The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Baseball Club (Los Angeles Dodgers affiliate) are scheduled for the series finale of their six-game set on Sunday. Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Max Scherzer is set to start against Baseball Club LHP Alec Gamboa. First pitch from Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark is slated for 2:05 p.m. CT.

### SATURDAY NIGHT SLUG FEST

Round Rock fell 10-9 on Saturday. Oklahoma City opened the scoring in the first on an RBI single by 1B Andre Lipcius that scored CF James Outman to make it 1-0. The Baseball Club added three in the second to increase their advantage to 4-0. A sacrifice fly by Outman plated another run. Lipcius then doubled home 2B Jonathan Araúz before RF Ryan Ward brought Lipcius around to score. An RBI single by CF Dustin Harris scored RF Trevor Hauver in the third for the E-Train. Oklahoma City took over the game in the home half, scoring six runs and increasing its lead to 10-1. A pair of long balls brought three in for Round Rock in the fourth. 3B Jantzen Witte hit a solo shot before SS Jose Barrero launched a two-run bomb and made it a 10-4 game. Round Rock plated five in the sixth to cut the Oklahoma City lead to 10-9. Whatley drove in 1B Blaine Crim with a single. Barrero hit a towering blast to left field for his second two-run homer of the game before C Andrew Knapp singled home 2B Jonathan Ornelas. Despite the comeback attempt, Oklahoma City held serve for the final three innings, taking the contest 10-9.

### IS THIS SCHERZER GUY GOOD?

Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Max Scherzer is scheduled to make his second rehab appearance for the Express on Sunday. The right-hander has not pitched for the E-Train since April 24. He is returning from offseason back surgery but dealt with a nerve issue in his thumb that slowed his rehab process. In his lone start for the Express this year, Scherzer went 2.1 innings with five hits, three earned runs and four strikeouts against Salt Lake.

### NOT HIS FIRST TIME IN OKLAHOMA

RHP Max Scherzer has appeared in Oklahoma City only once and it came in 2008 while pitching for Triple-A Tucson against the Oklahoma RedHawks on August 5, 2008. The right-hander went 4.0 innings and did not allow a run with two hits, two walks and six strikeouts.

### TOUGH SLEDDING VS OKC

Round Rock is 8-23 in their last 31 games against Oklahoma City going back to the start of 2023. Those 31 games include two postseason games in 2023. In the last nine meetings between the two teams, the Baseball Club has a +32 run differential.

### D-BOB DOES IT AGAIN

Express RHP Daniel Robert has not allowed an earned run in his last 8.1 innings on the mound. If you exclude Robert's first outing of the season on March 31, he owns a 1.37 ERA (3 ER/19.2 IP) with five walks and 27 strikeouts. He has allowed six earned runs for the season and has surrendered more than one run in a game only one time.

### AN EYE ON THE STANDINGS

With 13 games remaining in the first half of the season, Round Rock is 8.5 games back of first-place Sugar Land in the overall standings. The winner of the first half gets home field advantage in the PCL Championship Series. Sacramento is 2.0 games back while current opponent Oklahoma City is 4.0 games behind.

**ALCS EXPRESS REUNION**

The 2023 ALCS between Houston and Texas featured 22 players that appeared in a game for the Express. The Express reunited as the Rangers Triple-A affiliate in 2021 after spending eight seasons as the club's top affiliate from 2011-2018. Round Rock was previously a member of the Houston Astros organization from 2019-2020. From the Rangers, LHP Cody Bradford (2023), OF Evan Carter (2023), C Mitch Garver (2022, 2023), OF Travis Jankowski (2023), INF Josh Jung (2021, 2022), RHP Jose Leclerc (2016, 2018, 2022), LHP Martin Perez (2011, 2012, 2013, 2015, 2018), RHP Josh Sborz (2022, 2023), INF Josh Smith (2022), OF Leody Taveras (2021, 2022, 2023) appeared in the ALCS. For the Astros, RHP Bryan Abreu (2019), INF Jose Altuve (2019), INF Yordan Alvarez (2019), RHP Ronel Blanco (2019), RHP Cristian Javier (2019), OF Chas McCormick (2019), OF Kyle Tucker (2019), RHP Jose Urquidy (2019), LHP Framber Valdez (2019) appeared in the series and also played for the E-Train.

**EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS**

The 2024 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's second season with the E-Train. In his first season with the Express in 2023, he guided Round Rock to a PCL Second Half title and the club's first playoff appearance since 2019. The team's 89 total wins were the most regular-season wins in franchise history and just the seventh 80-win campaign in club history. Davis oversaw the longest winning streak in franchise history when the Express won 14 consecutive games last year from August 8-23.



Prior to Round Rock, Davis spent two seasons as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the 2003 World Series.

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
