YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Rumble Ponies, 8-6, in the series opener. Binghamton scored three runs in the bottom of the eighth on a two-out homer by Matt Rudick to take the lead. The Rumble Ponies opened the scoring in the first with a run-scoring double-play groundout. The Flying Squirrels took a 2-1 lead in the top of the second with an RBI single by **Brett Auerbach** and a sac fly by **Hayden Cantrelle**. Hayden Senger hit a solo homer to tie the game, 2-2, in the bottom of the second. In the fifth, **Vaun Brown** moved Richmond ahead with an RBI triple and scored on a groundout by **Marco Luciano** to open a 4-2 lead. Binghamton moved back in front with a two-out, three-run double by Brandon McIlwain in the bottom of the fifth. In the sixth, **Wade Meckler** hit a two-run single that gave the Flying Squirrels a 6-5 lead. Binghamton's bullpen combined for 3.1 scoreless innings to finish the game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels second the first of a six-game series against the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets. This series marks the Flying Squirrels' first set in Binghamton since 2019. That year, Richmond swept a three-game set at NYSEG Stadium from June 21-23. Since 2017, the Flying Squirrels are 7-2 in Binghamton. They have won three consecutive road series in Binghamton, going 2-1 in 2017, 2-1 in 2018 and 3-0 in 2019. The last series loss for Richmond in Binghamton was a three-game sweep from June 24-26, 2016. The Flying Squirrels were supposed to play a six-game series in Binghamton from August 31-September 5, 2021, but it was canceled. This year, Richmond is 3-1 against opponents from the Northeast Division.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS are tied for second in the Southwest Division, a half-game behind Erie. The Flying Squirrels were 14-7 through their first 21 games but have lost 12-of-their-last-18 falling to .500 for the first time this season before picking wins in the final two games of the series against Akron.

THE RUMBLE PONIES have alternated wins and losses over each of their last seven games and split last week's series in New Hampshire. After starting the season 11-10, the Rumble Ponies have gone 7-11 in their last 18 games. Binghamton's .218 team batting average is tied for the lowest in the Eastern League. Their 4.93 team ERA is ninth in the league and their 5.81 bullpen ERA is last. Binghamton's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 11), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 12), RHP Junior Santos (No. 20) and RHP Luis Moreno (No. 24). Jose Peroza is rated as the organization's best defensive infielder. MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list includes RHP Dominic Hamel (No. 7), RHP Mike Vasil (No. 9) and RHP Junior Santos (No. 17).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Ryan Murphy** makes his seventh start of the season and ninth-overall appearance. He last pitched last Thursday against the RubberDucks and allowed one run over three innings, tying season highs in strikeouts (5) and walks (4). Today marks Murphy's first start in his professional career in his home state of New York. Last year, Murphy began the season with High-A Eugene and went 1-0 with a 2.90 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Richmond in late-June and made two starts before being placed on the injured list for most of the rest of the season. Murphy was selected in the fifth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of Le Moyne College near Syracuse, N.Y., and was the highest-drafted Division II player that year. Murphy is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 20 Giants prospect and No. 27 by MLB.com. **For more on Murphy, see page two.**

FOR BINGHAMTON: Right-hander Mike Vasil makes his eight start of the season. Last time out, he worked seven scoreless innings and allowed three hits with five strikeouts in a win at New Hampshire last Thursday. After going 0-1 with a 4.50 ERA (9 ER/16.0 IP) in four April starts, he is 1-0 with a 0.43 ERA (1 ER/21.0 IP) in his three starts in May. On May 5, he allowed one hit in six scoreless innings at Somerset with seven strikeouts. He followed on May 11 allowing one run over a season-high eight innings against the Yard Goats. This year, Vasil leads the Eastern League in BAA (.154) and WHIP (0.70) while ranking tied for fourth in strikeouts (46), fourth in ERA (2.19) and tied for 10th in innings pitched (37.0). Vasil was selected in the eighth round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of the University of Virginia.

ALRIGHTY, ALDRETE: **Carter Aldrete** has homered three times over his last six games and driven in seven runs. In his last 14 games since May 6, he is batting .315 (17-for-54) with four homers, four doubles and nine RBIs. For the season, Aldrete is ranked tied for fifth in the Eastern League with 23 RBIs. He hit a go-ahead, solo homer in Sunday's finale against Akron.

LUCY, I'M HOME: Shortstop **Marco Luciano** was activated with the Flying Squirrels on May 2 and made his official Double-A debut on May 3. He joined the Richmond roster for last year's Eastern League playoffs, going 1-for-8 at the plate in the Division Series against Erie in September. Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 1 prospect and the No. 30 prospect in baseball. MLB.com has him rated as the Giants' No. 2 prospect and No. 20 overall. Baseball America also rates Luciano as the Giants' top power-hitting prospect. On May 4, Luciano drove a 394-foot solo homer for his first Double-A hit. Last Wednesday against Akron, he hit his third Double-A homer and tied a career high with four RBIs. On Sunday, he hit a solo homer in the eighth to tie the score in the Flying Squirrels' late comeback win. He has reached base in 12-of-his-15 games started this season.

VOUN RETURNS: Outfielder **Vaun Brown** was reinstated from the injured list with the Flying Squirrels on May 16. After missing the start of the season with an injury, he joined Low-A San Jose on a rehab assignment in late-April and played five games before joining High-A Eugene for five games. In the nine games on his rehab assignment, Brown hit .351 (13-for-37). Last year, Brown played his first full professional season and led all full-season minor leaguers in batting average (.346) and OPS (1.060). He also ranked third in the minors in SLG (.623) and sixth in OBP (.437). Brown joined the Flying Squirrels last August and made his Double-A debut in Akron, but left that game in the fifth inning with an injury and did not play again for the year. Brown is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. Baseball America also lists Brown as the Giants' best athlete and best hitter for average. He picked up his first Double-A hit last Thursday night and added his first Double-A homer on Saturday night, a three-run shot to center.

WELCOME, WADE: The Flying Squirrels activated **Wade Meckler** on May 17 and he made his Double-A debut that night, picking up three hits and scoring two runs. This year, Meckler leads the minors in batting average (.427) and ranks 10th in OBP (.474). He began the season with High-A Eugene and hit .456 in 20 games. He is rated by Baseball America as having the "best strike-zone discipline" in the Giants system. Meckler was selected by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State. He played 23 regular-season games last year after the draft, including 11 games to close the season with Low-A San Jose, where he hit .439 in 11 games.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Luis Matos** is ranked seventh in batting average (.304) and 10th in OBP (.398). **Ismael Munguia** is eighth in batting average (.300) and tied for seventh in hits (39). **Carter Aldrete** is tied for fifth in RBIs (23). **Hunter Cantrelle** is seventh in OBP (.409). **Kai-Wei Teng** is tied for fourth in strikeouts (46), ninth in BAA (.209) and eight in WHIP (1.14). **Evan Gates** is tied for seventh in saves (4).

WHERE THE RUMBLE PONIES RANK: Among the Eastern League leaders, Matt Rudick is second in batting average (.322), fourth in RBIs (24), first in OBP (.463), fifth in SLG (.559), tied for second in OPS (1.022), tied for fifth in doubles (10) tied for sixth in walks (27), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (16), ninth in total bases (66) and tied for third in runs scored (29). Jose Peroza is ninth in batting average (.296), seventh in SLG (.541) and seventh in OPS (.939). Wyatt Young is tied for sixth in walks (27). Nate Lavender is tied for seventh in saves (4). Mike Vasil is fourth in ERA (2.19), tied for fourth in strikeouts (46), first in BAA (.154) and first in WHIP (0.70).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 1, No. 30 overall), **Vaun Brown** (No. 6), **Mason Black** (No. 9), **Carson Seymour** (No. 12), **Landen Roupp** (No. 13), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 20), **Wade Meckler** (No. 23) and **Randy Rodriguez** (No. 30). Luciano is rated by Baseball America as the organization's best power hitter. Roupp is rated as having the best curveball. Brown is rated as the best hitter for average and the best athlete. Meckler is rated as having the best strike-zone discipline. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Luciano (No. 2, No. 20 overall), Brown (No. 5), Black (No. 10), Roupp (No. 13), Seymour (No. 17), Rodriguez (No. 26) and Murphy (No. 27).

ROAD TO THE SHOW: With his MLB debut on Sunday for the San Francisco Giants, pitcher **Ryan Walker** became the 88th Flying Squirrels alum to reach the majors. Walker pitched 51 games for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and 2022, combining to go 7-2 with a 2.95 ERA and two saves. He struck out 66 batters over 55 innings. This year, Walker made 15 appearances for Triple-A Sacramento, going 1-0 with a 0.89 ERA, before his call to join the Giants. In his debut on Sunday, Walker also picked up his first MLB win after pitching a scoreless sixth inning, working around two hits that frame. He started the seventh and left after allowing a single, which was stranded.
