JUNE 12th WORCESTER (29-35) at BUFFALO (33-31) 6:35 pm

Worcester Red Sox RHP Justin Hagenman (1-2, 5.64) vs. Buffalo Bisons RHP Beau Sulser (1-3, 7.59)

Buffalo Sauce – The Worcester Red Sox look to even this series at a victory apiece when they play game two of their 6-game set against the Buffalo Bisons (AAA-Toronto) tonight at 6:35 pm at Sahlen Field in downtown Buffalo. Tonight’s game can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. Last night the Bisons rallied for runs in the bottom of the 8th-inning to tie the game and another in the bottom of the 9th for a walk-off, 3-2 victory in the series-opener. For the WooSox it marked the 9th time they have lost a game during an opponent’s final at-bat and they dropped to 2-10 in 1-run games this season (the worst record in the league in that category).

This Series - The WooSox – who are paying their second visit to Buffalo in a month – play the Bisons again tonight & tomorrow both at 6:35 pm, Friday at 7:05 pm, Saturday at 6:35 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm. Worcester returns to action at Polar Park this coming Tuesday at 6:45 pm when they open a 6-game series against the Columbus Clippers (AAA-Cleveland) from June 18-23. It will be Peanut Allergy-Friendly Week at Polar Park all next homestand.

Halfway in Sight - The WooSox have just 11 games remaining before the official first half of the International League schedule ends on June 23. All teams will start anew at 0-0 when the second half begins on June 25. At this point, IL West-leading Omaha (AAA-KC) and former WooSox Ryan Fitzgerald have the 1st half championship in sight as they lead IL East-leading Syracuse (AAA-Mets) by 3½-games in the race for the lone playoff berth which goes to the team with the best overall record in the entire 20-team league when the first half ends with 75 games (or less if any games were canceled) of the 150 scheduled games played.

Buffalo Bites - Buffalo owns a 10-3 advantage in the season-series over Worcester...the WooSox worst mark against any opponent thus far this season. Worcester’s first trip to Buffalo came from May 7-12 for what amounted to a 7-game series including a make-up doubleheader on May 8 that was necessitated by an early-April postponement back in Worcester. The Bisons won 5 of those 7 games in Buffalo in May and are thus 6-2 at Sahlen Field vs. the WooSox. Buffalo won 4 of 5 in Worcester back from April 2-7.

Stats vs. Buffalo – Worcester has been out-scored by Buffalo, 79-48 in the first 13 games of the season-series. WooSox pitchers are 3-10 with a 6.11 ERA vs. Buffalo this season (71 ER in 104.2 IP) with 13 HRA. Sox batters are hitting .218 vs. the Bisons (86-for-395) with 13 HR.

On-Base Machines – Worcester and Buffalo are 1-2 in on-base pct. among all 20 International League clubs. The WooSox are 1st in the league with their .367 on-base pct. followed by the Bisons with their .366 OBP. The WooSox are just 14th in the league with a .250 team batting average but the Sox are tops in the league with 333 walks and the WooSox lead the IL with 54 hit batsmen. It all adds up to an impressive .367 OBP.

Left at the Altar – The WooSox lead the International League with 500 runners left on base (7.8 LOB per game).

Trying to Get in Tune in June – The WooSox are 3-6 in June thus far. The teams is batting .261 this month (78-for-299) with 11 HR while pitchers have a 4.23 ERA (37 ER in 78.2). Worcester and their opponents both have scored 51 runs in June.

Climbing Back –The WooSox have won 3 of their last 5 games following their 4-game losing skid from June 1-5. They are now 29-35 on the season after dipping to a season and franchise-low 7-games under .500 on June 5 at 26-33. Worcester's low point last year was 6-games under .500 when they were 8-14 on April 26, 2023. Their low in 2022 was also 6-games below on May 15, 2022 at 15-21. And their low point in 2021 during their inaugural campaign was just 3-games under when they started 0-3.

Even Not Too Long Ago - Just three weeks ago, on May 21 after a 20-4 rout of Norfolk, the WooSox pulled even at 23-23 on the season. The Sox have been over .500 just once this season when they were 2-1 on March 31.

Turn for Home – Worcester is back over .500 at Polar Park with their 18-17 record in Worcester (compared to 11-18 away from home). The Sox have been up and down at Polar Park throughout this season. They started 1-4 at home from April 2-7, then went 14-5 at Polar Park from April 16 – May 21, and recently were 0-7 from May 22 – June 5 before going 3-1 in their last four at home.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – WooSox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 54 times this season. The Red Sox Triple-A record for Most Hit by Pitch (by batters) in a season is 79 set by the Pawtucket Red Sox in 2000 & tied by the Worcester Red Sox in 2022.

Rankings – Worcester is 14th in the IL in team batting with a .250 average while Buffalo is 2nd at .264. On the pitching side, the Sox are 11th in team ERA (4.97) while the Bisons are 12th with a 5.01 ERA.

Streaks – The WooSox suffered a season-high 6-game losing streak from May 22-28 which was Worcester's longest in over a year since a 6-game losing streak from April 9-14 of last season. Worcester's longest winning streak of this season was 4 in a row from April 14 (G2 of a doubleheader) – April 19. They can match that with a victory today.

Series Math – Worcester is 4-5-2 in their first 11 series of 2024 (4 wins, 5 losses, and 2 splits). After not splitting any of their first nine series of the year, the WooSox have had to settle for splits during each of their last two 6-game series (at Charlotte and vs. Rochester). Worcester finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The Sox went 8-3-2 in 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Two for Ones – Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season – until May 16 (and then May 17 as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until their dramatic, 13-12 win on May 16 followed by May 17th's 9-8 triumph. They are now 2-10 in 1-run affairs (by far the worst mark in the league in that category). Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 4-7 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in 2-run affairs.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (16-17) than at night (13-18).

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 14 come-from-behind victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off. They have suffered 9 losses during the opponent's final at-bat.

May Be or Might Be - The WooSox rallied to win their final three games in May and finish the month even with a 14-14 record. The WooSox finished 10-14 in April after going 2-1 in March. Sox pitchers had a 4.88 ERA with 27 HRA in May while Sox batters hit .256 during the month with 42 HR.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers).

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half sending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (32-26) took over 1st-place by a ½-game over Hartford in the Eastern League Northeast Division thanks to a 9-5 victory at the Reading Fightin’ Phils last night. Alex Binelas led the way with 4 hits including a single, two doubles, and a homer as he delivered a 2-run single in the 1st-inning and a 2-run HR (#2) in the 7th. Kristian Campbell stayed hot in his first week with the Sea Dogs going 4-for-5 with 3 RBI. Roman Anthony continued his resurgence going with 3 hits including a triple to up his average to .273. Kyle Teel chipped in with 2 hits and is batting .294. The win went to Jacob Webb (5-1) who tossed 2.2 scoreless innings of relief.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of early-afternoon.

Worcester has already used 55 players this season (26 position players and 29 pitchers). The list does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox on May 3 but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on May 12 with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 12 players to Boston in the 10½ weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa, INF Enmanuel Valdez, and INF/OF Jamie Westbrook. Those 12 do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, RHP Nick Pivetta, OF Tyler O’Neill, and OF Masataka Yoshida who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Uwasawa and Heineman are back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
