holliday paced the offense with his second 4-RBI game of the season as scored two each with a double and his first career triple. And the defense was clean for the Shorebirds as they did not commit any errors.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: The Shorebirds will look to make it three-straight against Kannapolis on Thursday night as they send their Opening Day Starter, Juan Nunez to the mound to face Tanner McDougal for the Cannon Ballers will be making his first appearance since 2021 after missing all of 2022 with an injury.

THE BATS ARE HOT: The offense for the Shorebirds has showed out through the first five games of the regular season as they are the early Carolina League leaders in runs (47), doubles (12), home runs (5), and OPS (.868). Delmarva has scored double digit runs in three of their first five games ad have scored 7 or more in all their wins.

CREED'S CAREER NIGHT: Creed Willems put on an unbelievable show for the home fans to kick-off the season at Perdue Stadium on Tuesday night as the 2nd year catcher registered career-highs with three hits and four RBIs, including a go-ahead two-run homer in the fourth to give Delmarva a 3-2 lead. Willems produced an RBI and an extra-base hit in each of his first three games of the season.

TWIN KILLING CATCHERS: Creed Willems and Samuel Basallo has been an tremendous duo offensively to begin 2023 as the two have a combined 4 home runs and 14 RBIs through the first five games of the regular season.

MAMA THERE GOES THAT MAN: The number one overall pick from the 2022 Draft, Jackson Holliday, continues his impressive start to his first full-season in professional baseball as he collected his second 4-RBI game of the season in just five starts with a two-hit performance on Wednesday where he brought home two runs with a double in the second inning and his first career triple in the eighth inning in the 12-2 rout of Kannapolis. Holliday has five extra-base hits in his first five games of the year and has knocked in 5 runs with two outs.

LIGHTS OUT BULLPEN: The bullpen arms have thrived in the opening home series of the year for Delmarva as they have not allowed any runs through the first two games in 13.1 innings. The unit has struck out 19 in the series and have walked just 4 through the first two games against Kannapolis after the pitching staff surrendered 24 as a whole in the first three games of the season versus Salem.

YOUNG MAN'S GAME: The debut roster for the Delmarva Shorebirds will showcase plenty of youth as the average of the team is 20.9 years-old.

REMEMBER US?: There will be plenty of familiar faces on the Shorebirds Opening Day roster with 23 players who suited up at least once for Delmarva will be on the team to start the season.

REVERSING THE TREND: Delmarva faced major struggles against South Division opponents in 2022 as they went 9-32. They did not play their current opponent, Kannapolis last season as they are facing them for the first time since 2019.

TODAY'S STARTER: Juan Nunez makes his second start of the seasor as the 22 year old right-hander makes his home debut.

LAST OUTING (4/6/23 @ SAL): Drew the Opening Day Start against Salem and came out of the gates strong pitching a pair of scoreless innings to begin the year but the Red Sox rallied to score three runs on him in the bottom of the third as Nunez was not able to make it through the inning allowing three hits in the inning. He was taken out after 55 pitches and did not factor into the decision in an 11-7 win.

vs. KANNAPOLIS: This will be Nunez's first start versus Kannapolis.

SHOREBIRDS COACHING STAFF

ELIPE ROJAS ALOU JR.

Returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.

PITCHING COACH

Enters his first season as the Shorebirds Pitching Coach in 2023 after spending last season as a O's Pitching Coach in the Florida Complex League. Bleday played his college days as a Left-handed Pitcher for the University of Pennsylvania before being drafted in the 27th round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros. From there, Bleday spent two season in the Astros minor league ranks before making the jump to coaching in 2019.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Josh Bunselmeyer takes over as the Shorebirds Hitting Coach in 2023 after spending the last three seasons as a hitting coach for the Orioles between the Florida Complex League and the Dominican Summer League. Before coaching, Bunselmeyer played independent ball for the three season in the Frontier League as a utility player after playing college baseball for Saint Louis University.

FUNDAMENTALS COACH

Daniel Fajardo Is back in Delmarva for his second season as the Shorebirds Fundamentals Coach. After playing eight seasons in the Orioles minor league system and parts of two with the Shorebirds, Fajardo made his professional coaching debut with the 'Birds in 2022 bringing a wealth of knowledge from his time as a catcher. A 2019 Shorebirds Mid-Season All-Star, Fajardo was a Shorebirds fan-favorite hitting for a career .251 average with 124 RBI and 106 Runs Scored.


DEVELOPMENT COACH
