YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Yard Goats, 17-10. The Richmond hitters combined to hit eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also the most homers in a game for an Eastern League team since 2006 and tied for the most by an MiLB team this year. Ismael Munguia led off the game with a solo homer in the first inning. In the second, Logan Wyatt hit a solo homer and Will Wilson hit a grand slam to open a 6-0 lead. Carter Aldrete hit a two-run homer in the third, Victor Bericoto drove in two with a single in the fourth and Aldrete hit another two-run homer later in the inning to extend the lead to 12-0. Sean Roby hit a two-run homer run in the fifth and Aldrete hit his third homer, a solo shot, in the sixth inning. Later in the sixth, Munguia singled home a run to extend the lead to 16-0. Carson Seymour took a no-hitter into the sixth, but the Yard Goats scored three runs in the inning to close the score to 16-3. Bericoto hit Richmond's eighth homer of the night, a solo shot, in the op of the seventh. The Yard Goats scored six in the seventh and Grant Lavigne hit a solo homer in the ninth to close the score to 17-10. Aldrete's three home runs tied the Richmond single-game franchise record.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Richmond's first trip to Hartford since June 22-27, 2021. This series is the only set this year between the two teams.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 36-25 in their last 61 games since June 18, the second-best record in the Eastern League in that span, but have gone 4-5 on this road trip to Portland at Hartford. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 4.00 ERA is third-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 450.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 609.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.89 ERA, which is the fifth-lowest in Double-A. Richmond hitters have homered 23 times over the last nine games.

THE YARD GDATS have gone 2-9 in their last 11 games since August 19. Their .230 team batting average is 11th in the Eastern League and their 5.49 team ERA is 12th. Hartford's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Adael Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), OF Yanquiel Fernandez (No. 3 - No. 51 overall), 3B Sterlin Thompson (No. 6), OF Jordan Beck (No. 7), C Drew Romo (No. 9), 3B Warming Bernabel (No. 11), SS Julio Carreras (No. 17), LHP Carson Palmquist (No. 13) and OF Bladimir Restituyo (No. 30), MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects list includes seven Hartford players, including Amador (No. 1 - No. 21 overall), Fernandez (No. 2 - No. 53 overall), Thompson (No. 6), Romo (No. 9), Bernabel (No. 10), LHP Joe Rock (No. 16) and Palmquist (No. 21).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Nick Zwack takes the mound for his 14th start of the year and his third since being reinstated from the injured list on August 20 after missing three weeks. He last pitched in the first game of Sunday afternoon's doubleheader at Portland and allowed four runs over 1.1 innings in a loss. Zwack was selected in the 17th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Mets out of Xavier and traded to the Giants last August as part of the deal for Darin Ruf. After starting the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, Zwack earned a promotion to High-A Brooklyn, where he went 5-1 with a 1.84 ERA in 14 outings, landing him a South Atlantic League Post-Season All-Star selection. He closed the season with six starts for High-A Eugene following the trade. Zwack, a native of Minneapolis, played his college career at Xavier, where he was a First-Team All-Big East selection in 2021 as a senior. For more on Zwack, see page two.

FOR HARTFORD: Right-hander Andrew Quezada makes his 18th Double-A start. Last time out, Quezada pitched 1.1 innings and allowed seven runs, tying a season high. Over a three-outing span from July 28 through August 12, he went 3-0 with a 0.49 ERA (1 ER/18.1 IP), including allowing one run over nine innings in a complete game at Portland on August 12. In his last two starts since August 18, he is 0-1 with a 15.43 ERA (12 ER/7.0 IP). Quezada was selected in the seventh round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Rockies out of Cal State Fullerton. Last year, he spent the entire season with the High-A Spokane Indians and went 9-4 with a 4.28 ERA in 21 games (19 starts).

PLAYOFF CHASE: With 15 games remaining in the regular season, the Flying Squirrels are in second place the Southwest Division Second-Half standings, one game behind the Erie SeaWolves, who have already clinched a spot in the postseason by winning the division's first half, and one game ahead of the Bowie Baysox. Akron six games back in fourth. The winner of the second half in the Southwest Division will face Erie in the first round of the playoffs, unless the SeaWolves win the second half, which would lead to the second-place team (determined by winning percentage) in the second half advancing to the postseason. The Flying Squirrels are aiming to reach the playoffs for the fourth time in team history. They reached the postseason in 2011, 2014 and 2022.

POWER SURGE: The Flying Squirrels have homered 23 times in their last nine games dating back to August 22, which is the most in the minors during that span. On Thursday, the Richmond hitters combined for eight home runs, which set a new single-game franchise record. It was also tied for the most homers by a team in a single game in the minors this year, even with an eight-homer performance by Sugar Land at Albuquerque on May 7. It was also the most homers in an Eastern League game since the Harrisburg Senators homered eight times at Erie on June 18, 2006.

ALRIGHT, ALDRETE: On Thursday, Carter Aldrete hit three home runs in consecutive at-bats. He hit a two-run homer in the third inning, added another two-run homer in the fourth inning and hit a solo home run in the fifth. The three-homer performance tied the Richmond single-game franchise record. The last player to homer three times in a game was **Thomas Neal** on June 26, 2010 at Erie. Aldrete reclaimed the team lead in homers this year with 12. Prior to Thursday, Aldrete had not homered in his previous 36 games, back to his most recent home run on June 18.

COMING UP CLUTCH: Of the Flying Squirrels' last eight wins, they have scored the winning run in the seventh inning or later in five of them. On August 17, Victor Bericoto hit a walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning the beat Harrisburg after Richmond entered the inning trailing, 6-2, tying the largest ninth-inning comeback in franchise history. On August 19 against the Senators, Sean Roby won the game with a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth. On August 23 at Portland, Jimmy Glowenke hit a go-ahead single in the top of the ninth inning at Portland to give Richmond a 9-8 win. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader at Hadlock Field, the Flying Squirrels rallied after trailing, 8-6, down to their final out in the seventh before Brady Whalen and Bericoto hit back-to-back homers to tie the game and Logan Wyatt hit a two-run, pinch-hit homer for a 10-8 win. On Wednesday, Wyatt broke a 4-4 tie with a solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win at Hartford.

BERICOTO BASHING: Victor Bericoto has homered five times in his last seven games dating back to Thursday. In his last 13 games since August 16, Bericoto is batting .333 (15-for-45) with five homers, four doubles and 13 RBIs. On August 17 against Harrisburg, he hit walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning to cap a four-run comeback, which was tied for the largest ninth-inning comeback win in franchise history. Last Thursday at Portland, he homered and drove in two runs on the night. He added another homer on Saturday. He hit a game-tying homer in the last inning of Game 2 of Sunday's doubleheader at Portland. On Wednesday, he hit a two-run homer at Hartford. On the year, Bericoto leads the Giants system with 24 homers (16 with Eugene and eight with Richmond) and also leads the organization with 76 RBIs.

LONGBALL LOGAN: Logan Wyatt has homered four times in his last six games since Saturday. He hit a two-run homer in the ninth inning on Saturday night at Portland. On Sunday afternoon in the second game of a doubleheader, he hit a go-ahead, two-run homer with two outs in the seventh to lift Richmond to a 10-8 win over the Sea Dogs. On Wednesday at Hartford, he launched a go-ahead, solo homer in the top of the seventh for a 5-4 win. Dating back to August 20, Wyatt is batting .324 (11-for-34) with five homers, three doubles and 11 RBIs. His 17 homers between Eugene and Richmond this season are tied for the third-most in the Giants organization.

GLDW SHOW: Jimmy Glowenke is has picked up 15 hits and seven RBIs in his last eight games dating back to last Wednesday, batting .600 (15-for-25) with three homers, two doubles and four walks. Last Wednesday, at Portland he hit a two-run homer and picked up two RBI singles, matching his season high with four RBIs for the game. On the year, Glowenke is batting .350 (36-for-103) in road games, including all seven of his Double-A homers. Since July 1, Glowenke is batting .331 (43-for-130) with seven homers and 27 RBIs in 40 games.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny has reached base 62 times in his last 33 games since July 25 (34 hits, 27 walks, 1 HBP), hitting .298 (34-for-114) with six homers, six doubles, two triples and 25 RBIs adding a .435 on-base percentage. In the last home series against the Senators, Matheny hit .412 (7-for-17) with three homers, one double, nine RBIs and three walks. He is hitting .194 (7-for-36) in his nine games on this road trip. In the second game of Sunday's doubleheader, he hit a three-run homer. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 135 walks, ahead of Ricky Oropesa (112, 2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 5 - on IL), OF Vaun Brown (No. 7), RHP Hayden Birdsong (No. 12), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 16), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 17 - on IL) and RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 28), Baseball America rates Brown as the organization's best hitter for average and best athlete, rates Roupp as having the best curveball and Jose Cruz as having the best changeup. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes five Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 3), Birdsong (No. 10), Brown (No. 13), Roupp (No. 15) and Seymour (No. 23).
