KNIGHTS SWEEP JUMBO SHRIMP IN TWIN BILL

Charlotte broomed Jacksonville 3-2 and 14-9 in Thursday's doubleheader. In the opener, Griffin Conine homered and Valente Bellozo worked 5.0 innings of one-run ball. However, in the bottom of the eighth, Wynton Bernard's RBI triple tied the game before Mark Payton's walk-off single won it for the Knights. In the finale, the Jumbo Shrimp got a run in their first at-bats before Charlotte put up nine runs in the second inning, three in the third and two in the fourth to go up 14-2. Jacksonville scored seven in the fifth on only two hits to get the score to 14-9.

MAY SHOWERS BRING JUNE FLOWERS?

Jacksonville finished 8-19 during the month of May, marking the club's worst record in any month since at least 2005. The Jumbo Shrimp actually lost the final game of April to begin a stretch of 17 losses in 20 games. After a seasonhigh five-game winning streak from May 23-28. Jacksonville has now lost seven of their last eight games, meaning the club is just 9-24 (.273) in the last 32 games. Unsurprisingly, the Shrimp rank at or near the bottom in Triple-A in many categories since April 30: runs scored (145, T-28th), batting average (.247, 22nd), OBP (.336, 25th), slugging percentage (.378, 29th), OPS (.714, 28th) and home runs (27, 30th).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 39 of Jacksonville's 60 games (65.0 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 21 of the club's last 29 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs: Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 24 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 16-23 (.410) in these affairs.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 26 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 24-forhis-last-82, slashing .293/.404/.622/1.026 with six doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBIs, 16 walks and 15 runs scored. He's driven in at least one run in 15 of those 26 games, with multiple RBIs in five contests.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 11-22 (.333) home record is the worst such mark in the International League, while the club's 14-13 (.519) road record is one of only six winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 136 runs in 27 games (5.0 per game), nearly a full run better than what they average at home (134 runs in 33 games, 4.1 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 181 runs (ninth-most) in 33 home games (5.5 per game) compared to 125 (third-fewest) on the road (4.6 per game).

ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder Jonah Bride has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 51-for-176 (.290/.434/.540/.974) with 12 doubles, one triple, 10 home runs, 32 RBIs, 42 walks and 27 runs scored in 51 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks fifth in the International League in both on-base percentage and walks. sixth in OPS, 11th in slugging percentage, tied for 15th in extra-base hits (23) and 21st in batting average. Among the 129 qualified hitters in the IL, Bride ranks fourth in swinging-strike rate (5.0 percent) and 20th in line drive rate (28.6 percent).

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 24 of his last 27 games, notching 12 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 39-for-107 (.364/.421/.542/.963) with nine doubles, two triples, two home runs, 20 RBIs, 12 walks and 16 runs scored. Among the 195 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (51.1 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (3.9 percent).

After going a season-best seven games in a row without an error from May 23-30, the Jumbo Shrimp have committed a miscue in five of their last six games... Over his last four starts, Max Meyer has compiled 22 strikeouts in 13.2 innings (4.61 ERA, 13 H, 8 BB, .241 BAA).

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
