FRED NATS CRUISE TO GAME SIX WIN: The Delmarva Shorebirds suffered their fifth defeat of the week on Saturday night as the Fred Nats defeated them by a score of 7-1. Delmarva found themselves playing from behind early again after a first inning, RBI double by **Paul Witt** to make it 1-0. Fredericksburg then capitalized on a pair of Shorebirds errors as they scored four unearned runs with **Sammy Infante** and **Brady House**. They'd another run on a wild pitch and home run by House in the fourth to elevate their lead to 7-0. Delmarva attempted to fight back by scoring their first run in the fifth on an RBI single by **Adam Crampton**, but ultimately, they could not break through as the Nationals went on to win Saturday's matchup 7-1.

TODAY'S OPPONENT: Bradley Brehmer makes his second appearances of the week after working as the opener in first game of the doubleheader on Tuesday. He will face Nationals' prospect arm, **Jarlin Susana**. The right-hander is the No. 6 prospect for the Washington according to MLB Pipeline and was acquired from San Diego in the package for Juan Soto last August. Susana is making his eighth start of the season and is 0-3 on the year with a 4.18 ERA. The hard-throwing right-hander is facing the Shorebirds for the second time this season, starting against them on April 20 where he went four innings and struck out five, allowing one run in a no-decision.

ON THE DOUBLE: The offense has provided extra-base hits regularly this season as they are tops in the league in that category with 122 through the first 48 games. Their 77 doubles this year are currently the most in the league. **Samuel Basallo** leads the team with 11 two-baggers this season and there are 8 players on the Shorebirds roster who have 6 or more.

LEADER IN THE CLUBHOUSE: Samuel Basallo has put together an incredibly productive first season in full-season baseball as the 18 year old catcher is the current Carolina League leader in RBIs with 40. Basallo has four games this season with 3 RBI and a career-best 4 RBI performance against Fredericksburg on April 18. After his three RBI on Friday night, Basallo now has 13 runs batted in 11 games versus the Fred Nats.

PRADO AT THE TOP: Elio Prado has had a strong run going at the plate since moving into the leadoff spot in the order as he is batting 19/61 (.311) over his last 15 games, striking out only six times in that time frame. His frequency on base has helped him score a team-best 15 runs in that span as he is now the team-leader with 29.

HOT TEJADA: Angel Tejada has been one of the hottest hitters in all the Carolina League over the last two weeks. In the last 17 games, Tejada is batting .272 (15/55) with 4 doubles, 3 homers, and 9 RBI. The infielder has reach base safely in 15 of those 18 games and has registered an RBI in 6 of them.

MOVING ON THE JUNE: The Shorebirds will look to regain their early season form offensively after a tough month of May. In the second month of the season, Delmarva batted .215 with an average of 4 runs per game. The strikeout rate very much increased in May as the offense struck out 288 times for an average of 11 time per game (35.5% K-Rate) which was second-worst in the Carolina League.

MORE BELLONY: Isaac Bellony has made an instant impact for the Shorebirds since joining their roster on May 30. He's contributed a hit in his first four starts this week, highlighted by a four-hit performance on Friday night. Bellony has drove in two runs in consecutive ball games and has grabbed a plethora of extra-base hits as he has two doubles and two triples in the series.

ROUND 2 WITH THE FREDDIES: The Shorebirds return to Fredericksburg for their second series with the Fred Nats. In the first series, Delmarva won four of the five matchups with offense score 48 runs in the five game combined, scoring six or more in every game with 18 extra base hits total throughout the week.

TODAY'S STARTER: Bradley Brehmer toes the slab for the final game of the seven-game series against the Fred Nats. This will be the second time Brehmer appears this week after he appeared as the opener for the restart of the suspended game played back on Tuesday.

LAST OUTING (5/30 vs LYN): Brehmer worked in relief as he opened the restart of the suspended matchup from April 22nd. He dealt 5 innings, matching his career-high of 6 strikeouts, allowing 3 runs (2 earned) on 4 hits in a no-decision.

vs. FREDERICKSBURG: This will be the third time Brehmer faces the Nationals this season. In addition to his outing on Tuesday, Brehmer also started the game against Fredericksburg on April 23 and went four innings on the hill, allowing two runs on five hits. He took a no-decision in an eventual 8-5 win.

2022 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS: Pitched his final year of college at the University of Indiana after three seasons at Wright State. Made 17 appearances, 14 as a starter and earned a 5-4 record with a 5.30 ERA. The sinker baller collected 77 strikeouts with 33 walks across 74.2 total innings with his top performance of the season coming on April 23 versus Nebraska where he dealt 6 innings on the mound and stuck out a season-best 11 Corn Huskers. Allowed just 1 run on 3 hits as his quality start led the Hoosiers to an 8-1. Was selected by the Orioles in the 12th Round of the 2022 Draft.

STAYING GROUNDED: Brehmer has been great at what he does best and that's getting the ball on ground. This season, the sinker baller has a 2.21/1 ground-out/air-out ratio. As a result, he's induced a team-high five double plays with 41% of his total outs being on ground.

MANAGER



Felipe returns to the Shorebirds for his second season as manager and his 16th in the Orioles organization. Previously, he served as the Director of the Orioles' Dominican Republic Academy. He was a 40th round pick by the Kansas City Royals in the 1998 amateur draft, he played in the minor leagues for the Royals from 1998 to 2001, and in the short-lived Canadian Baseball League in 2003. His father, Felipe, played in the Majors for 15+ years before managing the Expos ('92-'01) and Giants ('03-'06). Alou's brother, Luis Rojas, was the manager of the Mets and is currently on the Yankees coaching staff. This will be Felipe's 16th season in the Orioles organization.


