JACKSONVILLE SPLITS TWIN BILL WITH NASHVILLE

Jeff Lindgren tossed a complete game in the opener of Wednesday's doubleheader to lead Jacksonville to a 4-1 win but the Jumbo Shrimp fell 11-4 in the finale to the Sounds. Lindgren ceded just one run on two hits in his 7.0 frames, becoming the first Jacksonville pitcher to throw a complete game since 2021. **Cobie Fletcher-Vance** crushed a two-run home run in the effort. In the finale, Nashville scored in each of the first six innings. The Jumbo Shrimp's lone source of offense came during a four-run fifth inning, highlighted by homers from **Victor Mesa** and **Charles Leblanc**.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 24 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 24-for-79 (.304/.396/.595/.991) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 13 RBIs, 11 walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 20.0% of the time this season. His .206 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 214 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, **Brian Miller** had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 20 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 26-for-70 (.371/.438/.514/.952) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and 10 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.1 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 36.5 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 12 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 17 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 17 home runs are tied for the sixth-most in Triple-A over the last 12 games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 66 homers are tied for 17th in Triple-A.

THROUGH THE GOOD TIMES AND THE BAD

Jacksonville salvaged their seven-game series on Sunday with Durham, but the six losses the Jumbo Shrimp suffered to the Bulls were their most in any set since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Nonetheless, Jacksonville has lost 20 of its last 28 games. During this span, the club has dropped 9.5 games in the standings (6.5 to 16.0 games back). The Jumbo Shrimp's 110 runs scored (3.9 per game) are the second-fewest in Triple-A during this span, and the club owns a collective batting line of .230/.317/.378/.695, all figures that rank in the bottom three in Triple-A. Jacksonville's 169 runs allowed (6.0 per game) is the 11th-most at the level during this run.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, over their last 31 games, they've combined to surrender 113 runs, 108 earned, on 157 hits (11.8 H/9) in 123.2 innings for a 7.86 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to walk 70 (5.1 BB/9) against only 92 strikeouts (6.7 K/9).

JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder **Jacob Amaya** came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 28 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 34-for-100 during this stretch, slashing .340/.409/.590/.999 with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 20 RBIs, 12 walks and 18 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .179 this year.

SHRIMP BITES

Following Tuesday's defeat against Nashville, Jacksonville has lost its last seven series openers. The Jumbo Shrimp were swept last Wednesday in a doubleheader at Durham, and split their doubleheader with Nashville yesterday...Jeff Lindgren's complete game in game one of the doubleheader was the first CG of 6+ innings since 8/3/21.

ABOUT ENMANUEL

-De Jesus was originally signed by the Boston Red Sox as a free agent on a minor league contract.

-Pitched for Magallanes in the Venezuelan Winter League in both 2017 (four games) and 2018 (16 games). All of his outings were out of the bullpen.

-De Jesus led High-A Salem in strikeouts (122) and wins (T-1st, 9) and threw at least 6.0 innings in 11 of his 24 starts.

2023 SEASON

-Missed 40 games with an injury from April 4-May 19.

2022 SEASON

-De Jesus was assigned to the to Jacksonville on Dec. 16, 2022.

2021 SEASON

-De Jesus was primarily used as a starter in in Boston's minor league system until 2021.

-De Jesus was then moved to the reliever roll where he went 3-0 with a 2.35 ERA and 40 strikeouts in his 13 relief appearances for Portland. Nine of his 13 relief outings were multi-inning appearances.

-Grew up in Valencia, VZ and originally signed by Boston as an international free agent on July 2, 2013 when he was 16 years old.
