FRISCO FALLS TO ARKANSAS IN SERIES OPENER:

The Frisco RoughRiders threatened in the ninth inning on Tuesday night but ultimately lost a 5-2 series opener against the Arkansas Travelers at Riders Field. The RoughRiders (5-5) loaded the bases in the final inning, bringing the winning run to the plate. Arkansas reliever Juan Then got Luisangel Acuña to bounce into a double play to end the game and earn the save. Stephen Kolek (2-0) tossed 1.2 innings for the win, soon after David Garcia got Frisco on the board. Trailing 3-0 in the fourth inning, Garcia ripped a ball to right-center field for a two-RBI double. Garcia went 3-for-4 on the night with his first extra-base hit of the season. Frisco totaled seven hits in the ballgame, but Garcia's double was the only extra-base hit and the only scoring play for the RoughRiders. In his third start of the season for Frisco, Jack Leiter (0-1) allowed eight hits and three runs in 5.0 innings. Justin Slaten kept the game close in relief, striking out three hitters in the eighth and ninth innings, but allowed an unearned run. Evan Carter walked four times on Tuesday. The RoughRiders' outfielder has now reached base in nine of 10 games this season.

DRIVERS, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have started their offense early and often so far this season. They have score in the first inning in four of the last five games and in the first or second inning in five of the last six games. Through 10 games, the RoughRiders are outscoring their oppponents 9-4 in the first inning and 23-8 over the first two innings. The RoughRiders nine runs in the first inning are third in the Texas League to Arkansas (14), Springfield (10) and Wichita (10) while their 23 runs in the first two innings are second in the Texas League. Arkansas is first with 24 runs in the first and second inning.

THIS PEN IS NO BULL ...:

To start this season, the RoughRiders bullpen has been brilliant. Through 10 games, the Riders have just allowed two home runs and own a 1.80 ERA. That is good for first in the Texas League and third in all of Minor League Baseball (Hudson Valley, 1.61, Harrisburg, 1.64). Against San Antonio, the Riders pen only ceded three earned runs for a 1.08 ERA in the six games. Seven different Frisco relievers have thrown at least two times without allowing a run. Overall, the RoughRiders have a team ERA of 2.76 which is the best in the Texas League (Tulsa is second with a 3.89 ERA) and eighth in all of Minor League Baseball.

LOAD UM UP:

The RoughRiders have had a league-high 17 at-bats with the bases loaded this season. As a team, they are hitting .353 (6-for-17)/.333/.824/1.157 with two grand slams and 18 RBIs. They are one of just nine teams in Minor League Baseball with two grand slams this season already as **Trevor Hauver** hit one on Opening Day and **Dustin Harris** added another on Sunday in San Antonio. On the pitching side, Frisco has not allowed a hit with the bases loaded this year and only one run on a sacrifice fly.

DEFENSE WINS CHAMPIONSHIPS:

The RoughRiders have just committed four errors through 10 games and committed their first position player error on Sunday. The team's .989 fielding percentage is fourth in Minor League Baseball (Clearwater, .992).

WALK THIS WAY:

The Riders hitters worked 40 walks in the six games against the San Antonio Missions, which was the sixth-most in the minors last week. On the season, Frisco's 57 walks lead the Texas League and are tied for sixth in Minor League Baseball (among non-Triple-A teams) while their .354 team OBP is fourth in the Texas League. **Evan Carter** leads the Texas League (and is tied for the Double-A lead) with 12 walks and is second in OBP (.531).

I LIKE BIG WINS AND I CANNOT LIE:

The RoughRiders five wins this season have come by eight, six, seven, seven and 10 runs, respectively, while their five losses have come by a combined 14 runs. That gives Frisco a +24 run differential through 10 games, which is the best in the Texas League despite being tied with Amarillo (5-5 record, -16 run differential) in first in the South Division. The only team with a +20 run differential in the league is Tulsa, which is 6-4 (+21).

EVAN ALMIGHTY:

Outfielder **Evan Carter** has reached safely in nine of the 10 games this season, batting .378 (14-for-45)/.531/.649/1.180 with a double, three home runs, 12 walks, 15 RBIs and two stolen bases. Carter is sixth in the Texas League in average (.378), sixth in hits (14), tied for first in home runs (3), second in RBIs (15), first in walks (12) and fourth in OPS (1.180). On Wednesday, Carter crushed a three-run home run and a solo homer for his second two-home run game of his Minor League career before adding another home run on Sunday. The No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system won a MiLB Rawlings Gold Glove in 2022. The reigning Tom Greive Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, Carter joined the RoughRiders for the last week of the 2022 season and the playoffs. Carter is also the second-youngest player in the Texas League this season, trailing on 19-year-old Deyvison De Los Santos of Amarillo.

ABOUT OWEN								

-White was drafted out of Jesse C. Carson High School in China Grove, North Carolina in 2018. He won the 2018 North Carolina Gatorade Player of the Year award, going 10-1 with a 0.22 ERA his senior year, striking out 101 over 63.2 innings. He also played shortstop and finished his career as the school's all-time record holder in hits, runs, RBIs, wins and strikeouts. Also played basketball and football (had some small-school offers at QB).

-Originally committed to the University of South Carolina before signing for \$1.5 million with the Rangers. Texas used the No. 15 pick on RHP Cole Winn (Rangers MiLB Pitcher of the Year in 2021 with the RoughRiders) and signed him underslot to help sign White overslot. Was thought to be a two-way player candidate if he went to South Carolina.

-2018 is the same draft as eight other former/current RoughRiders: RHP Cole Winn (1, 15), INF Jonathan Ornelas (3, 91), RHP Sean Chandler (6, 179), RHP Tim Brennan (7, 209), INF Jax Biggers (8, 239), LHP Grant Wolfram (18, 539), LHP Josh Smith (25, 749) and RHP Cole Uvila (40, 1199).

2023 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 3 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com

-Opened the 2023 season with three shutout innings against Amarillo on April 7th. He was working his way back up from a neck injury that kept him out for a couple weeks during Spring Training.

2022 SEASON

-Entered the season as the No. 8 prospect in the Rangers system by MLB.com

-Over his last three starts in Hickory, before being promoted to Frisco, White went 2-0 with a 1.89 ERA (4ER/19.0IP) while striking out 30 and just walking three over 19.0 innings.

-Recorded five quality starts over his 10 total starts, including a 7.0 innings, 1 ER, 11 K start on June 11th.

-With Hickory, owned a 45.8 percent groundball rate, 10th in the South Atlantic League. Also had a 16.4 percent swinging strike rate (3rd in SAL) and a 33.3 percent strikeout rate (4th).

-Was dominant in Double-A debut on June 25th, allowing one runs until an inherited run came across over his 5.1 innings in Arkansas

-Threw 5.1 hitless innings with seven strikeouts on July 1st against CC, winning Texas League Pitcher of the Week. Left game with left ankle injury, but was able to make next scheduled start. Riders lost no-hitter in 7th inning when Seth Nordlin allowed single, but Frisco won 5-0.

2021 SEASON

-Was Low-A Down East's Opening Day starer before punching the ground after an error and breaking his hand on May 4th. He returned to the Wood Ducks on August 10th.

-From The Athletic: "As soon as I did that, CY (general manager Chris Young) called me and basically said the Rangers have my back and they knew that it wasn't out of like hatred or trying to hurt myself," White explained on Monday. "It was more going out and competing and my emotions got the best of me at that moment in time. It's not like I came in the dugout and punched something at a locker, it was just — emotions got the best of me, I did what I did, and now I had to pay the consequence. But ..." White paused and nodded before giving a wry smile. "I promised them that I would never do it again."

-After making just nine outings on the season, he won Arizona Fall League "Pitcher of the Year", going 5-0 with a 1.91 ERA and 29 strikeouts over a league-best 28.1 innings.

2018-2019 SEASONS

-Did not see action in the 2018 season after being drafted as part of Rangers "de-load program".

-Missed the entired 2019 season with "Tommy John" surgery.
