2022: Signed with the San Francisco Giants as an MiLB Free Agent prior to the season, posting a 5.13 ERA in 40.1 IP for Double-A Richmond before his release on July 21. Fenter then signed with the (independent) 2022 Atlantic League Champion Lancaster Barnstormers where he pitched in nine games, going 2-1 with a 2.95 ERA in 21.1 IP. He signed with the Yankees prior to the 2023 season.

2021: Made 13 starts and 8 relief appearances for Double-A Bowie, posting a 5.47 ERA in 77.1 IP with 86 K. Prior to the season, he was selected by the Chicago Cubs in the Rule 5 Draft. At Cubs Spring Training, Fenter threw a perfect, seven-pitch inning before being returned to the Orioles on March 12.

2019: Went 8-2 with a career-best 1.81 ERA and 33% K rate for Delmarva, holding opponents to a .185 BAA.

2018: Split season between Short-Season Class-A Aberdeen and Class-A Delmarva, going 8-6 with a 4.84 ERA and 91K in a career high of 83.2 IP over 13 starts and 14 relief appearances.

2017: Made 11 starts for the Rookie-level GCL Orioles recovering from injury, posting a 3.45 ERA in 28.2 IP with 33 K. Made one appearance for Short-Season Class-A Aberdeen, throwing 1.2 IP of relief.

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (1st year)

Dominguez begins his 1st season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 9th overall as a manager and 17th overall coaching in the Yankees organization. He spent the past two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre and was assigned to the same post for 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Dominguez becomes the 5th manager in Patriots franchise history and the 3rd since becoming the Yankees Double-A affiliate. He succeeds 2022 Eastern League Manager of the Year Dan Fiorito. Dominguez also previously served as the defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). The Panama City, Panama native has managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). From 2012-2015, his teams finished at least 10 games over .500, including reaching the DSL semifinals in 2012 and 2015. An outfielder during his playing days, Dominguez signed with the Yankees as an undrafted free agent in 2001 and spread four minor league seasons for New York between the DSL and the GCL. 


