YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Patriots, 13-3. Elijah Dunham opened the scoring for Somerset with an RBI double in the fourth and Spencer Jones added a two-run homer in the fifth to open a 3-0 lead. Jimmy Glowenke cut the score to 3-1 with a solo home run in the fifth. The Patriots added nine runs in the seventh, including a grand slam by Jones. Rafael Flores hit a solo homer in the eighth to extend the lead to 13-1. In the ninth, Christian Koss hit a two-run double for the Flying Squirrels.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles, in the first of a three-game series. In the Flying Squirrels' last trip to Bowie, they won five-of-six games in a series from May 21-26, with the lone loss being a 2-1 defeat on May 23. In that series, they outscored the Baysox, 46-26. This is Richmond's final series in Bowie this year. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at The Diamond against the Baysox from April 23-28. The Baysox will return to Richmond this week from Thursday through Saturday for the final meetings between the two teams this season.

A CASE OF THE MONDAYS: Today's game is the only scheduled Monday game for the Flying Squirrels this season. Last year, the Flying Squirrels played one Monday game, a 3-2 win at Reading on July 3, 2023. There was one Monday game in Richmond's 2022 season, a 15-7 win over Reading on Independence Day. Those two games are the only Monday games played by Richmond since the new scheduling format began in 2021. The Flying Squirrels have won five consecutive games played on Mondays, with the last Monday loss coming on August 5, 2019.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS snapped a four-game losing streak with Saturday's win before falling again on Sunday. They dropped four straight games to open the second half last week after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .220 and averaging 3.8 runs per game (134 runs/35 games) at home compared to a .238 batting average and 4.9 runs per game on the road (189 runs/39 games).

THE BAYSOX went 4-2 last week at Reading to open the Eastern League's second half. In the first half of the season, they went 32-36, finishing in fifth place in the Southwest Division. Bowie is hitting .227 as a team this year, 11th in the league. The Baysox pitching staff has a 3.94 team ERA, fourth-best in the league and has allowed 79 homers, most in the circuit. Bowie's roster includes 10 of Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Samuel Basallo (No. 2), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 9), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), 3B Max Wagner (No. 14), RHP Trace Bright (No. 20), OF John Rhodes (No. 26), RHP Alex Pham (No. 27), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 29), Baseball America ranks Samuel Basallo as the best power hitter in the Orioles system, Silas Ardoin as the best defensive catcher, Jud Fabian as the best outfield arm and Trace Bright as having the best curveball. MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Beavers (No. 7), Johnson (No. 10), Fabian (No. 12), Wagner (No. 14), Bright (No. 16), Rhodes (No. 23), Pham (No. 24) and Bencosme (No. 27).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander John Michael Bertrand makes his 15th start of the season and his third against Bowie. He last pitched on Wednesday against the Patriots and worked five innings. He allowed four runs in that start, all in the first inning. Bertrand has been named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week twice this year, first for throwing seven perfect innings against the Baysox on April 27 and then for working six hitless innings in Bowie on May 23. He has made seven scoreless starts this year, all at least five innings. Last season, he climbed three levels, working from Low-A San Jose to High-A Eugene before joining Double-A Richmond in July for the remainder of the season. For the year, he led all qualified Giants minor league pitchers in winning percentage (.688) and ranked second in ERA (3.65), second in wins (11), tied for second in WHIP (1.23), third in innings pitched (118.1) and fourth in BAA (.248). Entering 2024, Bertrand was rated by Baseball America as having the best control in the Giants system. Bertrand began his collegiate career at Furman University in South Carolina before playing his final two seasons at the University of Notre Dame. He was selected by the Giants in the 10th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. For more on Bertrand, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Ryan Long makes his eighth start of the season. He has also made seven relief appearances. He has made two appearances against Richmond this year, totaling nine scoreless innings. He worked four innings and allowed two hits with seven strikeouts in a start at The Diamond on April 25. On May 25, he pitched five innings and allowed two hits with five strikeouts in a relief outing against the Flying Squirrels at Prince George's Stadium. Last time out, he worked 3.2 innings and allowed four runs in a no-decision at Reading on Tuesday. Long was selected by the Orioles in the 17th round of then 2021 MLB Draft. He joined the Baysox from High-A Aberdeen last July and made 12 appearances (six starts), going 3-3 with a 6.51 ERA. In his career against the Flying Squirrels, Long has a 0.64 ERA (1 ER/14.0 IP) in three appearances.

CARTER'S CRUISING: Dating back to June 13, Carter Howell is batting .353 (18-for-51) with three doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times. He has two triples in his last five games, including an RBI triple on Thursday night. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season and he is tied for ninth in hits (66). He is leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.283), OBP (.359), OPS (.767), hits, doubles (15), triples, total bases (95), runs (34) and stolen bases (8).

KOSS-SOME: In his last two games, **Christian Koss** is batting .375 (3-for-8) with two doubles, a homer and five RBIs. Koss was named Eastern League Player of the Week on June 24 after leading the minors with a .647 batting average (11-for-17) in his return to face his former team in Portland the previous week. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. Since returning, he is batting .380 (27-for-71) in 21 games with a homer, 11 doubles, eighth walks, 17 RBIs, 13 runs scored and four stolen bases.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 19 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .354 (29-for-82) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, In his last 29 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .325 (37-for-114) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in seven-of-11 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .382 (18-for-47) in that stretch.

WILL POWER: Will Wilson is batting .318 (14-for-44) with a homer, a double and nine RBIs over his last 11 games dating back to June 16. He has picked up multiple hits in five-of-his-last-11 games, including three hits three times. He hit a solo homer in Portland on June 21, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with Shane Matheny, Sean Roby and Devin Harris while trailing only Ricky Oropesa (37), Jacob Heyward (33) and Jarrett Parker (30)

TO THE MUNGUIA: Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .316 (12-for-38) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in eight of his nine games played, including three two-hit games. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,862). The next home game on Thursday is sold out.

PROSPECT WATCH: Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 10), RHP Eric Silva (No. 20), C Adrián Sugastey (No. 23) and RHP José Cruz (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and John Michael Bertrand is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B Victor Bericoto (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF Jairo Pomares (No. 26).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garabito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023) and Hayden Birdsong (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
