Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series at the Lake County Captains, the High-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, continuing a nine-game road trip that began with winning two of three at Fort Wayne before dropping the first two games of this series. The Nuts are 8-6 this season against Lake County, 4-4 at Classic Auto Group Park. These are the final meetings of the season between Lansing and Lake County.

Last Night: Captains 5, Lugnuts 2. In an 11 a.m. matinee, the Nuts received solo home runs from Will Simpson and Brayan Buelvas, but that was all Lansing could manage against Rorik Maltrud and three relievers in a second straight defeat.

On the Air: Today's game is on MiLB TV and Bally Live, with a Lugnuts audio stream via StreamGuys, Adam Jaksa and Jesse Goldberg-Strassler on the call.

On Deck: The Lugnuts and Captains play through Sunday, leading into the four-day Major League Baseball All-Star Break. Then the Nuts return home to welcome in the Great Lakes Loons for a three-game series from July 19-21.

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander Luis Morales, the youngest player on the team, will serve as the sole representative for the Oakland A's in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game a week from today on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas. Morales, the Athletics' No. 1 pitching prospect and No. 2 overall prospect, becomes the 5th active Nut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016).

All-Star Alumni: Speaking of Vladdy Jr., the 2017 Nuts alum and 2022 Lansing standout **Mason Miller** were each named American League All-Stars; for Vladdy, this is his fourth consecutive All-Star nod while rookie Miller makes his first All-Star appearance, continuing a stellar first full season that has him in Rookie of the Year conversations.

Having a Blast: Outfielder Brayan Buelvas loves hitting against Lake County, slashing .350/.435/.700 this year. Yesterday's solo home run marked his fourth roundtripper of the year hit in Lake County and his fifth (of seven total) in 2024 against the Captains; it was his first longball since May 19, the last game that the Nuts had played vs. the Caps before this week. In 2022, Buelvas knocked two HRs in a three-day span in Eastlake. (BTW, Euribiel Ángeles is hitting .407 vs. Lake County this year.)

Powering On: Buelvas isn't alone; the Lugnuts have three total home runs in this series, giving them nine homers this month (second only to Lake County in the MWL) and 60 HRs for the year – 19 of which have come against the Captains in only 14 games compared to 41 homers in their other 68 games.

Prospecting: Lansing has four MLB Pipeline Top 30 Oakland Athletics prospects on its roster: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2, and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect), corner infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 24), tomorrow's starting pitcher, **Will Johnston** (No. 27), and outfielder **Brayan Buelvas** (No. 29).

What a Crowd! The Nuts' 9,917 attendance on July 3 was the largest crowd in not just the Midwest League, but in all of Class A+ this season. It topped all but one Class A team (Fresno), all but one Class AA team (Frisco), and was larger than 14 Class AAA teams.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2022: Jack Owen was named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, honoring dominance against Great Lakes. In his third start with the Lugnuts after getting promoted from Single-A Stockton, the 24-year-old southpaw from Auburn University set down the first 14 Loons hitters of the game, striking out seven. Jose Ramos singled to center field with two outs in the fifth for Great Lakes' first base runner; Owen responded by retiring the next four batters, finishing six scoreless innings with just one base runner allowed.

Relievers Kumar Nambiar and Trayson Kubo blanked Great Lakes over the final three innings, finishing a two-hit 1-0 Lugnuts shutout win. The Nuts went on to win four of six games from the Eastern Division's top team.

In a Nutshell: Watters first appeared for the Lugnuts on August 31, 2022, pitching against Cubs rehabber Wade Miley at South Bend in his second professional appearance... he then spent the full 2023 season for the Nuts... he has spent all but one MiLB inning (of 93 total professional innings) with the Lugnuts... opened the 2024 season in a piggyback tandem with Wander Guante, who was promoted to Double-A Midland on May 14... on May 29, needed only 39 pitches to fire five scoreless innings against Peoria... promoted to Triple-A Las Vegas for an emergency relief appearances on June 23 at Tacoma, earning the win in a 20-10 victory; allowed first five batters to reach before recovering to record the next nine outs scorelessly...

Hometown Hero: Home city of Rocky Gap, Virginia, is in the Ridge-and-Valley Appalachians, located near the West Virginia border... neighboring city: Bluefield, home of the Bluefield Ridge Runners, previously known as the Bluefield Orioles and Bluefield Blue Jays, which fed such stars as Alejandro Kirk and Vlad Guerrero, Jr. to the Lugnuts when both were in the Jays' system... cousin is Jason Michaels (2001-2011 in MLB).

Glory Days: Starred for the Bland County HS Rockets as an all-state baseball player as well as in basketball (where he regularly posted double-doubles and topped out at 45 points in one game) and football.

Off to College: Did not receive much notice before his high velocity was discovered at a tryout in Morgantown... named to the Academic All-Big 12 Rookie Team as a freshman (5 G, 4.70 ERA, 7 2/3 IP, 4 R, 6 BB, 11 K)... as a sophomore, made 19 appearances: 3.33 ERA, 27 IP, 15 H, 11 R, 32 BB, bullpen-leading 53 K, .165 avg. allowed, tied for team lead with four saves; named Academic All-Big 12 Second Team; NCBWA Stopper of the Year Midseason Watch List... made first college start in the 2021 Big 12 Championship vs. Texas: 3 IP, 0 H, 4 R, 4 BB, 8 K... as a junior in 2022, named preseason All-American; dominated early as team closer and was moved into role as Friday starter; struck out 15 Texas Longhorns in 6 1/3 IP on May 7; overall: 18 G, 11 GS, 3-7, 6.22 ERA, 59 1/3 IP, 64 H, 44 R, 41 BB, 75 K; named All-Big 12 Honorable Mention.

WVU to the **Pros:** First of three Mountaineers selected in the 2022 draft... the Fort Wayne TinCaps have featured two WVU teammates in Jackson Wolf and Ryan Berger; pitched against Bergert on May 26, 2023, and tossed 5 2/3 scoreless innings, allowing only one hit... the last West Virginia player to suit up for the Lugnuts was Ryan McBroom, who won the 2015 Midwest League Most Valuable Player award.

Draft Day: Rated Keith Law's No. 68 draft prospect for The Athletic, with Law writing, "Watters started the year in the Mountaineers' bullpen, where he hit 99 mph a few times, so the team moved him to the rotation around midseason, where he struggled more with control (37 walks in 50.2 innings) but also showed enough that some scouts think he can start in pro ball. Watters sits 94-97 mph with a power slider in the mid-80s that can miss bats ... when he locates it. It's not a bad delivery, with a reasonably short arm stroke and strong finish, so that's not the reason he doesn't throw strikes, but it's true across all of his pitches. It's much more likely he ends up a power reliever with two plus pitches. But with enough of a changeup to start and a delivery that looks like it should work, I wouldn't be surprised to see a pro team keep him in the rotation."... Fangraphs' No. 96 draft prospect... Selected 124th overall by the A's in the 4th round and signed for \$491,750... highest pitcher taken by the Athletics in 2022 (following first-round catcher Daniel Susac and three straight outfielders in high schooler Henry Bolte in the second round, Clark Elliott in the compensatory round B, and Colby Thomas in the third round).
