#### LAST TIME OUT...

**MOOSIC, Pa. (July 22, 2021)** – The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders fell to the Rochester Red Wings 9-0 on Thursday night at PNC Field. The game marked the third shutout loss of the season for the RailRiders.

Rochester took the lead three batters into the game on an RBI single by Jake Noll. Later in the frame, Brandon Snyder connected for a three-run home run off Matt Krook to run the Red Wings lead to 4-0.

Krook (2-2) battled through 5.0 innings, allowing seven runs on nine hits while walking one and striking out one. He allowed two home runs in the game, both to Snyder.

The RailRiders offense was stymied by Red Wings pitchers throughout the first eight innings, mustering only two hits, both doubles from Armando Alvarez. The third baseman finished 2-for-4 with his two doubles, the only SWB player to record multiple hits.

Brian Keller allowed two runs in an inning of work following Krook, but Nick Green came in after and turned in a terrific outing to close out the game. In his first game back with the RailRiders, Green allowed only one hit and no walks while striking out two in three innings of work in the bottom of the ninth Thomas Milone stroked a one-out single to right against Gabe Klobotsis, but that was all Scranton/Wilkes-Barre could muster. SWB's three hits are the fewest collected by the team in a nine-inning game this season. Ben Braymer (2-6) allowed only one run in 5.0 innings of work for the win, while four Red Wings relievers finished off the shutout.

#### NEWS & NOTES

**ALVAREZ ON THE RISE:** RailRiders infielder **Armando Alvarez** has been on a tear over his last five games at the plate, batting .318/.318/.727 with two home runs and five RBIs. Of the six hits he has in this span, five of them have gone for extra bases, with three doubles added to his home runs. He has raised his season batting average from .219 to .230, and his OPS has jumped 45 points from .648 to .693. In addition to his recent offensive spurt, Alvarez made a diving catch into the first base camera well on Tuesday night against Rochester which ended up as the No. 1 "Top Play" of the night on ESPN's *SportsCenter*.

**NO HITS FOR YOU!** On Wednesday **Luis Gil**, **Reggie McClain** and **Stephen Ridings** combined to no-hit the Rochester Red Wings in an 8-0 victory. It was the first no-hitter thrown by Scranton/Wilkes-Barre under the Yankees affiliation (2007 - Present), and the first overall since **Jeremy Cummings** no-hit Rochester on Sept. 3, 2006. With the RailRiders having thrown a one-hitter on May 27 against the Buffalo Bisons, 2021 is the first season in franchise history to feature both a no-hitter and a one-hitter in the same season.

- The RailRiders no-hitter was the third thrown in Triple-A East this year. The Iowa Cubs have thrown two no-nos this year, using four pitchers to no-hit the Indianapolis Indians on May 9, and had three pitchers no-hit St. Paul on July 11.
- It was the first no-hitter for a Yankees Triple-A affiliate since 2002, when **Adrian Hernandez**, **Bob Scanlan** and **Kevin Lovinger** of the Columbus Clippers no-hit the Indianapolis Indians in a 15-1 win. The Clippers threw four no-hitters while affiliated with the Yankees from 1979 - 2006, including one by **Mariano Rivera** in 1995.

**QUALITY CONTROL:** After not having a single quality start (defined as at least 6.0 IP while allowing 3 ER-or-less) in their first 62 games of the season, the RailRiders have gotten two in a row. RHP **Deivi Garcia** tossed one on Tuesday night, allowing 3 ER in 6.0 innings of work, and **Luis Gil** followed up with 6.0 shutout innings on Wednesday. Prior to these starts, the last QS for the RailRiders was thrown by **Michael King** on Aug. 27, 2019 against the Pawtucket Red Sox at McCoy Stadium, a span of 693 days. King threw 6.0 innings of shutout baseball in a 4-0 win.

**JUST WINGING IT:** For the first time in nearly two months, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders will take on the Rochester Red Wings this week. The RailRiders took four of six in the first series of the season with the Red Wings, which at the time was scheduled to be SWB's lone trip to Roc City. However, thanks to MLB's announcement of the Triple-A Final Stretch postseason extravaganza, the club returns to Frontier Field for the final five games of the season from Sept. 29 through Oct. 3. The Red Wings make one more return trip to the Electric City after this series from Sept. 7-12, the final homestand of the Triple-A regular season for the RailRiders.

**RAPID-FIRE CHANGE:** With injuries and COVID health and safety protocols effecting the New York Yankees MLB roster, the RailRiders roster has seen dramatic change over the weekend. Before Friday's game, **Hoy Park**, **Rob Brantly**, and **Greg Allen** were all added to the Yankees 26-man roster for the first time, and **Chris Gittens** was recalled by the Yankees. In return the RailRiders received **Thomas Milone**, **Matt Pita**, **Donny Sands** and **Christian Perez** from Double-A Somerset. Milone and Perez have previous stints this year with SWB, while Pita and Sands are in their first stints in Triple-A. Then on Sunday, **Ryan LaMarre** was added to the Yankees 26-man roster following an injury to Tim Locaastro on Saturday. Then on Tuesday, **Estevan Florial** was recalled by the Yankees and **Frederick Cuevas** was transferred from High-A Hudson Valley. With the promotions of Allen, **Trey Amburgey**, LaMarre and Florial, since last Thursday, the only remaining outfielder on the RailRiders roster is **Socrates Brito**.

**IT'S THE FINAL STRETCH (DA NA NA NA):** In lieu of a traditional playoff in Triple-A Baseball, MLB announced last Wednesday that all Triple-A teams will compete in a 10-game postseason tournament called the Triple-A Final Stretch from Sept. 22 through Oct. 3. Each league will have a regular season champion, crowned for having the best record across 120 games, and a Final Stretch champion, crowned for having the best record in the added 10 games. Unlike any tournament you may be familiar with, the Triple-A Final Stretch has a set schedule of opponents and you continue to play even if you are eliminated from contention. MLB announced the RailRiders will play Syracuse from 9/22-26 at PNC Field and finish the Final Stretch at Rochester from 9/28-10/3. MLB also announced it will give a prize to the winners of the Final Stretch.

**2021 PRESEASON PROSPECT RANKINGS:** MLB Pipeline - NYY #28, FanGraphs - NYY #37

**LAST TIME OUT:** After a breakout start to his season with Double-A Somerset, Glenn Otto gutted through 4.1 innings in Worcester in his Triple-A debut last Friday. After a walk and two singles, Somerset took the lead three batters into the bottom of the first, but the right-hander settled in from there. Needing a career-high 93 pitches to complete 4.1 innings, he left the game with the score tied 2-2. He registered four strikeouts in the start, his fewest in any game this season.

**YOU GO, GLENN OTTO:** This year has been a breakout season for Glenn Otto, beginning with his first start of the year with Somerset. He lasted 6.0 innings, something no SWB starting pitcher has done through 61 games, and allowed no runs. In his time with the Patriots, Otto had five scoreless starts of at least 5.1 innings, struck out double-digits five times, including 14 twice, and racked up six wins.

**2021 HIGHLIGHTS:**

- Began the season with the Double-A Somerset Patriots break camp roster.
- Promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre on July 14.
- At the time of his promotion, was tied for second among all minor league pitchers with 103 strikeouts (Cade Cavalli; Wilmington, Harrisburg). His 7.36 K:BB (103:14) was fifth among qualified pitchers in Double-A leagues or higher.

**PERSONAL/CAREER:**

- Missed most of the 2018 season (limited to 2 G, 10.1 IP with Low-A Charleston) after surgery to remove a blood clot from his pitching shoulder.
- Also missed time in the 2019 season while dealing with a ribcage injury.
- Pitched three seasons at Rice, going 18-6 with 17 SV and a 2.61 ERA (172.1 IP, 123 H, 68 R/50 ER, 87 BB, 222 K) in 82 appearances (four starts).
- Left school tied for fourth on the Owls' all-time saves list.
- Was the 2017 Conference-USA Tournament MVP and a member of the 2016 All-Conference-USA First Team.
- Pitched for the U.S. Collegiate National Team in 2016.
- Graduated from Concordia Lutheran H.S. (Tex.) in 2014, where he was named to the 5A TAPPS All-State First Team.
- Following the 2019 season, played for Surprise in the Arizona Fall League, going 3-1 with a 1.88 ERA (24.0 IP, 10 H, 5 ER, 13 BB, 26 K, 2 HR) in six starts...tied for the AFL lead in wins and ranked fourth in ERA (min. 20.0 IP)
